



Sir,

On 07/27/2020 patrol units responded to the area of 312 Blandina St relative to a reported domestic in which a male pointed a handgun at a female.

While in the area, Sgt Cimpi located a male matching the description of the suspect still in the area. Upon being stopped, the male discarded a book bag and fled on foot from Sgt Cimpi. During the ensuing foot pursuit; I, along with members of patrol surrounded the area. After a brief foot pursuit I was able to apprehend the suspect and was quickly assisted by PO Morinitti and PO Jukic in taking the male into custody. The male would later be identified as Brandon McNair.

Upon conducting a backtrack of the pursuit, Sgt Cimpi and PO Rejrat located a loaded and defaced .380 handgun. Video evidence would later be collected showing the male discarding the firearm during the pursuit.

PO DeTraglia secured the discarded book bag which was later found to contain contraband consisting of narcotics pills.

I would like to make note in each respective officers e-file relative to their efforts in taking McNair into custody and removing an illegal handgun from the streets.

I just wanted to take a moment to say thank you for The Utica Police Department's assistance to The New Hartford Police Department in locating a wanted subject sought by our department for Criminal Contempt In The First Degree.

On September 13th, 2019 we investigated a [REDACTED] here in the Town that resulted in a Criminal Contempt Charge due to a court order that the suspect stay away from two juvenile children. The suspect, [REDACTED] refused to surrender himself afterward and an Arrest Warrant was subsequently issued for him.

Information was developed that he began to move around to stay at different residences other than his know address in Utica in order to evade us. I reached out to Investigator Cerminaro in your Warrants Unit to let him know of our warrant and our interest in this person. 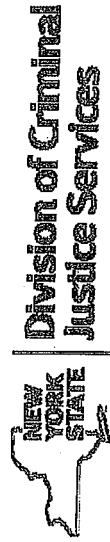

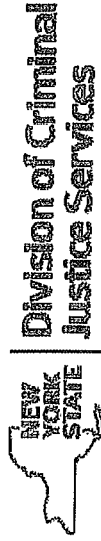

When they went to take her into custody for the warrants she resisted arrest and PO's Rejrat and Fee utilized soft hand techniques and a come along to place her in custody and handcuff her. There was a witness [REDACTED] on-scene who informed me that Gary was aggressive towards the officers. [REDACTED] is presently being deposed by PO Morinitti. There were no injuries to either Gary or the officers. Gary has a history of hostility towards law enforcement as evidenced in RMS. No complaints associated with this response to resistance.

On July 8, 2018 at around 1435 hours Cars 53 (PO Rejrat) and Car 52 (PO Sweet) were dispatched to [REDACTED] regarding a female out of control and threatening suicide. Upon the officers arrival they were met by the female's parents [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] who were actively restraining her due to her violent behavior. They identified the female as [REDACTED] and stated she has a history of Bi-Polar Disorder and she frequently gets violent when she is off her medication, which she currently was. [REDACTED] was threatening suicide and homicide and was deemed to fit MHL 9.41 criteria. While waiting for UFD's arrival, and even once they arrived, [REDACTED] continued to be physically combative with her family, officers, and the firefighters. [REDACTED] had to be restrained by the officers and firefighters until she was medicated and passed out. Both PO Rejrat and PO Sweet completed Response to Resistance reports due to them having to physically restrain [REDACTED] for an extended period of time.

On September 24, 2018 PO Morinitti was assigned to Car/Zone 52 and took a [REDACTED]. After investigating the incident PO Morinitti had domestic charges against the suspect, [REDACTED], for Harassment 2nd, Criminal Mischief and Endangering the Welfare of a Child. PO Morinitti then returned with the victim to the front of her residence [REDACTED] where he made contact with the suspect. The victim advised [REDACTED] was under arrest for the Harassment and PO Morinitti attempted to take [REDACTED] into custody at which time [REDACTED] tensed up his body and attempted to get away from PO Morinitti. PO Morinitti, PO Rejrat, and PO Ambrose then took hold of [REDACTED] by the arms and completed a take-down maneuver, putting [REDACTED] on his stomach on the sidewalk. They all advised [REDACTED] several times that he was under arrest, to put his hands behind his back, and to stop resisting. While PO Rejrat and PO Ambrose attempted to get [REDACTED] hands behind his back and secured in handcuffs, PO Morinitti utilized a head pin maneuver to keep [REDACTED] under control and on the ground. After a short time [REDACTED] was secured in handcuffs and placed in the rear of Car 52. No witnesses to the incident. [REDACTED] sustained a scrape to his bottom lip while he was on the sidewalk. Same was treated by UFD at HQ.

