It was determined that he failed to utilize due care while operating a patrol car.

This complaint was ultimately investigated and deemed sustained, as he was in fact rude, and discourteous toward the complainant. He was issued a written counseling memorandum.
- It was noted in his E-File that he was verbally counseled regarding Vehicle and Traffic and how it applies to subjects walking on a highway.
- He is able to multi-task and this has been demonstrated on calls as he can handle his calls and also is able to pay attention to the radio traffic. He will use good judgment and clear a not in progress call to assist with in progress calls that require additional police units.
- Reports are very well written, free of error and are often completed on time and thorough.
- Shows his dedication to further himself in his career by becoming a member of METRO SWAT and by requesting training opportunities that arise.

How can this employee best improve his/her performance? (Include setting Career /Performance Goals).

PO Femia needs to work on his communication skills and exercise more patience and tact when dealing with difficult and confrontational subjects. PO Femia also needs to be more cognizant with utilizing due care when operating his patrol car as he has been involved in a total of three accidents with department vehicles, and was faulted for causing each of the previous accidents with associated policy violations for failure to utilize due care while operating department vehicles. PO Femia does have strong leadership qualities and is knowledgable

On July 31st 2020 at approximately 2230 Hrs you were involved in a use of force incident involving whom you were escorting into unit 13 in the sallyport area at UPD HQ. While escorting him into unit 13 using soft hand techniques the point you on your right shoulder. Upon being bitten you called a "Cocksucker." You also told him that when you see him on the street it's over.

A review of your police personnel file uncovered a counseling memo for the use of insolent language and violation of the below policy on a prior occasion in December of 2018. You told a citizen "Shut up and not to call the fucking police anymore."

As a result of the investigation it was determined that you have violated Department Procedural Manual Chapter 8, Article 1: Professional Standards of Conduct & Ethics 1.14 PERFORMANCE AND ATTENTION TO DUTY:

- G. Cooperation, Coordination and Courtesy:
- 2. Employees should be courteous, respectful and professional at all times, toward citizens, members of the department and individuals representing other organizations, in all forms of communications in the performance of their duties.
- 3. Employees shall not use harsh, profane, insolent, or intentionally insulting language.

Command discipline is the resolution of disciplinary issues through the **mutual** consent of the accused member and the Chief of Police. This command discipline is in lieu of a formal disciplinary action through the process mandated by Article 5, Title B, Section 75 of the New York State Civil Service Law and the Collective Bargaining Agreement. You have accepted responsibility for your actions and have elected to accept the discipline stipulated in this letter. Command discipline was determined based on the totality of circumstances of this investigation. Several factors were considered including your truthfulness and admissions as well as previous related incidents.

DECLINED. We came to the following resolution.

- A) You accept the findings of the investigation.
- B) You accept responsibility for violating the Departmental Procedural Manual.
- C) You accept the forfeiture of (1) vacation days from your 2020 accrued Time Bank
- D) You accept and understand that in the future, this behavior or any other violation of Departmental Rules or Regulations of a similar nature will be subject to further progressive disciplinary action.

Officer J. Femia:

On May 24, 2019, you were assigned to C Platoon Car 45 / Zone 57 (sole occupant). While operating Car 45 with the patrol vehicle's emergency lights and siren activated, you passed a red light at the intersection of Eagle St. and Elm St. in the City of Utica. After passing the red light, Car 45 was struck by another vehicle operated by The accident caused property damage to both involved vehicles with Car 45 incurring a damage estimate totaling \$3,298. The ensuing accident investigation found that the was unlicensed. Furthermore, the accident investigation faulted for causing the accident in that he failed to yeild to an emergency vehicle. Sgt. Sabanovic handled the associated internal investigation regarding the officer involved motor vehicle accident to determine if departmental policy was violated. The ensuing internal investigation found that you failed to utilize "due care" while operating Car 45 in emergency mode subsequently violating several sections of departmental policy.

As a result of the investigation it was determined that you have violated Department Procedural Manual as follows:

Chapter 4, Article 1 – Patrol Operations

1.14 CARE OF EQUIPMENT:

A. Officers assigned a departmental vehicle shall abide by all policies, procedures, and rules relating to the care, inspection, and maintenance of such vehicle.

Chapter 8, Article 1 – Professional Standards of Conduct and Ethics

- 1.14 PERFORMANCE AND ATTENTION TO DUTY:
- A. General Duties;
- 2. Employees shall perform their duties in a competent manner.
- EE. Departmental Vehicles/Operation/Care/ Personal Use/MV Accident/Reporting;
- 2. Employees shall operate departmental vehicles in a careful and prudent manner, and shall obey all laws and departmental directives pertaining to such operation.
- 1.17 GENERAL RULES OF CONDUCT:
- P. Departmental Property and Equipment;
- 1. Employees shall be held responsible for the proper care and use of departmental property and equipment assigned to or used by them. When obtaining any equipment, and again upon its return, it is the employee's responsibility to inspect it. Employees shall utilize departmental equipment only for its intended purpose.

