On December 23, 2016, at approximately 8:00 p.m., car 25, Officers Michael Mahay and Paul Dewey conducted a citizen stop of a person in the Ave. The stop was due to the party failing to use the sidewalk. During the stop, officers observed the suspect blading the right side of his body away from them and constantly touching the right side of his waistband. Officers could also smell a very strong odor of marihuana emanating from his person. As officers approached, the suspect continued to blade his right side, touching the area of his waistband with his forearm and elbow. Due to officer safety concerns, as well as the area being known for a high level of narcotic and firearms activity, Officer Dewey walked toward the suspect stating that he was going to conduct a check of his person due to his actions. The suspect immediately fled from officers, heading north on Dudley Ave. Officers pursued him into a yard, where the suspect slipped and fell in the snow. They then observed him throw a dark colored handgun a short distance away from him and land on top of the frozen snow. He was taken into custody without further incident.

Once in custody, the suspect was found to be in possession of a large quantity of marihuana (12 corner knotted bags, weighing in excess of 25 grams). The handgun was found to be a loaded Smith and Wesson model 59 9mm with one round in the chamber and 11 in the magazine.

This arrest was the result of good police work and seamless teamwork. Officer Mahay's and Officer Dewey's actions took a dangerous individual and an illegal handgun off of the streets of the community. Their actions bring credit to themselves and the entire Utica Police Department.



On August 21, 2017, Investigator Aaron Donaldson and Officers Michael Mahay, Christopher Manion, Paul Dewey, Dennis Basler and Tyler Sheppard were assigned to a GIVE Strike Team detail targeting "Hot Spot" locations of recent shooting incidents in the City of Utica. While in the east Utica area, Investigator Donaldson and Officers Dewey and Mahay observed three known GIVE Offenders riding bicycles in violation of several Vehicle & Traffic Law statutes. The three offenders were known to be associated with a violent group in the city believed to be responsible for multiple recent shots fired incidents. Investigator Donaldson notified Officers Manion, Basler and Sheppard of their observations and intentions to make a stop of the individuals.

Working together, the units made a coordinated effort to track and stop the group several blocks from where they were first observed. When the officers initiated contact, the three males began to flee on foot. One male in particular, who was believed to have been involved in several shooting incidents, was observed discarding a handgun in the roadway as he was fleeing the officers. After a foot pursuit and struggle to handcuff, three of the pursuing officers took the individual into custody. A loaded handgun was recovered and the other two suspects were charged accordingly.

The arrest of the violent gun offender had implications on several other gun-involved incidents in the city. He was ultimately convicted at trial for his crimes and sentenced to several years in prison. The officers' keen observation skills, ability to work as a team, and commitment to combating gun violence removed a violent gun offender from the streets and undoubtedly curbed gun violence in the City of Utica.

On March 28th, 2017, Investigator Aaron Donaldson received information via a confidential informant that four males were walking on and that one of the males was in possession of a sawed-off shotgun.

Investigator Donaldson proceeded to the area, and soon thereafter located the males in question. He relayed his findings to members of the Tactical Unit who were assisting him with this investigation. TAC members Sergeant James Grande, Officer Sean Bubnis, Officer Paul Dewey, Officer Jessica Dodge, Officer Michael Mahay and Officer Kyle Piersall with the assistance of Officer Dennis Basler from C Squad, attempted to conduct a stop of the parties. Two of the males fled toward City Street while the other two were successfully stopped.

During the investigation of the two detained individuals, Officer Basler conducted pat frisks. In doing so, he felt what he soon learned to be a sawed-off shotgun, as described by the informant, in the front of one subject's pants. That individual was immediately arrested, brought to headquarters, and charged with several felonies.

Through excellent team work and officer safety practices, a loaded weapon was removed from the streets and another criminal charged with weapons possession-related offenses.



> On 9/9/17 at about 0245 hours units were dispatched to regarding a male threatening to shoot/kill a female at the residence. > On Thursday November 23rd 2017 PO Dewey responded along with other units to a call for a fight with reports of a male in possession of a handgun. While on scene PO Dewey assisted patrol with dispersing a crowd from the area. While doing so, Lisa A Murdock approached other persons in a violent and tumultuous manner in an attempt to right. PO Dewey stepped between her and the group, advising her to leave the area. As he did so, Murdock threw her right hand back towards PO Dewey striking him in the chest. At that time PO Dewey's BWC (#SPO3) dislodged from his shirt and struck him in the face causing a small abrasion. At that time the BWC fell to the ground and stopped recording. At that time PO Dewey advised Murdock that she was under arrest. As he went to take Murdock into custody she actively resisted her lawful arrest for Harassment 2nd by flailing her arms in an attempt to prevent control. At that time PO Dewey used an empty hand control technique and pinned Murdock to Car 40 by her upper torso/shoulder area in order to gain a position of control. Once he gained the necessary compliance there was no

further escalation of force and Murdock was taken into custody without further incident.