This afternoon, at approximately 1030 hours, Officer Rejrat responded to the St. Luke's Hospital Psychiatric Unit regarding a female ([REDACTED]), who was being released from their facility, that had an open/valid warrant out of our agency. Upon arrival, St. Luke's Security Officer Gabriel escorted [REDACTED] out of the Psychiatric Unit; Officer Rejrat advised her that she had a warrant and that she was under arrest. [REDACTED] immediately began yelling that she was not going to be arrested and was not going to with Officer Rejrat. Officer Rejrat gave several loud audible commands for [REDACTED] to put her hands behind her back, but she did not comply with Officer Rejrat's orders. [REDACTED] then attempted to flee by turning her body away from Officer Rejrat and start to run toward a pair of Exit doors. At that point Officer Rejrat grabbed [REDACTED], advised her to stop resisting, and pinned her against a wall to prevent her from exiting out of the doors. Officer Rejrat continued to tell [REDACTED] to stop resisting and for her to give him her hands, but [REDACTED] continued to resist by flailing and pulling her arms from Officer Rejrat's grasps. At that point Officer Rejrat, with the assistance of Gabriel, executed a takedown of [REDACTED] in order to gain a position of advantage. While on the ground [REDACTED] continued to resist by stiffening her arms, preventing Officer Rejrat from handcuffing the same, and also by kicking her legs. After a brief struggle Officer Rejrat was able to handcuff [REDACTED] the rear and she was taken into custody without any further incident. On Friday, May 31, 2019, I, Sergeant Samuel M. Geddes reported to the Utica Police Department for the 0745 to 1600 hours shift. I was assigned to the Uniform Patrol Division as a "B" Platoon street supervisor in SUV 40, attired in full uniform, under the command of "B" Platoon Squad Commander, Lt. S. Dougherty.

At about 1019 hours, Car 54, PO T. Duval was dispatched to Family Dollar, 1711 Genesee Street for a larceny in progress. Upon PO Duval's arrival he called out with a failure to comply. Channel 1 was cleared and I was advised that the speed was 40 MPH and that the vehicle stop was related to the larceny investigation. Martin, [REDACTED] stopped her vehicle at the light at which time PO Duval and PO S. Rejrat (Car 53) went to the vehicle, performed a takedown of Jennifer Martin, while PO C. Manion (Car 55) approached the front seat passenger, Alex J. Martin, [REDACTED] removed him from the vehicle and took him to the ground. Both Martin's were handcuffed without further incident.

Once on scene I spoke with both Alex and Jennifer Martin (BWC 3295), J. Martin complained of an abrasion to her right knee, A. Martin had no physical complaints, however he stated that his cell phone got scratched. J. Martin said she was alright and declined medical attention. I explained the notice of claim process to A. Martin. Photos secured.

Relative to this investigation J. Martin was charged with the larceny and Vehicle and Traffic Law violations. It was determined that A. Martin was not a co-conspirator in the larceny and was released with no charges.

Photos of both Alex and Jennifer Martin where secured by me and placed in the crime scene photo file under RMS # 19-19479.