Subject: Officer involved property damage accident (Officer Femia Unit 57)

On December 27, 2018 Officer James Femia was assigned to car/zone 57. At approximately 2028 hours he was traveling westbound through the St. Agnes Cemetery, located at 601 Arthur Street. Officer Femia stated he was traveling at very low speed when his vehicle started sliding due to extremely icy pavement. Officer Femia applied his brakes, however he was unable to regain control of the vehicle. The vehicle slid forward, hitting the curb and the cemetery sign. the vehicle continued sliding and finally came to rest after it collided with the northeast corner of the cemetery mausoleum. Officer Femia did not sustain any injuries. The driver side airbag deployed. Unit 57 sustained damage to the front driver side bumper and fender. Photographs were secured of the vehicle and the scene. Lt. Holt was notified of the incident. I contacted St. Agnes Cemetery and left a voice mail with my contact information. Unit 55 Officer DeTraglia completed a Tracs accident report. No independent witnesses on scene. Car 57 was towed to hq by Midland Collision. It was taken out of service and parked at the fleet maintenance garage. The supervisor investigation is pending under RMS # 18-52563.

 sound decision making as he has a tendency to make illogical choices that are not in line with SOPs,



Parties

This Agreement is entered into by **James Femia**, herein after referred to as **RELEASOR**/ **INDEMNITOR**, and the City of Utica, herein after referred to as **RELEASEE/INDEMNITEE**.

As used in this Agreement, the term "Releasee/Indemnitee" is hereby defined as the City of Utica, its current, former, or retired officers, employees, elected officials, agents, successors, servants and assigns (in their individual, personal, official, representative, and any other capacities). The term "Releasor/Indemnitor" is hereby defined as James Femia, as well as his heirs, executors, administrators, and assigns.

Recitals

WHEREAS, Releasor/Indemnitor is presently employed with a municipal police department within New York State; and

WHEREAS, Releasor/Indemnitor now desires to accept employment with the Releasee/Indemnitee; and

WHEREAS, Releasor/Indemnitor is willing and desires to indemnify the Releasee/Indemnitee for any legal actions taken against Releasee/Indemnitee arising out of General Municipal Law § 72-c and/or other applicable law; and

WHEREAS, Releasee/Indemnitee makes an offer of employment only on a condition that this Agreement is duly executed;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises and covenants set forth herein, by and between Releasor/Indemnitor and Releasee/Indemnitee, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. For consideration as described above Releasor/Indemnitor agrees to fully indemnify and defend, including reasonable attorney's fees by counsel of Releasee's/Indemnitee's choosing, Releasee/Indemnitee for any and all liabilities, charges, bills, fees, tolls, expenditures, costs, damages, and/or expenses incurred by Releasee/Indemnitee as a result of an action arising out of General Municipal Law § 72-c and/or other applicable law, filed against Releasee/Indemnitee;
- 2. For consideration as described above Releasor/Indemnitor agrees to waive, release, hold harmless and promises never to assert, any and all claims that he has or might have against any Releasee/Indemnitee or their predecessors, successors, the City's current, former, or retired officers, employees, elected officials, agents, successors and assigns (in their individual, personal, official, representative, and any other capacities), whatsoever, including without limitation those arising from or relating to any of the claims, allegations, or incidents that have or could have been asserted in a lawsuit whether known or unknown that arose prior to the date of this Agreement or will arise out of his accepting of employment as contemplated by the parties. Those claims being released

include, but are not limited to, ones arising out of *General Municipal Law § 72-c* and other federal, state and local statutory or common law, as well as any other claim that the Releasor/Indemnitor has or may have against any Releasee/Indemnitee.

- 3. Releasor/Indemnitor waives any rights he might otherwise have had under the New York State Civil Service Law, the New York State Civil Practice Law and Rules, the collective bargaining agreement, or any other provision of law, rule or regulation, with respect to his duty to indemnify, defend and hold harmless the Releasee/Indemnitee.
- 4. Releasor/Indemnitor hereby acknowledges, agrees, represents, warrants, and guarantees that:
 - a. he has read this Agreement and understands its meaning and effect;

Further, this Agreement supersedes any and all other agreements, either oral or in writing, between or among the parties hereto with respect to the subject matter hereof. In addition, any modification of, or waiver of rights under, this Agreement shall be effective only if in writing and signed by the parties.
- 7. In entering into this Agreement, the parties represent that they have relied exclusively on their own (or their respective attorneys) judgment and analysis of the facts, and have not relied on any representations or conditions made by any opposing party.



Those claims being released

include, but are not limited to, ones arising out of *General Municipal Law § 72-c* and other federal, state and local statutory or common law, as well as any other claim that the Releasor/Indemnitor has or may have against any Releasee/Indemnitee.

- 3. 





I would like to thank you and your department for the assistance provided to members of the Rochester Police Department during the month of August 2018. 



Awarded to OFFICER JAMES FEMIA

On August 2nd, 2017, Officer James Femia and Officer Michael Flo were dispatched to regarding a motor vehicle accident involving a child on a bicycle. While the officers were in route, communications advised them that the child was struck by a vehicle and was not breathing.

