PO Morinitti only used three sick days during this rating period and never reported late for his tour.

PO Morinitti was observed one block out of zone by Captain Cinque. When questioned about it he said he had just missed a turn to stay in zone. This incident was documented and has not been an issue with PO Morinitti since.

PO Morinitti is frequently a top performer in productivity in the platoon.

PO Morinitti conducts complete and thorough investigations as well as Evidence Technician work. The only issues with PO Morinitti's reports are the organization and grammar of the information itself. They are sometimes written in a way that can be hard to follow, such as in a bullet point / paragraph hybrid format. This has been something PO Morinitti has worked on throughout his career and as his supervisor I have seen a marked improvement in this over time.

PO Morinitti has a mild mannered demeanor and calming presence when dealing with the public but at the same time he does not hesitate to act or get physical when the situation calls for it. This is a good balance and should be something officers strive to achieve.

pointed a handgun [REDACTED]

While in the area, Sgt Cimpi located a male matching the description of the suspect still in the area. Upon being stopped, the male discarded a book bag and fled on foot from Sgt Cimpi. During the ensuing foot pursuit; I, along with members of patrol surrounded the area. After a brief foot pursuit I was able to apprehend the suspect and was quickly assisted by PO Morinitti and PO Jukic in taking the male into custody. The male would later be identified as Brandon McNair.

Upon conducting a backtrack of the pursuit, Sgt Cimpi and PO Rejrat located a loaded and defaced .380 handgun. Video evidence would later be collected showing the male discarding the firearm during the pursuit.

PO DeTraglia secured the discarded book bag which was later found to contain contraband consisting of narcotics pills.

I would like to make note in each respective officers e-file relative to their efforts in taking McNair into custody and removing an illegal handgun from the streets.

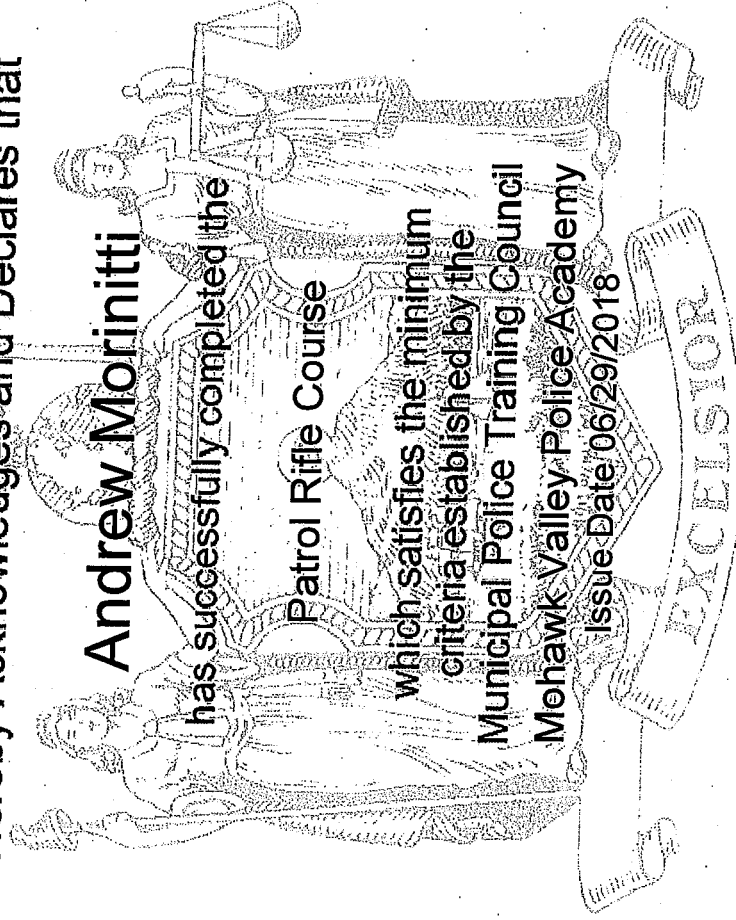

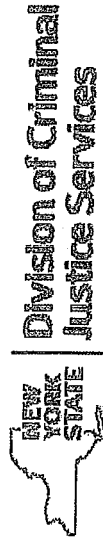

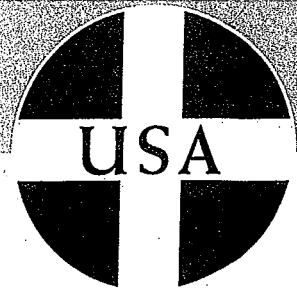

On December 1st 2016, Officers Joshua Sweet and Raymond Kellogg were patrolling West Utica when they observed a male subject walking in the area of Court St. The officers knew the man was wanted by the Utica Police Department. They attempted to stop and affect an arrest but the subject fled on foot. The officers gave chase and additional units responded to the area. While searching for the male in the area of the brewery, a witness saw a male matching the subject's description discard an item in the rear parking lot of a Varick St. pub. Officer Andrew Morinitti and Officer Kellogg checked the lot and located a .22 caliber pistol.