This morning, at approximately 0956 hours, units were dispatched to [REDACTED] to assist Kunkel Ambulance with a male party who was refusing to be transported to the hospital. Upon arrival I met with Kunkel personnel who advised me that they were called to transport [REDACTED] due to him possibly having a medical issue, and once [REDACTED] was inside the ambulance he became non-compliant and fled back to his apartment. I was advised that [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] I was advised that [REDACTED] appeared to be confused and could not respond correctly to questions that were being asked of him. I proceeded to interview [REDACTED] who was clearly disoriented stating that he did not know where he was, that he was not human, that he could not see or move, and that he was both big and small. While I was speaking with [REDACTED] he exhibited sporadic erratic behavior as he would jump up to his knees and then lay back down several times. Based on the interview of [REDACTED] did not meet the criteria for MHL 9.41 custody and the Kunkel personnel was advised of the same. At this time PO Rejrat, RPO Striker, and PO Ciotti arrived on scene and all attempted to reason with [REDACTED] but he continued to be non-compliant with going to the hospital. Based on [REDACTED] medical / mental health history and his current behavior Kunkel contacted St [REDACTED]



of [REDACTED] Kunkel then confirmed that the ER doctor signed a [REDACTED] for [REDACTED], and further advised that they were going to give him some medication via injection in order to calm him down. We advised [REDACTED] that he had to go to the hospital and he became verbally non-compliant as he advised us that he was not going to go to the hospital. [REDACTED] son even attempted to pick [REDACTED] up and escort him to the transport chair, but [REDACTED] became dead weight and threw himself on his couch. Due to [REDACTED] unpredictable behavior, his verbal non-compliance, and the fact that Kunkel was going to administer a shot [REDACTED] was advised that he was going to be handcuffed. PO Ciotti, PO Rejrat, and RPO Striker then attempted to handcuff [REDACTED] immediately started to resist by verbally stating that he did not want to be handcuffed and then he actively resisted by flailing his arms, holding them underneath his body, and stiffening his arms preventing the officers from handcuffing him to the rear. PO Rejrat, PO Ciotti, and PO Striker all administered empty hand controls in attempt to handcuff [REDACTED] but he continued to actively resist. I then administered an empty hand head control in order to assist the officers with gaining a position of advantage. After a brief struggle [REDACTED] was handcuffed to the rear and seated on the floor. [REDACTED] continued to resist the officers by passively sitting on the floor and refusing to go with Kunkel. At that point PO Rejrat, PO Ciotti, and PO Striker administered an empty hand come along and placed [REDACTED] on Kunkel's transport chair. [REDACTED] was then transported downstairs, but he continued to resist attempting to squirm out of the transport chair. While in the front vestibule [REDACTED] was able to partially slip out of transport chair. At that point PO Rejrat, PO Ciotti, RPO Striker, and I removed [REDACTED] from the transport chair and carried him to the stretcher. [REDACTED] was then placed on the stretcher and escorted to the ambulance.

[REDACTED] sustained a minor abrasion to his right hands as a result of the handcuffs rubbing on his hand. Subsequently, [REDACTED] was transported to St. Luke's Hospital as a result of the 9.45 MHL custody.

This afternoon, at approximately 1319 hours, units were dispatched to [REDACTED] regarding an attempted burglary that had just occurred. Communications advised the responding units that there were two black male suspects that were currently fleeing the area eastbound on Erie St. Car 52 (PO Mowers) and Car 53 (PO Rejrat) responded to the area and immediately intercepted two black males, who met the description of the suspects provided by Communications, at the intersection of Erie St & Andes Ave. Upon approaching one of the males, later identified as [REDACTED] PO Rejrat immediately advised [REDACTED] to cease his movement, approached him, and advised him to put his hands behind his back. PO Rejrat then attempted to detain [REDACTED], and at that point [REDACTED] immediately began actively resisting by stiffening his arms and preventing PO Rejrat from handcuffing him. At approximately 0813 hours, Car 53 (PO S. Rejrat) and Car 51 (PO S. Berger) responded to the Family Dollar, 1000 Court Street regarding a trespass in progress and that the subject in question was a black female wearing an orange backpack, who had left the scene on foot towards Varick Street, which would be East of the Family Dollar. I now know the black female wearing the orange backpack to be, Keri R. Stuckey, [REDACTED] While conducting an area check for Stuckey, PO Rejrat located her at the intersection of Stark Street and Warren Street. PO Rejrat exited his vehicle, engaged Stuckey in conversation, and seeing that she was armed with a pocket knife that was clipped to her pocket, he attempted to disarm her by trying to grab the knife from her pocket. Stuckey reached down stopping PO Rejrat from securing the knife, at this time PO Berger arrived and Stuckey pulled the knife from her pocket, displayed it and told the officers to back up, at which time both PO Rejrat and PO Berger pointed their issued duty weapons at Stuckey, who started to retreat Southbound on Stark Street. Stuckey, PO Berger and PO Rejrat all moved on foot South and then East on McVean Street.