Officers Femia and Flo arrived on scene, almost simultaneously, and observed a Dodge Durango in the driveway with a bicycle pinned underneath the rear passenger tire. Not far from the vehicle was the injured child. As the officers approached the chaotic scene, they observed a frenzied crowd of bystanders growing larger, screaming for help for the child. At that point, the officers learned the identity of the child.

Without hesitation, Officer Femia applied gloves and started to tend to the child. There was a large amount of blood. Officer Femia checked for a pulse but was unable to locate one. Officer Femia then immediately started to perform CPR on the child with the assistance of the child's mother. Officer Femia provided instructions regarding how to assist him with the CPR process. With the mother breathing into the child, Officer Femia started chest compressions.

While Officer Femia was performing CPR, the crowd around them started to encroach. It was at that time that Officer Flo started crowd control of approximately 50 or more people. Officer Flo continued to advise the crowd to give Officer Femia room to tend to the child. Soon after, a UFD ambulance arrived on scene and without hesitation, Officer Femia carried the child to the ambulance and paramedics for further medical attention.

Officer Femia's quick action to render medical treatment on scene was nothing less than heroic, and Officer Flo's assistance helped contain a chaotic and potentially hostile situation from escalating. These officers bring honor to the Utica Police Department for their heroic and steadfast actions.





On November 4th 2017 at approximately 2345 hrs Car 25, PO Dewey and PO Sheppard attempted to stop a white in color four door vehicle incident to a report of shots fired in the area of the control of the stop. Upon activating their emergency lights the vehicle failed to comply and fled the stop. The subsequent vehicle pursuit ended when the suspect stopped his vehicle at Rutger St and Mohawk St. Based on the circumstances of the incident, Sgt Grande and PO Dewey approached with their service weapons drawn and pointed at The vehicle's door was then opened at which time Sgt Grande and PO Dewey utilized softhand/comealong techniques with a takedown in order to bring the ground to gain a position of advantage. Once on the ground stalled to comply with lawful orders to place his hands behind his back and to stop resisting, at which time PO Sheppard and PO Femia each administered hard hand strikes to the stall shead (Sheppard) and back/torso (Femia). Once officers gained compliance, was taken into custody without further escalation of force.

Summary:

On April 19, 2020 I, Sgt. Dzenan Sabanovic reported to the Utica Police Department for the 1545-0000 hour's shift. I was assigned to car 50 as a patrol supervisor.

At approximately 2022 hours several units responded to the area of regarding disorderly parties. Approximately 20 minutes prior to this incident several units were dispatched to the same location for the same type of incident involving the same individuals. I responded to the area. Upon arrival other units were on scene. I observed three individuals standing in the rain arguing. I now know one of those individual to be did not have a shirt on and he appeared to be intoxicated, belligerent and somewhat aggressive as I observed him clinch his fists several times. and the other two individual were advised several times to leave. The other two individual were somewhat reasonable and eventually left. refused to leave the area after being told multiple times to do so. He made several threatening statements towards myself and other officers on scene. He went over to a vehicle, where his ride was waiting for him. He refused to get in the car and leave the scene. he continued yelling obscenities. I observed several residents in the area looking at inside their front door. Due to us going to the same location twice within 20 minutes and Mosher refusing to disperse the area and continued to cause a disturbance by yelling obscenities I decided that the only way to resolve the situation was to take into custody for disorderly conduct. At this time Officer Schultz and I advised in the was under arrest and to place his hands behind his back. He immediately refused our verbal command by tensing up his arms. I he was under arrest and to place his grabbed a hold of It arm and attempted to put it behind his back, Several other officers came to assist us. Intinued resisting and refused to place his hands behind his

back. I held on to the ground back. I held on to the ground continued to resist by tucking his arms underneath his body. With the assistance of other Officers we were able to pull forms from underneath him and place him in handcuffs.

Officer Femia secured photographs of the scene. Unit 13 responded to the scene and transported HQ. While at HQ I spoke with the stated he was not injured and did not require medical attention. Conduct and Resisting Arrest. He was released with an appearance ticket to the scene and transported to the scene and transported he was not injured and did not require medical attention.

I was not able to locate any independent witnesses on scene

Officer Femia secured pictures of the scene.

I interviewed regarding the response to resistance. He stated he was not injured and did not require medical assistance.

She went on and on about her concerns for her infant, herself and you know "there is a virus out there".....

I said I would report this to you.

The main focus of complaints were in regards to COVID issues and our policy issues in regards to custodial arrests which were explained in detail. The allegation of the Officer telling her to "Shut Up" was unfounded. Was satisfied with the explanations and when asked if there was anything more I could do she stated feels better that we responded to listen to her. After reviewing the incident it appeared that an additional crime was committed last night, however was not charged. Officer Lange was sent back tonight to secure Criminal Trespass charges, which made all parties on scene very satisfied as they are seeking an Order of Protection. No formal Complaint was requested.

PO Lange and PO Femia were both advised regarding this complaint and we discussed better ways to handle / deal with incidents of this nature.
