This was observed when dealing with an EDP in the basement of a residence, Ptln. Evans was able to communicate with the subject and talk him out of the basement using his strong verbal skills.

Officer Evans is a quality officer who can improve upon his skills by furthering his knowledge of policies and laws. Officer Evans is a member of the SWAT team as well as a General Topics instructor. He should look to broaden his horizon on teaching topics. One area Evans should try to continue to improve upon is his proactivity while conducting patrols. Ptln. Evans had one issue while dealing with a supervisor and owned up to his mistake and in general is very rarely, if ever an issue for supervisors.

For officer safety reasons, Evans should have never removed his duty belt while on the call.

Officer C. Evans:

On July 24, 2017, around 1800 hours, while assigned to C Platoon Car 59, you were dispatched to 11 Bryant St. to assist C Platoon Car 53 - PO Balsler with a reported dispute. Upon arrival, PO Basler found that the situation at hand was a civil dispute involving Cindy Ross and John Kaminski. While PO Basler was handling the incident, you noted that an uninvolved white male later identified as Charles Donlon was yelling profanities seemingly directed at your position from the front yard of 18 Bryant St. Donlon's actions were described as tumultuous and disorderly therefore you opted to confront Donlon to address his behavior while PO Basler finished resolving the unrelated civil dispute.

Upon confronting Donlon, you advised him to cease his disorderly behavior as he was creating a public disturbance. Donlon continued with his disorderly and tumultuous behavior by directing vulgarities and provocations towards you such as "come over here and suck my dick" as well as "take that gun and badge off and I'll fuck you up."

In a brief lapse of judgement, you removed your badge and duty belt in what you claimed was an attempt to deescalate the situation by "calling Donlon's bluff" and showing Donlon that you would not be intimidated by his actions as you felt confident that Donlon would not engage you in a physical altercation. A few moments later, you admittedly realized your lapse in judgement and walked away from the situation disregarding Donlon's continued provocations.

An acquaintance of Donlon, recorded the encounter between Donlon and you on her cell phone which was uploaded to social media - Facebook and subsequently went viral with thousands of views / shares. The Utica Police Department's command staff was alerted to the situation which prompted the initiation of an internal investigation to determine whether the actions of all the involved officers aligned with department policy / procedure. The inquiry found that your above noted actions were unprofessional and in violation of department policy.

As a result of the investigation it was determined that you have violated Department Procedural Manual as follows:

Chapter 8, Article 1: Professional Standards of Conduct and Ethics

1.17 General Rules of Conduct:

A. Unbecoming Conduct;

1. Employees shall conduct themselves at all times, both on and off-duty, in such a manner as to reflect the highest standards of the law enforcement profession.

Last Revision Date 6/7/2016

On 8/1/2017, a Command Discipline hearing was commenced. You were offered PBA representation and you ^{CE}accepted/denied. Also present during this hearing was - declined PBA representation. We came to the following resolution.

- A) You accept the findings of the investigation.
- B) You accept responsibility for violating the Departmental Procedural Manual.
- C) You accept this Letter of Reprimand.
- D) You also understand that in the future, this behavior or any other violation of Departmental Rules or Regulations of a similar nature will be subject to further disciplinary action.