Sometime during this, PO Berger transitioned to Taser, PO Rejrat had lethal cover. As the three approached the vacant lot that would be [REDACTED] it was evident that Stuckey had put the knife away at some point, so both PO Rejrat and PO Berger holstered their respective weapons and performed a take down. On 2/4/19 at approximately 1246 hours car 53, Ptlm. Rejrat was dispatched to 916 Harper St for a Peace Officer. CO/VI Debra Williams ( [REDACTED] ) called regarding her Suspended License Plates that were on Natyah Dawsons ( [REDACTED] ) vehicle. Williams showed proof of ownership and was advised to retrieve her plates. Rejrat then spoke with Dawson about Williams retrieving her plates. Dawson immediately disagreed about the issue and started to aggressively approach William on the sidewalk and gave clear indicators she was going to attack Williams. Williams had a screwdriver in her hand, and Rejrat stepped in front of Dawson and gave her loud commands to "Stop" so the situation would not escalate. Dawson ignored Rejrat's commands and went around him and grabbed Williams by the hair and struck her. Rejrat continued to tell Dawson to Stop which she ignored. Rejrat then grabbed Dawson around the head and pulled her to the ground while she continued to strike Williams. Several other parties were trying to intervene and Rejrat again told Dawson to stop and let go of Williams. She would not comply so he held her down and announced that OC spray would be deployed should she not comply. The announcement appeared to gain compliance and Williams was immediately cuffed to the rear. Rejrat advised her she would be under arrest regarding Disorderly Conduct. She stated she was not injured and photos were secured. BWC Footage tagged.

No injuries or complaints were reported. Williams was booked and released on appearance tickets for harassment 2nd and disorderly conduct. Response to resistance form completed by PO Rejrat. Response to Resistance investigation initiated under RMS 20-3891.

Greetings,

This morning, at approximately 0922 hours, units were dispatched to 1038 Court St regarding a report of a male party attempting to steal beer off the back of a delivery truck. Upon units arrival they encountered Mizziah Murray [REDACTED] who was highly intoxicated and causing a disturbance outside of the Court St Market. Murray was threatening PO Fitzgerald, PO Rejrat, and PO Dodge stating that he had the Coronavirus and that he was going to spit on the officers. Murray was acting in a tumultuous way yelling and screaming obscenities towards the officers, coughing towards the officers, spitting on the ground and in the direction of the officers, licking his hands, and threatening that he would contaminate the officers. PO Fitzgerald, PO Rejrat, and PO Dodge attempted numerous times to disperse Murray from the area advising him that if he did not leave he would be arrested for Disorderly Conduct, but he refused to leave, he littered his Styrofoam coffee cup on the ground, and he attempted to go into the corner store from which he was advised that he was no longer welcome for the day. The officers then escorted Murray out of the store, and at that point Murray took an aggressive stance towards the officers, stated that he was not going to leave, and further stated that he was going to get them sick. PO Rejrat, PO Fitzgerald, and PO Dodge then advised Murray that he was going to be arrested for Disorderly Conduct and they approached him. Due to Murray's behavior throughout the incident, PO Rejrat and PO Fitzgerald utilized an empty hand come along, by grabbing his arms, to escort Murray to the rear of Car 52 and gain a position of advantage while PO Dodge placed Murray's hands behind his back, and further handcuffed his hands. While Murray was handcuffed he attempted to spit again, thus resulting in PO Rejrat grabbing his head / hair and re-directing his head to prevent Murray from spitting on the officers. PO Dodge then obtained a spit hood and placed it over Murray's head. PO Rejrat and PO Fitzgerald then attempted to place Murray in the rear of Car 52 but he began actively resisting by stiffening his body preventing the officers from having him sit in the back seat. Due to Murray's resistance PO Fitzgerald went to the rear passenger side and utilized an empty hand come along by grabbing Murray by his handcuffs and pulling him while PO Rejrat pushed on his legs to get him seated correctly in the rear of Car 52.

