Perfomance - Officer Gomez has shown that when he takes his time and puts forth the effort that he is more than capable of performing at a level that is above average when compared to his peers. However, PO Gomez at times has shown that he can lose focus and/or initiative which conversely tanslate to poor or shotty reports/paperwork.

Interpersonal Skills - Officer Gomez continues to be a well liked and outgoing Officer who interacts well with both, his peers within the department as well as with the general public.

Performance Under Stress - PO Gomez showed good performance under stress when on 12/8/19 he and his partner responded to a report of a shots fired (RMS #19-46512) and while en route they observed a vehicle fleeing the area at a high rate of speed committing several traffic violations. After a brief pursuit of this vehicle PO Gomez and his partner engaged in a foot pursuit of the front passenger subject who was holding what appeared to be a possible handgun at his side. PO Gomez was able to give clear information to other responding units over his radio during his pursuit of the subject. PO Gomez was eventually able to catch up to the subject and arrest same with the help of responding units. The subject who was ultimately in possession of an illegal handgun would not have been apprehended if it were not for Officer Gomez's poise and performance throughout this otherwise intense/stress-filled pursuit.

- Officer Gomez should continue to be a positive example for his peers, especially to newer officers by continuing to show up for work with his positive/upbeat attitude and continue to maintain his high standards of Punctuality and Attendance.

Officer Gomez in his personal vehicle followed this wanted man over ten miles on the NYS thruway while coordinating with the department who was also coordinating with NYSP thruway division until the wanted man was pulled over out past the Westmoreland exit by the NYSP and taken into custody.