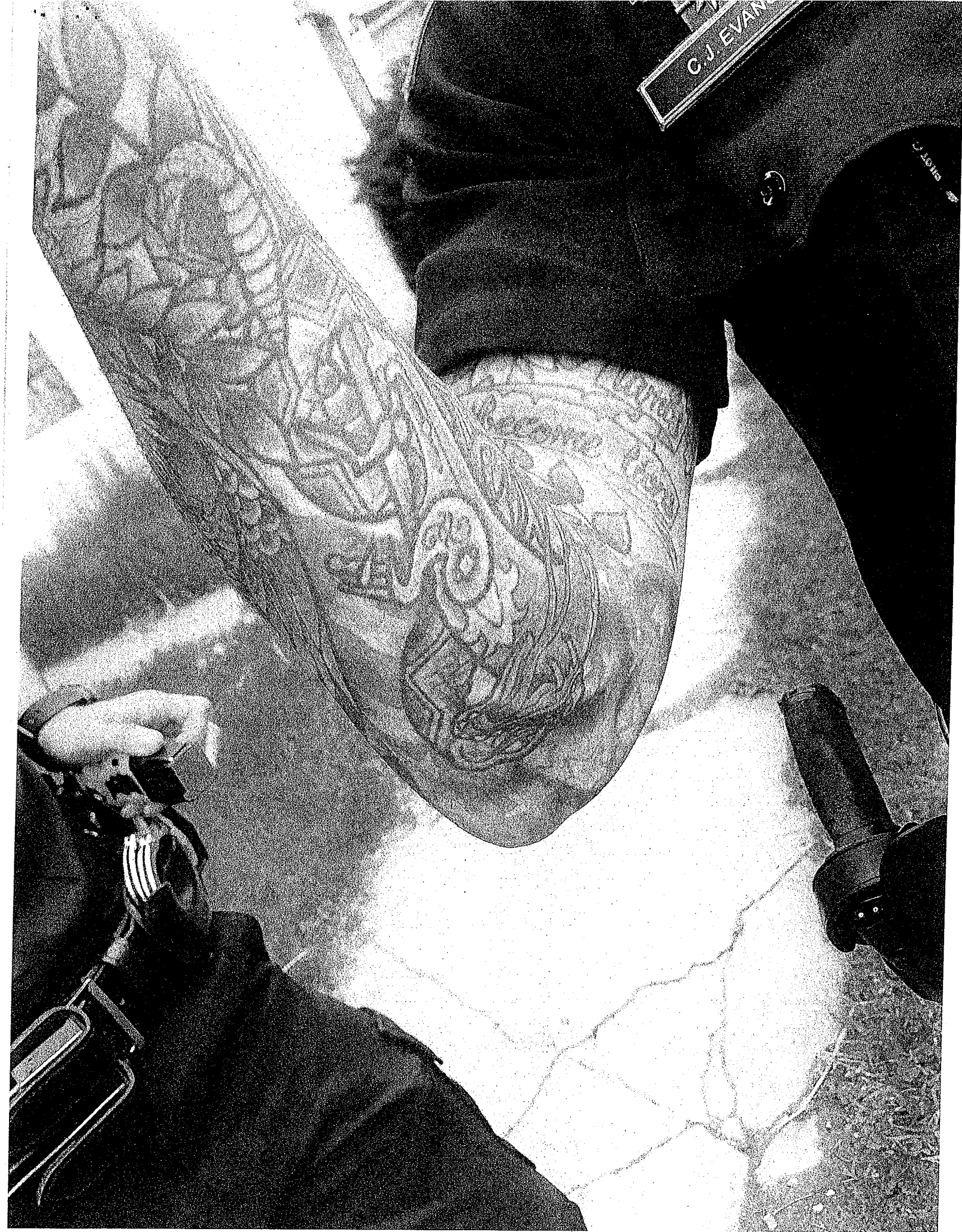

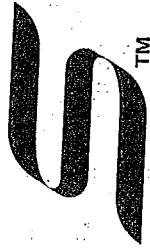

OFFICER CHRISTOPHER EVANS, OFFICER ANDREW MILLER and OFFICER RICHARD LANGE

On May 27th, 2018, Officers Christopher Evans, Andrew Miller and Richard Lange encountered a highly aggressive and agitated male who menaced them with a knife in the middle of the roadway in front of a home on Seymour Avenue. Prior to their arrival, they were informed by communications that this emotionally disturbed subject had just stabbed an individual inside a residence there. Once met by this armed and disturbed subject, officers yelled for him to disarm himself. The subject then began to stab himself in the chest and throat while advancing towards Officers Miller and Lange.

After a taser deployment and ensuing struggle, the officers were able to detain the subject in handcuffs. Officer Lange and Officer Evans rendered medical aid to the subject by applying direct pressure with cloths and combat gauze to the open wounds on his neck. Officer Miller assisted by keeping the combative male restrained and from flailing around. UFD arrived on scene and took over medical treatment.

During the encounter, it was highly likely that the subject would try to bite and strike them and that they would be directly exposed to the blood of this subject. These officers acted without hesitation and without regard for their own safety in an effort to save the life of this bloody and combative individual.


On February 9th, 2019, multiple patrol units were dispatched to [REDACTED]. The dispatch center advised officers in route that the male suspect was in possession of a knife. The patrol units quickly responded to the scene to learn the suspect had already left the residence.