Once Murray was seated in the rear of Car 52 PO Fitzgerald took him to headquarters and turned him over to the booking officer (PO Fanelli) and chauffer (PO Santana). While in the booking area Murray continued to act disorderly, threatening the officers, and trying and cough in the direction of PO Fanelli, PO Fitzgerald, and the other male prisoner who was seated on the bench. In order to prevent any further possible contamination and separate Murray from the other male prisoner PO Fitzgerald began escorting Murray from the bench to the Cage. While PO Fitzgerald was escorting Murray he continued to make threats towards the officers, twist his body, and attempt to pull away from PO Fitzgerald. At that point PO Fanelli assisted PO Fitzgerald and utilized an empty hand takedown by grabbing Murray in the rear base of his neck placing him on the bench in the cage, and holding his head turned away from the officers to prevent Murray from further coughing in the direction of the officers. After Murray was placed on the bench in the cage PO Fitzgerald removed the handcuffs, and he was secured in the same without any further incident.

Due to Whitton not filing the complaint, I completed a basic complaint form myself and turned it over to the Professional Standards Office.

When Officer Rejrat concludes his interaction with Whitton, he says "Fuck". This is not language that should be utilized during calm interactions with citizens or suspects.

## **II. Review of applicable rules & regulations, orders and operating procedures or laws:**

This use of profanity is in violation of Utica Police Department Chapter 8, Article 1, Section 1.14 (G) Sub Section 2. Employees shall be courteous, respectful and professional at all times, toward citizens, members of the department and individuals representing other organizations, in all forms of communications in the performance of their duties.

## **III. Employee's response to the performance deficiency:**

## **IV. Clearly explain the behavior expected of the member:**

It is expected of officers not to utilize profanity unless there are extenuating circumstances and the officer feels the language is necessary in that exact moment. One example, would be a suspect not complying with verbal commands while at gunpoint.

The continued use of unnecessary profanity, if substantiated, could result in negative discipline and may include (but is not limited to) reprimand, loss of time or pay, or other measures deemed appropriate.

## Personnel Complaint

On 06/23/2020 I reported to the Patrol Division for the 0745- 1600 hours shift. I was assigned to Car 53 /Zone 53, a marked patrol vehicle, attired in full uniform, Per the Squad Commander Lt Murphy.

At around 1445 hours I responded to the area of Broadway St and Columbia St to investigate a stolen property incident. When I arrived on scene I activated my BWC # 7035 per department policy. During the course of the investigation probable cause was developed to arrest Patricio Whitton [REDACTED] regarding NYS PL 165.40, Criminal Possession of Stolen Property 5th. See arrest report 20-22411 for arrest details.

During this investigation Sgt Perra and PO Castilla were assisting me. They had to clear for an in progress call. At the conclusion of the arrest I released Whitton from handcuffs and he was issued an APTK per Covid 19 Policy. Also due to Covid 19 policy, I was wearing a department issued face covering during the entire incident. I verbally warned Whitton should I see him in the city again with stolen property he would have problems. While speaking with Whitton he again started to communicate to me the same less than believable story he had been telling me through the investigation while showing me something on his phone. At this point I became disinterested in continuing to speak with Whitton as the investigation had concluded and he was free to go. In frustration, I made a comment to myself and said "Fuck this" which was captured on my BWC. I then shut my BWC off as I was done with this interaction and started to walk away to my patrol car which was parked in the street

**SUBJECT:**

A few minutes passed and I continued to sit in my patrol car and process paperwork and wait for the tow truck to leave. Whitton approached my driver's side window and asked for my name. I reactivated my BWC and told Whitton my name was on the appearance ticket should he need it. He then asked for his license back which I still had inadvertently in my possession. I gave him his license back immediately. He then started to photograph me and say Louis Brindisi is his lawyer and this is not over. He then stated that he is calling Lt Dougherty to report me. I nodded to him to go ahead. I rolled my window up and continued with my paperwork. I turned my BWC off as I did not speak with anyone else and left the scene to go to PHQ.