Photographs of the scene, Murdock and PO Dewey were secured by PO Winkler. I responded to HQ where all BWC footage was viewed and tagged. Murdock declined medical attention and denied any injury during my interview. Email notification of the Response to Resistance was completed. Murdock was subsequently charged with Harassment 2nd and Resisting Arrest. PO Dewey declined any medical and declined an Officer Injury/Exposure Report.

Supervisor Investigation form completed. I find the actions of PO Dewey to be justified and in accordance with the UPD policy and NYS PL Acticle 35.

Summary:

On 12/22/17 at about 2250 hours, car 26, PO Dewey and PO Sheppard observed who they know to be Nathaniel Sessome exit a vehicle on Mohawk St and Blandina St. Austin was in contact with car 26 and advised that Sessome had an active warrant from Onondaga County for Violation of Probation, which was extraditable throughout Due to the active warrant, PO Austin began surveillance of the New York State. vehicle so that officer could conduct a stop to take Sessome into custody. At about 2256 hours PO Austin advised that Sessome had re-entered the vehicle and the vehicle began to travel South on Mohawk St toward Rutger St. Car 25, PO Mahay advised that the operator was Anthony Kenny-Oliver and that he had knowledge that he was driving with his driving privileges suspended. A vehicle stop was conducted on Mohawk St just south of Rutger St. The vehicle was a gray Nissan bearing NY Immediately Officers approached both the drivers side and The occupants were identified as Anthony Kenny Oliver (Driver), passenger side. Nathaniel Sessome (Passenger) and Jamar Sessome (rear passenger). Kenny was taken into custody without incident regarding him driving on a suspended license. officers has Nathaniel Sessome exit the vehicle, he was advised that he was under arrest for the open warrant and was placed in handcuffs. Officers used 3 sets of handcuffs, due to officers knowing that Sessome had previously been shot and had little use of his left arm. Once in cuffs Sessome threw himself onto the ground and began screaming that his arm hurt and that officers were assaulting him. At no point were any officers assaulting Sessome. He then immediately became belligerent and screamed that he needed to go the hospital due to pain in his arms. Officers attempted to help him up out of the snow and Sessome again threw himself down to the ground while yelling at the officers that he needed an ambulance. I advised him that we could have an ambulance meet us at the station to evaluate him. He refused and again began screaming that his arm hurt. At this time I notified Dispatch to responded UFD for an evaluation of Sessome on scene. Officers continued to be courteous and explain to Sessome that they had not done anything to him. He then began to flail himself around on the ground and yell that UPD is beating him. At no time were any officers using force against him. Sessome had a very strong odor of an alcoholic beverage on his breath and appeared intoxicated. Officers then again attempted to help him up out of the snow and he began to attempt to hit his head off of the back window of the car saying that officers were doing it to him. At no time were officers hitting Sessomes head into the window. Sessome then again through himself on the ground. UFD arrived on scene to evaluate him. Bianco and Kennedy from UFD treated Sessome. He was belligerent toward them and only continued to scream and be uncooperative. I believed all of his actions up to this point were in an attempt to not be arrested on the warrant and he thought he would go to the hospital and get released. During the entire encounter, Sessome was making false statements that officers were using force and "beating him". I was on scene the entire time of the incident and at no point did officers utilize force and were trying to assist him up and out of the snow.

Once the ambulance arrived on scene, Sessome was transported to St Elizabeth PO Austin, PO Dewey and PO Sheppard also went to the hospital to Hospital. maintain custody of Sessome. I notified Lt Holt in the Squad Commander officers regarding Sessome going to the hospital and he made contact with Onondaga County to arrange transfer of custody. I was advised that it was approved to meet half way

to transfer custody once Sessome was discharged from the hospital.

PO Mahay secured photographs of the scene and attempted to secure photos at the hospital of Sessome but was unsuccessful due to him being totally uncooperative. All photographs were downloaded under RMS number 17-55828.

At the hospital Sessome continued to be loud and belligerent. He was yelling at ER staff and refused certain nurses to assist in treating him. He continually changed what his complaint of pain and injury was. It was his arm then his chest, then he could not breath. Dr. treated Sessome and stated that there were no apparent injuries and diagnosed him with a complaint of pain. Sessome was discharged from the hospital and transported and transferred over to Onondaga County at exit 33 by car 26.