At that point, Sgt. David Poccia, Officer Christopher Evans, Officer Richard Lange and Officer Steven Gray proceeded to conduct the preliminary investigation. While conducting the investigation inside the residence, the suspect returned to the scene wielding a large knife at the officers. The officers drew their duty weapons and immediately gave verbal commands to drop the knife but the suspect did not comply. The suspect then retreated into the basement with the knife and refused to come back upstairs.

The officers on scene were suddenly dealing with an armed barricade situation. This is when the officers, primarily Officer Evans, began to talk with the suspect in an attempt to get him to drop the knife and surrender. Officer Evans initiated and maintained a dialogue with the suspect for 23 minutes before the suspect finally agreed to surrender to officers.

These officers should be recognized for their professionalism and actions under extreme pressure. When the suspect appeared with the knife, it was very close to a lethal force situation. However, these officers utilized their good judgement and training. Officer Evans should also be specifically recognized for his verbal skills and ultimately ending the tense situation through communication.

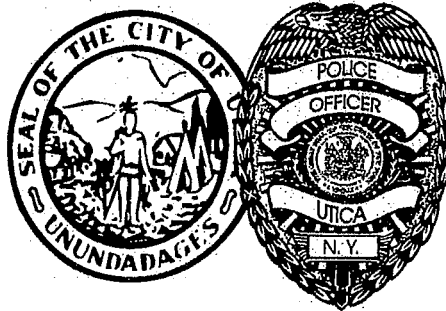

On June 30th 2017, Investigator Aaron Donaldson received information regarding an individual who was in possession of an illegal handgun. Investigator Donaldson observed that person inside a vehicle and observed the vehicle commit a vehicle and traffic violation while he was following it. Officer Dennis Basler, Officer Christopher Evans and Officer Ray Kellogg assisted Investigator Donaldson in conducting a traffic stop of the vehicle on Stark Street.

When the officers approached the vehicle, there were four occupants and they could smell an odor consistent with marijuana emanating from inside the vehicle. When officers searched the vehicle, they located a loaded Colt .22 caliber revolver. The gun found was reported stolen out of Saratoga County.

All officers involved performed their duties knowing there was possibly a handgun inside the vehicle. These officers diligently performed their duties without fear and took another illegal handgun off the street.

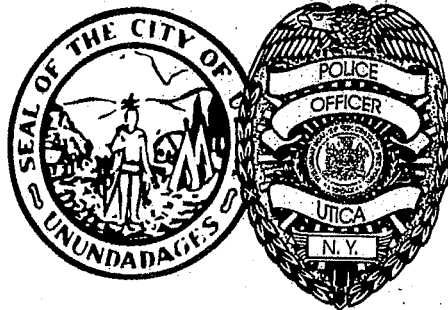

On Sunday, October 8, 2017, just before 1:00 a.m., while assigned to an extra-duty GIVE Grant special detail, Lieutenant James Holt conducted a vehicle stop of an SUV on the 1600 block of Brinckerhoff Ave. pursuant to violations of NYS Vehicle and Traffic Law. Soon after, Captain Donald Cinque, Sergeant Keith Phillips and Officer Christopher Evans arrived to assist.


The occupants of the vehicle were identified and it was discovered that the right front passenger was wanted by the City of Rome Police Department regarding an outstanding warrant. While removing this occupant from the vehicle, Lt. Holt detected an odor of marihuana. He now suspected that the occupants of the vehicle may be in possession of a quantity of marihuana.

As the investigation progressed, the right rear passenger fled from the scene on foot. Captain Cinque, Lieutenant Holt, Sergeant Phillips and Officer Evans engaged in a foot pursuit of the subject and after a brief physical struggle, apprehended him within a rear yard of Brinckerhoff Ave. This second passenger was taken into custody and ultimately found to be in possession of a fully functional, defaced, loaded, Ruger 9mm handgun within his pants. He illegally possessed the handgun and was subsequently charged with various criminal possession of a weapon charges.

The right front passenger was taken into custody and turned over to the City of Rome Police regarding his outstanding warrant. The remaining occupant of the vehicle, the driver, was charged with unlawful possession of marihuana as well as several violations of NYS VTL.

Due to the seamless teamwork, attention to duty, keen observations and selflessness of Captain Cinque, Lieutenant Holt, Sergeant Phillips and Officer Evans, a dangerous armed criminal was apprehended and an illegally possessed handgun was seized without incident. The actions of all the involved officers bring honor to themselves and the Utica Police Department.