When I returned to PHQ at shift change Sgt Perra summonsed me to the squad commanders office. He inquired if I had said something to Whitton that would cause him to file a complaint. I advised him of the above conversation, and that was maybe what he referring to? Sgt Perra advised me that Whitton accused me of using a racially derogatory term by calling him "Spic" under my breath. I then advised Sgt Perra that I made no such comment and that I could not attest to what he was referring to. I was then made aware Whitton posted the photo he took of me and placed it on Facebook calling me a racist cop and making accusations I called him a "Spick".

I was advised to complete an interagency memo regarding this incident.

On the 23rd day of June 2020, I reported to work for the 0800 to 1600 hour shift, assigned to Car 50, under the command of Lt. Michael Murphy.

**Summary:**

On June 23rd 2020, Officer Stanley Rejrat responded to Broadway Street and Columbia Street to investigate a vehicle with stolen license plates. The stolen license plates activated a hit on one of the Utica Police license plate readers. Rejrat responded to the scene and located a 1999 Gray Dodge Durango parked on the side of the road, unoccupied. Attached to the same Dodge Durango was two license plates, New York registration [REDACTED]. That current location is a construction site for the new hospital. Rejrat inquired with the site supervisor who was operating the Dodge Durango in question. The construction workers stated they would send out the individual who owned the vehicle. At that time, Patricio G. Whitton [REDACTED] emerged from the construction site. Whitton claimed that the Dodge Durango was his vehicle but he did not drive it to the job site. Whitton claimed his sister drove it to the job site. After further investigation it was learned that Whitton did drive the vehicle to the job site and he was subsequently charged with Criminal Possession of Stolen Property. Whitton was arrested on scene, but due to the COVID precautions, he was issued an appearance ticket. When Officer Rejrat was removing the handcuffs, Whitton claimed that Rejrat threatened him with arrest anytime he observes him on the street. Whitton also made the claim that Rejrat called him a "Spic". Whitton called the station at a later time to report his account of the incident. I spoke with Whitton and told him I would investigate the matter further.

**Investigative Facts:**

On June 23rd 2020, Officer Stanley Rejrat responded to Broadway Street and Columbia Street to investigate a vehicle with stolen license plates. The stolen license plates activated a hit on one of the Utica Police license plate readers. Rejrat responded to the scene and located a 1999 Gray Dodge Durango parked on the side of the road, unoccupied. Attached to the same Dodge Durango was two license plates, New York registration [REDACTED]. That current location is a construction site for the new hospital. Rejrat inquired with the site supervisor who was operating the Dodge Durango in question. While on scene the supervisor notified Patricio G. Whitton. When Officer Rejrat first made contact with Whitton he tried to distance himself from the vehicle by throwing the keys to a coworker and denying it was his car. Whitton then claimed he uses the vehicle but he didn't drive to the construction site. Whitton claimed that his sister drove him to the construction site. Whitton also stated that he put the license plates on the Durango last year. This is physically impossible because the license plates were stolen two nights prior. So Whitton lied about the license plates and he continues to lie during the entire investigation. Such as the false claim that his sister drove him to the construction site. Officer Rejrat spoke with employee Mathew Walrath, who stated he observed Whitton arrive to the construction site in the Dodge Durango. Walrath

provided a supporting deposition that he observed Whitton arrive to work that same day, driving the Durango. Walrath stated that Whitton has been using that Dodge Durango for at least a month. During the investigation, Whitton continued to ask for Lieutenant Sean Dougherty, and claimed that he knew him. When I asked Lieutenant Dougherty if he knew Whitton, he stated that he did not know him.

Whitton's Dodge Durango was not registered and had no insurance. Due to the vehicle not being properly registered or insured, it was towed from the scene by Nimey's Automotive.