All BWC footage was downloaded and viewed and tagged regarding the incident (7761, 5181, 6723,2342 and 3486). All officers are to complete comprehensive narratives regarding the incident. PO Austin placed copies of the discharged paperwork into records.

On September 22, 2018 Officers Michael Flo and Marissa Vomer were assigned to car/zone 52. At approximately 2057 they conducted a vehicle stop of NYregarding VTL violation. Officer Flo approached the driver, who verbally identified himself as Kelly D. Jones . Officer Vomer was acting as a cover officer and standing on the passenger side of the vehicle. Officer Flo advised Jones regarding false personation. He went back to his vehicle to conduct checks of Mr. Jones. While seated in his patrol vehicle Officer Flo observed and heard Officer Vomer say "stop." Officer Flo observed the driver exit his vehicle and start fleeing from the stop, traveling southwest. He exited his vehicle and started chasing Jones along with his partner Officer Vomer. They ran southwest through the parking lot of 1416 Genesee Street and continued running through the parking lot of 1418 Genesee Street. Once in the southwest corner of the parking lot Officer Vomer was able to grab Jones and utilize a takedown in an attempt to gain control of him. Jones went to the ground but he immediately got back up and started aggressively resisting arrest. He stood back on his feet and turned his body to the right. He reached back and placed his whole right hand on Officer Flo's duty issued handgun. He started pulling up Officer Flo's handgun in an attempt to remove it out of the holster. Officer Flo struck Jones' hand with his hand to get it off of his weapon, however Jones still held on to his handgun. Officer Flo was in fear that Jones was going to remove his handgun out of the holster so he delivered one hard hand strike to Jones' face. Jones let go of Officer Flo's handgun and Officer Flo initiated another takedown. Once on the ground Officers Flo and Vomer attempted to gain control of Jones' arms, however he was actively resisting by placing his hands underneath his body preventing the officers from gaining control of his arms and place him in handcuffs. Jones repeatedly attempted to get up on his feet and breakaway from the officer's grip. At one point Jones was able to overpower the officers and get up on his feet. Officer Flo and Officer Vomer initiated another takedown and brought Jones back to the ground where they continued to struggle with him. Jones continued to aggressively resist arrest by swinging his elbows, flailing his arms and attempting to stand up. During the struggle he elbowed Officer Vomer in the left cheekbone area and Officer Flo in the right shoulder. Officer Vomer placed her handcuffs on Jones' left wrist, however he continued fighting and they were not able to handcuff Jones' right arm. Unable to gain control of Jones Officer Flo delivered approximately 5-6 hard hand strikes to the body and head area. Officer Vomer delivered 2 hard hand strikes to Jones left upper body area. Officer Gray arrived on scene. Officer Gray was on the right side of Jones and he grabbed his right arm in an attempt to pull it behind his back. Officer Gray struggled with Jones who was continuing to actively resist and he was eventually able to break away from his grip and tuck his hand underneath his body. Officer Dewey and Officer Basler arrived on scene. Officer Dewey observed Jones actively resisting arrest. Other officers were struggling with him and did not have control of both of his arms. Officer Gray delivered several hard hand strikes to the right side of Jones' torso. He was able to grab Jones's right hand, and began attempting to place it behind his back, while giving him verbal commands to stop resisting. Officer Dewey observed a lose handcuff on Jones left arm. Fearing that he may use the handcuff as a weapon against Officers Flo, Vomer, Gray and himself Officer Dewey delivered several hard hand strikes to Jones left side of the body and face. Jones then moved his right hand from underneath his body and attempted to push off of the pavement to get up on his feet. Although Jones was still resisting Officer Gray was able to place Jones's right arm behind his back, and place a handcuff on Jones's right wrist. Jones continued to resist by pulling his left hand from underneath his body and attempted to push off of the pavement in order to get the officers off of him and get up on his feet. Officer Dewey observed that one handcuff was open and feared that it could be used as a weapon against them so he delivered several more hand strikes to Jones face area. Upon delivering these strikes Jones stopped aggressively resisting arrest, giving officers the opportunity to pull both of his hands behind his back and handcuff him. After Jones was handcuffed it was determined that his real name was Kristopher D. Jones Officer Basler and Officer Austin assisted other officers with an area check for any discharged

contraband.

Officer Vomer and Officer Flo both lost their body worn cameras during the pursuit. After an extensive search of the area we were able to locate Officer Flo's body worn camera, however Officer Vomer's camera was not located.