On 12/29/17, Utica Police CID conducted an investigation regarding terroristic threats (RMS 17-56604). As a result of the investigation, CID obtained an active felony arrest warrant for the suspect Gentry Staggs regarding Making a Terroristic Threat which was issued by Utica City Court Judge Giruzzi. The arrest warrant listed the residence of Mr. Staggs at [REDACTED]. Several attempts to contact Mr. Staggs were unsuccessful. CID conducted an investigation regarding the whereabouts of Mr. Staggs and found that he was in fact at his residence - [REDACTED].

Due to exigent circumstances as well as documented threats, METRO SWAT was requested to execute the arrest warrant for Mr. Staggs at his residence. Thus, on 12/29/17 around 1630 hours, several members of METRO SWAT (Cinque, Holt, Acquaviva, Penree, Schultz, Evans) made entry into the residence of Mr. Staggs at [REDACTED]. This evening, at approximately 2006 hours, units were dispatched to [REDACTED] regarding a male suspect who allegedly stabbed a female victim with a pencil and was threatening to cut himself with a knife. When Car 55 (PO Lange) and Car 57 (PO Miller) arrived on scene they met with the suspect, [REDACTED] in the roadway. [REDACTED] was in possession of a knife and walking towards the officers. As a response to [REDACTED] aggressive fighting the officers utilized aggressive counter measures in the form of hard hand strikes and take downs. While on the ground [REDACTED] still continued to aggressively fight the officers and at that point Sgt. Perra administered two kicks to [REDACTED] head. After Sgt. Perra administered the two kicks [REDACTED] ceased fighting the officers and they were able to handcuff him to the rear. Upon arrival he spoke with Bagicha Singh who advised him that he called to have an intoxicated male removed from the property. Singh informed Evans that this male does not live inside the apartment building due to a Utica City court order, however no such order could be located in RMS. PO Evans located Walter D. Kimball, who appeared visibly irate. Kimball was holding an open alcoholic beverage and was asked to set same down so PO Evans could conduct a pat frisk of his person as he observed what appeared to be a knife pouch on his right hip. Kimball informed Evans that he had a knife and started reaching for the pouch on his hip. PO Evans took control of Kimball's right wrist and instructed him to stop reaching for the knife. Kimball began to pull away from Evans, and Evans again ordered him to stop. During this struggling, Kimball ignored all his verbal commands to cease his action and continued to pull away from Evans. Kimball then swung his left hand at Evans in an attempt to hit him with his alcoholic beverage. PO Evans raised his right shoulder, bracing himself for Kimball's strike and was struck on his shoulder. At this time PO Evans returned a hard hand strike using a closed right fist, which struck Kimball on the left side of his face. Kimball was

then taken to the ground, where he continued to pull away from him in an attempt to break his control over his wrist. PO Evans held him in place until Officers Zayas and Maciol arrived to assist with placing Kimball into handcuffs.

Photographs of the scene and Kimball were secured. Kimball did not make any complaint, he was transported by UFD to St. Elizabeth's Hospital regarding a bloody lip. Kimball was highly intoxicated. A response to resistance form was completed by Ptlm. Evans. All BWC footage was tagged.

McCray became very belligerent and

aggressive at the very top of the stairwell with Officer Evans and ignored Officer Evans commands for him to calm down back out of his (Officer Evans') personal space. McCray continued to violate Officer Evans' personal space and while in Officer Evans' personal space abruptly stepped towards Officer Evans in what appeared to be a threatening manner and this is when Officer Evans advised McCray that he was under arrest and McCray tensed up and did not give Officer Evans his hands so that he could be handcuffed so Officer Evans utilized a soft hand take down to McCray by grabbing a hold of McCray's wrist and pulling him to the ground by same therefore giving Officer Evans a position of advantage and allowing him to handcuff McCray without further incident. McCray stated he was not injured, not in need of any medical attention and showed no apparent signs of any injury. All applicable body worn camera footage was tagged, response to resistance form and officer narrative were completed by Officers Evans and reviewed by this supervisor. A supervisor Response to Resistance Form was completed and all actions by Officer Evans were deemed to be in accordance with UPD policy and procedure. McCray was subsequently charged with harassment 2nd by PO Evans.