When returning to the Utica Police Station, I received a call from Whitton on the phone in the office. Whitton stated that after all the police officers left the scene, it was just him and Officer Rejrat. Whitton claimed that Rejrat threatened to arrest him if he sees him in the city, and he also accused Rejrat of calling him a "Spic". Whitton told me on the phone that he had witnesses of Rejrat calling him a Spic. I explained to Whitton that the officers are equipped with body worn cameras. I told Whitton that I was going to immediately watch the camera footage and call him back. I reviewed the footage of the interaction between Rejrat and Whitton. When reviewing the body worn camera footage, Whitton was trying to give explanations to why he had no insurance and no registration, but it was obvious to Rejrat that he was lying. You can tell that Officer Rejrat was starting to get frustrated with Whitton because he feels he was lying to him. You hear Rejrat say "If I find you in the city stealing shit again, you are going to have a problem." This is the statement that I believe Whitton took as a "threat". When watching the entire body camera footage, I never hear Rejrat call Whitton a Spic. At the end of the conversation, Rejrat gets frustrated and says "Fuck it" and walks away. Rejrat turns his camera off and walks back to his patrol car. Shortly after, Officer Rejrat reactivates his camera because Whitton walked back over to his patrol vehicle. You can hear Whitton on camera telling Rejrat that his coworkers just heard what he said and he will be reporting him to Lieutenant Dougherty. That is when Whitton took a picture of Rejrat sitting inside his patrol car.

I tried to call Whitton back multiple times that day and I could not get a hold of him. Due to the nature of the accusation I initiated a supervisor investigation.

The next day (June 24th) I responded back to Broadway Street and Columbia Street with Lieutenant Holt to speak with Whitton further. When speaking with Whitton he continued to make the claim that Officer Rejrat threatened him and called him a "Spic". I then informed Whitton that I watched the body worn camera footage and I never heard Rejrat call him a Spic. This is when Whitton started to change his story that Officer Rejrat said the word Spic more softly and it was barely audible. Whitton then went on further to state that he could observe Rejrat "mouth" the word Spic. I asked Whitton the exact time that Officer Rejrat called him a Spic and he stated it happened within one minute of being released from handcuffs. When watching the video, there were multiple discrepancies with Whitton's claim. Whitton claims that Rejrat called him a Spic within one minute of being released from handcuffs. After review of the video, you never hear Rejrat call Whitton a Spic in that timeframe or during the entire video. The other major issue is that Whitton claimed he observed Rejrat "mouth" the word Spic. However, through reflections and other body worn camera footage, it was learned that Rejrat was wearing a medical mask, making it impossible for Whitton to observe him "mouthing" anything. When reviewing the body worn camera footage Rejrat states "If I find you in the city stealing shit again you're going to have a problem." During the end of the interview Rejrat does get noticeably frustrated because he feels that Whitton is continually lying to him. Rejrat is on camera asking Whitton "Do you want to be somewhat honest with me." When Whitton continues to tell his story, Rejrat gets frustrated, says "Fuck it", and starts to walk away. At this time Rejrat shuts his camera off and walks back to his car. While Rejrat is sitting in his vehicle, Whitton walks over to speak with Officer Rejrat again, so Rejrat reactivates his body worn camera. Whitton tells Rejrat "My coworkers and those guys heard what you said, and I will let lieutenant Dougherty know."

Prior to speaking with Whitton on June 24th, we spoke with several employees on scene. I spoke with Kevin Callahan who was flagging traffic that day. Callahan stated he saw the police on scene the day prior, but did not hear the conversation. I spoke with Mathew Walrath, a site supervisor who provided the supporting deposition that Whitton drove to the construction site that day. Walrath stated he did not hear the conversation between Whitton and Officer Rejrat. I also spoke with site workers Ryan Mulholland and Jessica Theopold, both told me they did not hear the conversation between Whitton and Officer Rejrat. Finally, I spoke with Timothy Sheldon, the tow

truck driver from Nimey's Automotive, who was on scene and would have been in the best position to hear any type of conversation between the two. Sheldon stated that he did not hear the conversation between Officer Rejrat and Patricio Whitton. Sheldon stated that it appeared the officers were being respectful towards Whitton and were not raising their voices. Sheldon stated after the police left, Whitton approached him and told him that the officer called him a "Stupid fucking Spic." Once again, another claim that directly contradicts Whitton's accusation. Whitton told me over the phone that Officer Rejrat called him a "Spic", but told the tow truck driver he called him a "Stupid fucking Spic."