Officer Sweet and Officer Anthony Aurience continued to search for the male in the area of the bars on Varick St. Officer Aurience then located the male attempting to scale a fence on Varick St. and took him into custody without further incident. The male subject was positively identified as the male who discarded the firearm and was subsequently charged with criminal possession of a weapon and criminal possession of a firearm, in addition to his active warrant. The officers successfully removed from the streets a man who was and is a danger to the community as well as an illegal handgun. Officers Sweet, Kellogg, Aurience, and Morinitti are a credit to themselves and to the City of Utica.

No witnesses to the incident. Rivera sustained a scrape to his bottom lip while he was on the sidewalk. Same was treated by UFD at HQ.

On January 20, 2019 at approximately 0827 hours PO Morinitti was operating Car 50 for Zone 56 due to the Snow Emergency and poor road conditions. PO Morinitti was north bound on Culver Ave. and making a left turn onto Crouse St. when the vehicle behind him (NY [REDACTED]) continued north bound and drove into the rear left quarter panel of Car 50 as it turned. The operator of [REDACTED] Kristopher Worden [REDACTED] stated that he was north bound on Culver Ave. behind Car 50 when he believed Car 50 was pulling over to the right side of the roadway so he began to drive around him on the left. Worden said he then saw Car 50's left turn signal go on and Car 50 started to turn left onto Crouse St. and Worden was unable to stop his vehicle, causing him to strike the rear left side of Car 50.

There is now a large dent on the rear left quarter panel of 50 behind the tire and below the tail lamp. The damage does not appear to be effecting the operation of the vehicle. Chuck from Fleet Maintenance checked and cleared the vehicle for service. I will be handling the subsequent investigation.

Greetings,

On Tuesday June 4, 2019 units were dispatched to [REDACTED] regarding a [REDACTED] progress. PO West, and PO Jessica Dodge arrived on scene and upon doing so they observed a black male, now known to be Jamall M. Moore [REDACTED] walking away from the residence. Moore appeared to be disheveled, sweating, and clearly agitated. As the officers began investigating the call the [REDACTED] exited off of the porch of [REDACTED] and began yelling towards Moore; stating that she wanted him arrested for head butting her. At that point PO West yelled out to Moore, advising him to stop walking away and that he was under arrest. Moore did not comply with PO West's direct orders and continued to walk away. PO West again advised Moore that he was under arrest, but Moore still continued to walk away. At that point PO West, and PO Dodge approached Moore and attempted to utilize an empty hand control to take him into custody. Moore immediately began actively resisting by pulling away from their grasps and turning his body. PO Morinitti then arrived on scene and assisted by utilizing a soft hand come along and takedown of Moore in order to gain a position of advantage. While on the ground Moore continued to actively resist the officers, who were advising him to stop resisting and to give them his hands. He did so by flailing his arms and pulling them underneath his body. PO Morinitti then administered 4 strikes to Moore's torso in order to gain compliance, but Moore continued to resist. At that point PO West un-holstered his issued Taser and announced that he would "Tase" Moore if he did not place his hands behind his back. Upon the announcement of the Taser Moore then complied, placed his hands behind his back, and he was handcuffed to the rear. Moore was then escorted to his feet and further escorted to the rear of Car 55.

Moore was transported to headquarters by Car 45, PO Jessica Dodge.

Moore stated his back and neck hurt, but declined any medical attention. Moore did not make any further complaints regarding the use of force.

PO West's Taser was taken out service, placed in a plastic bag, and put in the Taser cabinet.

On 08/03/2019 at approximately 0810 hours PO Morinitti caused damage to his front left tire in car 55. PO Morinitti informed me that while he was in route to a MVA on the Thruway Ramp he was traveling on Route 12 S and was approaching the Downtown / State Street split and was attempting to choose the best route to the MVA, when at the last minute he decided to take the State Street route. PO Morinitti stated as he merged towards the State Street ramp his drivers side front tire struck the curb where the road splits and caused damage to the rim and tire. PO Morinitti contacted me on my cell phone to inform what had happened. I then responded to the scene to assess the situation. I notified the squad commander, Lt. Dougherty and secured photographs of the scene and damage. I observed that the rim was bent and the tire had a slice in it however not punctured. I advised PO Morinitti to respond to headquarters with Car 55 and grab a spare tire from the storage room. A Tow truck off rotation was called to change the tire. There was no other damage caused to car 55. The damaged tire was tagged and left in the Sally Port. A fact finding investigation has been initiated.