On Monday, July 24, 2017, I, Dennis P. Basler, reported to work at the Utica Police Dept., in full patrol uniform attire, for the 1600-0000 hours shift and I was assigned to the Uniform Patrol Division, Car 53 / Zone 53 / BWC #0501, per Platoon Commander, Lt. Holt.

At approximately 1759 hours, I was dispatched to [REDACTED] regarding a dispute in progress; however, this was later determined to be a civil complaint.

While speaking with the caller, Cindy Ross [REDACTED], and the other involved party, John Kaminski [REDACTED], I noticed that a male and a female could be clearly heard yelling profanities loudly from the north end of the street. PO Evans had also arrived on scene and approached the disorderly parties to address their behavior. After speaking with the Ross and Kaminski, I turned that direction and observed PO Evans standing in the roadway with a white male, who I recognized as Charles Donlon [REDACTED], yelling profanities from the front yard of [REDACTED].

I walked to where PO Evans was standing and observed him removing the keepers from his gun belt. I asked him why Donlon was yelling to which he replied Donlon challenged him to remove his firearm and police badge. Rather than leave it unsecured, I offered to secure PO Evans' property on my person and then stood by while he finished his conversation with Donlon. This lasted for approximately 10-15 seconds and then we returned to our patrol vehicle while Donlon proceeded to shout obscenities towards us; saying he would fuck us up, to suck his dick, and calling PO Evans a child molester.

On July 24, 2017, I, Christopher Evans, reported to the Utica Police Department for the 1600-0000 hours shift in full duty attire and was assigned to car/zone 59, under Platoon Commander Lt. Holt.

At approximately 1800 hours I was dispatched to 11 Bryant Street for a reported civil complaint. While on scene, I encountered a w/m I know to be Charles Donlon [REDACTED]. Although Donlon was not initially involved in the reported incident, he became argumentative with parties on scene. Through prior police experience I know Donlon to be extremely hostile and confrontational, especially in the presence of law enforcement. I advised Donlon that he was not helping the current situation with his constant profanity and to go into his home. Donlon then directed his hostility towards me stating "Come over here and suck my dick". Donlon continued on with his spouting of profanity stating "take that badge & gun off and I'll come over there and fuck you up", to which I obliged, removing both my badge and duty belt. I did so knowing it was highly unlikely that Donlon would approach me with intentions to engage in a physical altercation. It was also my hopes that after seeing he was not going to intimidate me that Donlon would return to his home without further incident. After a few moments, I realized my lapse in judgment and walked away, putting my gear back on, as this is not the conduct expected of a police officer.

On the 24th day of July 2017, I reported to work for the 1600 to 0000 hour shift, assigned to Car 40 as a street supervisor, under the command of Sgt. Starr Rae Wooden.

Summary:

On July 24th 2017, at around 1800 hours, Officer Christopher Evans and Officer Dennis Basler were dispatched to [REDACTED] for some type of dispute. Upon arrival Officer Basler spoke with a Cindy Ross regarding a civil dispute she was having with John Kaminski. During the call Officer Evans encountered a Charles E. Donlan [REDACTED] toward the north end of [REDACTED]. At this time Donlan began verbally harassing and threatening Evans. Donlan then challenged Evans to take off his badge and gun to fight him. Officer Evans then proceeded to remove his badge and duty belt at Donlan's request. About 15 seconds later Evans put his duty belt back on and walked away from Donlan with no physical contact.

Investigative Facts:

On July 24th 2017, at around 1800 hours, Officer Christopher Evans and Officer Dennis Basler were dispatched to [REDACTED] for some type of dispute. Upon arrival Officer Basler spoke with a Cindy Ross regarding a civil dispute she was having with John Kaminski. During the call Officer Evans encountered a Charles E. Donlan [REDACTED] toward the north end of [REDACTED]. Mr. Donlan was not involved in the original call for service and he did not call the police. It appears Donlan's intentions were to verbally harass the officers on scene because Evans said nothing to him until he started yelling. Evans was talking to [REDACTED] when Donlan began yelling at Evans. Donlan was screaming a wide variety of insults and threats towards Evans while he was on the street. Mr. Donlan was calling Evans a "Motherfucker", telling him to "Suck his dick" and that he will "Fuck him up". At one point, Donlan challenges Evans to take off his badge and gun so they could fight. After Donlan's challenge to fight, Officer Evans removed his badge and duty belt. Evans took his badge and duty belt off and handed it to Officer Basler. After roughly 15 seconds passed, Evans pinned his badge back on his uniform and placed his belt back on his waist. Donlan continued spewing threats at Evans until he cleared the call. Just prior to clearing the call Donlan began threatening and using racial slurs towards Officer Basler.

