Responsiveness to Supervision - Officer Gomez is always responsive to his supervisors and is willing to take on any task without complaining.

Report Writing Ability - Officer Gomez completes reports in a timely manner and has shown good progress and improvement as far as the fewer number of reports containing spelling/gramatical errors that need to be corrected after being reviewed by supervisors.

Perfomance - Officer Gomez has shown that when he takes his time and puts forth the effort that he is more than capable of performing at a level that is above average when compared to his peers. However, PO Gomez at times has shown that he can lose focus and/or initiative which conversely tanslate to poor or shotty reports/paperwork.

Interpersonal Skills - Officer Gomez continues to be a well liked and outgoing Officer who interacts well with both, his peers within the department as well as with the general public.

Performance Under Stress - PO Gomez showed good performance under stress when on 12/8/19 he and his partner responded to a report of a shots fired (RMS #19-46512) and while en route they observed a vehicle fleeing the area at a high rate of speed committing several traffic violations. After a brief pursuit of this vehicle PO Gomez and his partner engaged in a foot pursuit of the front passenger subject who was holding what appeared to be a possible handgun at his side. PO Gomez was able to give clear information to other responding units over his radio during his pursuit of the subject. PO Gomez was eventually able to catch up to the subject and arrest same with the help of responding units. The subject who was ultimately in possession of an illegal handgun woulld not have been apprehended if it were not for Officer Gomez's poise and performance throughout this otherwise intense/stress-filled pursuit.



In connection with my appointment as a Police Officer for the City of Utica, New York for the Spring 2017 Academy, I, Steven Comez (print name), do hereby agree to the following:

- I understand and agree that, should I voluntarily terminate my employment with the City of Utica Police Department for any reason other than health related, within three (3) years of my date of hire (as listed above), I will be responsible for reimbursing the City of Utica for the cost of any uniforms or equipment issued to me by the City of Utica, as well as for the cost of all preemployment processing expenses including the medical exam, drug testing, psychological testing, and polygraph testing. The amount of such reimbursement will be determined by the price in effect on the date of my hire. Current prices are listed on the attached sheet.
- In addition to the above, should I voluntarily terminate employment within five (5) years of my date of hire for the purpose of accepting other employment in law enforcement, I will be required to reimburse a percentage of my wages earned while at the Mohawk Valley Police Academy, in accordance with the attached schedule.

I also understand and agree that in the event of my voluntary termination, recovery of such monies owed may result in the City of Utica commencing a legal action to collect any money owed to the City of Utica under this Contract. I further agree that, in the event that I voluntarily terminate my employment as a City of Utica Police Officer within either of the two time periods set forth above, the City of Utica shall be permitted to initiate automatic payroll garnishment of any or all accumulated remaining time balances <u>e.g.</u>, <u>vacation time</u>, <u>sick time</u>, <u>personal leave</u>, <u>and holiday pay</u>. If that amount is not sufficient to cover the total cost, I agree to fulfill my obligation to pay any remaining unpaid balances.
