**Nomination for Award**  
**Fort Schuyler Post 1290**

In the evening of December 26, 2017, Deputy Fire Chief Scott Ingersoll and Deputy Police Chief Ed Noonan were [REDACTED] at the [REDACTED] Marcy New York.

As Deputy Chief Noonan was arriving [REDACTED] a young girl met him in the parking lot. The girl was crying and did not have coat on despite the cold weather. Deputy Chief Noonan asked what was wrong and the girl replied she could not wake her mother up. Deputy Chief Noonan immediately went [REDACTED] Fire Chief Ingersoll.

Together both chiefs had the girl take them to the apartment that was nearby but on another road, where the mother was found lying on the floor. Deputy Chief Ingersoll who is also a New York State Certified Paramedic assessed the patient and found she was not breathing and was turning purple. Both men recognized it was an apparent overdose and Ingersoll immediately began CPR on the mother. First responders were notified as well as an ambulance while CPR was continued.

CPR was administered for at least 10-15 minute before the local fire department and ambulance arrived. Deputy Chief Ingersoll informed arriving responders of the situation and directed them to administer Naloxone to the patient to counter the overdose. A second dose was also needed and administered and the patient finally responded. The mother did not appear to suffer from any other symptoms.

The actions of Deputy Fire Chief Ingersoll and Deputy Police Chief Noonan undoubtedly saved this woman's life. Both men did not hesitate to respond while off duty and used their experience and training to achieve a successful outcome. Their actions uphold the highest traditions of public safety. Both men should be commended for their role in saving the life of this individual.