During this verbal exchange there was no physical contact between any of the officers and Charles Donlan. Body worn camera footage was reviewed and there was also a civilian video that Mr. Donlan took, which was secured for the investigation. In both videos it clearly shows that Evans took off his duty belt during the incident after being challenged to a fight. The video footage collected during this investigation (BWC & civilian video) appears to capture everything that occurred. Both officers' narratives are consistent with the videos that were reviewed. The main issue regarding this complaint is the fact that Evans took off his duty belt. Evans' verbal

exchange did remain relatively professional minus Evans telling Donlan "I get out of work at midnight." As mentioned before, the whole incident was captured on video, which helps verify the events that occurred without dispute.

Investigative Findings:

After investigating this matter, it was determined that Officer Christopher Evans did take his badge and duty belt off after being challenged to a fight by Charles Donlan. This is without doubt an officer safety issue and unprofessional. As Utica Police Officers we are trained not to remove our duty belts unless there are extenuating circumstances, and this was not one of them. Evans endangered himself and Officer Basler by removing his duty belt, with his duty weapon on the belt. Evans secured the belt with Officer Basler but that immediately burdens Basler with having to protect the equipment on the belt. Being Officer Evans' supervisor, I am extremely surprised with this behavior, for he is usually an exemplary officer. Officer Evans is a young officer who made an error in judgment while dealing with a belligerent person. Luckily nothing extreme happened as a result of Evans' actions and as mentioned before this type of behavior is not his normal course of business. Being a police officer in this day and age is very difficult due to the physical, mental, and verbal abuse we endure on the street. However, it cannot be ignored that Officer Evans did violate policy and procedure. Evans did violate Chapter 8, Article 1, Section 17 of the Utica Police Department Policy and Procedure which states "Employees shall conduct themselves at all times, both on and off-duty, in such a manner as to reflect the highest standards of the law enforcement profession." Evans' actions did not uphold the highest standards of the Utica Police Department. It was also determined that Officer Basler did not violate any policy and procedure during the incident.

Summary:

I, Lt. James R. Holt Jr., am employed by the City of Utica Police Department, assigned to the Patrol Division - C Platoon (1545-0000 hour's shift) as the Platoon Commander. While performing my duties as the C Platoon Commander, I reviewed an internal investigation submitted to me by Sgt. Perra regarding an External Personnel Complaint in association with Utica Police Incident # 17-32919.

On July 24, 2017, around 1800 hours, C Platoon Car 53 – PO Basler and C Platoon Car 59 – PO Evans were dispatched to [REDACTED] for a dispute. Upon arrival, PO Basler and PO Evans found that the situation at hand was a civil dispute involving Cindy Ross and John Kaminski. While handling said civil dispute, both officers noted that an uninvolved white male later identified as Charles Donlon was yelling profanities seemingly towards the officers from the front yard of [REDACTED]. Donlon's actions were described by the officers as tumultuous and disorderly therefore PO Evans opted to confront Donlon to address his behavior while PO Basler finished resolving the unrelated civil dispute.

PO Evans confronted Donlon and advised him to cease his disorderly behavior as he was creating a public disturbance. Donlon continued with his disorderly and tumultuous behavior by yelling to PO Evans "come over here and suck my dick" as well as provocations such as "take that gun and badge off and I'll fuck you up."

In a brief lapse of judgement, PO Evans removed his badge and duty belt and handed same to PO Basler in what PO Evans claimed was an attempt to deescalate the situation by "calling Donlon's bluff" and showing Donlon that he would not be intimidated as he felt confident that Donlon would not engage him in a physical altercation. PO Evans quickly realized his lapse in judgement and walked away from the situation disregarding Donlon's continued provocations.

An acquaintance of Donlon, recorded the encounter between Donlon and PO Evans on her cell phone which was uploaded to social media – Facebook and subsequently went viral with thousands of views / shares. The Utica Police Department's command staff was alerted to the situation which prompted the initiation of an internal investigation to determine whether the actions of all the involved officers aligned with department policy / procedure. C Platoon Supervisor Sgt. Perra was tasked with the impending internal investigation.

Investigative Facts:

Sgt. Rios of the Professional Standards Unit secured the video depicting the confrontation between PO Evans and Charles Donlon which appeared on Facebook, same was turned over to Sgt. Perra for investigatory / documentation purposes. Sgt. Perra reviewed said footage which appeared to depict the entire encounter in question between PO Evans and Donlon.

Sgt. Perra researched the associated incident (RMS 17-32919) and found that the only involved officers were PO Evans and PO Basler. Sgt. Perra interviewed both PO Evans and PO Basler regarding the incident in question for fact finding purposes. Furthermore, Sgt. Perra requested and secured comprehensive narratives from both PO Evans and PO Basler on Intra-Agency Memorandums requesting that they explain their actions in entirety regarding the associated incident.

Sgt. Perra reviewed and tagged all associated Body Worn Camera footage captured by the Body Worn Cameras of both PO Evans and PO Basler.

After reviewing the above noted camera footage, Sgt. Perra found no inconsistencies in the accounts provided by both PO Evans and PO Basler. Furthermore, Sgt. Perra found no reason to interview Donlon regarding the incident in question as he was confident the entire encounter between PO Evans and Donlon was captured on camera.

Investigative Findings:

Sgt. Perra concluded that the actions of PO Evans were unprofessional in violation of the Utica Police Department Procedural Manual Chapter 8, Article 1 – Professional Standards of Conduct & Ethics, Section 17:

1.17 GENERAL RULES OF CONDUCT:

A. Unbecoming Conduct;

1. Employees shall conduct themselves at all times, both on and off-duty, in such a manner as to reflect the highest standards of the law enforcement profession.


Furthermore, Sgt. Perra concluded that PO Basler's actions did not violate any established department policy and/or procedure.

After reviewing all applicable case work regarding the above personnel complaint, I concurred with Sgt. Perra's findings.

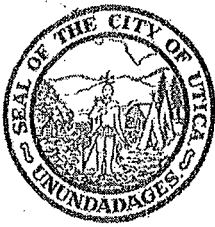
Recommendations:

A few moments later, you admittedly realized your lapse in judgement and walked away from the situation disregarding Donlon's continued provocations.

An acquaintance of Donlon, recorded the encounter between Donlon and you on her cell phone which was uploaded to social media - Facebook and subsequently went viral with thousands of views / shares. The Utica Police Department's command staff was alerted to the situation which prompted the initiation of an internal investigation to determine whether the actions of all the involved officers aligned with department policy / procedure. The inquiry found that your above noted actions were unprofessional and in violation of department policy.

As a result of the investigation it was determined that you have violated Department Procedural Manual as follows:

Chapter 8, Article 1: Professional Standards of Conduct and Ethics

1.17 General Rules of Conduct:

A. Unbecoming Conduct;

1. Employees shall conduct themselves at all times, both on and off-duty, in such a manner as to reflect the highest standards of the law enforcement profession.





I. Identify and define the behavior to be modified:

When completing a DMV photo request Officer Christopher Evans failed to provide a comment regarding the circumstances of the request. Any officer requesting a photo from the DMV must document in the comments sections as much information as possible regarding the nature of the request, e.g. John A Doe stopped at court and Varick St open container violation could not provide any form of identification, request made to confirm identification. Additional e.g. Jane Doe stopped for passing red light at Genesee St at Parkside Ct, did not produce a driver's license or any form of ID, request made to confirm identification.

II. Review of applicable rules & regulations, orders and operating procedures or laws:

It has been stated time and time again in written e-mails and by oral directive that employees will make every effort to complete criminal history and DMV photo requests by filling in all applicable fields with as much information and detail as possible. All fields will be completed and all comments/remarks sections will have the required amount of information

III. Employee's response to the performance deficiency:

PO Evans understands his deficiencies in regards to the audits and will strive to be much more conscientious.

IV. Clearly explain the behavior expected of the member:

PO Evans will complete ALL fields listed and provide ample information in the comments section of both request forms. He should know that the more information he puts in the comments section, the less likely he will be flagged by the state in the future.

V. Potential consequences for continuing the unacceptable behavior:

In the event PO Evans is flagged on any future DMV or criminal history inquiries, further discipline will result which will likely include at a minimum a letter of reprimand.

VI. Provisions for follow-up consultations:

The audit reports will be carefully monitored in the future for any deficiencies on the part of PO Evans.