On June 25th I made contact with Whitton in person again. I told Whitton that I would like him to file a complaint in writing, but he stated he did not feel comfortable coming to the station. I told Whitton that he could also file the complaint online on the Utica Police Department website. Whitton told me that he would rather file the complaint online than go to the station. The aforementioned conversation was also captured on my body worn camera. On July 9th Whitton came to the station, requesting to speak to me about the complaint. Whitton brought an entourage of people with him during his visit. The group Whitton brought to the station were learned to be the Utica Abolitionists'. Whitton was informed that I was off on this particular day, so he wouldn't be able to speak to me. However, Sgt. Star Rae Wooden gave Whitton a hard copy complaint form so he could fill it out and turn it back in. When I came into work on July 11th I tried to contact Whitton on the phone, and I left him a message to call me. When Whitton was at the station on July 9th, there was a claim that nothing was being done about his complaint. This is more false information because I talked to Whitton on three consecutive days about the complaint, June 23rd, 24th, and 25th. During those interactions it was explained to Whitton that the incident is being investigated and would take some time. Whitton was also encouraged to complete a formal complaint in writing. Whitton did provide me his verbal complaint on June 23rd, and I initiated the investigation that day. I asked Whitton several times that I would like him to complete a formal written complaint, which I cannot force him to do. At this time Whitton has been given all the means and opportunities to file the written complaint.

This complaint did involve some social media activity, which I would like to briefly describe. On the day the incident occurred, Patricio Whitton posted on Facebook a picture of Officer Rejrat sitting in his police car. On this post, Whitton writes that Rejrat threatened him and called him a Spic. This did cause Officer Rejrat some scrutiny on the street. The social media post spread to the point where people on the street were saying "Oh, you're the racist cop." Then on June 11th, "LoveandRageMedia" posted an article about Whitton's encounter with Officer Rejrat. This article mimicked Whitton's claim that Rejrat threatened him and called him a Spic. That same night, the Utica Abolitionist group turned their course and wrote an additional post denouncing Patricio Whitton. The social justice group received information that Whitton had a history of abusing woman and "grooming young girls." The group apologized for providing a platform for Whitton and they deleted the article they posted on the website. Then on July 12th, a Jose Columa came to the station and provided me paperwork in regards to Patricio Whitton. The paperwork included text message screen shots of Whitton calling Columa and his children Spics. All social media evidence was included in the investigative packet.

#### Investigative Findings:

This investigation is based off two complaints from Mr. Whitton. The first complaint is that Officer Rejrat threatened him in a manner he felt was inappropriate. The second complaint is that Officer Stanley Rejrat called him a "Spic." Officer Rejrat told Whitton "If I find you in the city stealing shit again you're going to have a problem" I don't see this statement as being egregious or directly threatening. I see this statement as being a verbal deterrence from breaking the law. There is no threat to his person or threat to unfairly persecute him. Officer Rejrat gave Whitton a stern warning that if he caught him breaking the law, he would take action, which is his job. To cover the racial slur portion of the complaint, I never hear Rejrat call Whitton a Spic on the body worn camera footage. Through this investigation, I uncovered some concerning issues with Patricio Whitton and his credibility. As result of this investigation, I discovered that Whitton was untruthful multiple times and lacked candor. There was an overwhelming amount of evidence that Whitton was trying to be intentionally deceptive. The lies all started at the beginning of the investigation when Whitton stated he put the plates on his vehicle last year. The aforementioned statement is false because the plates were stolen two nights prior to June 23rd. Whitton

then made claims to know Lieutenant Sean Dougherty, when I asked Dougherty he stated he did not know Whitton. On the body worn camera footage, Whitton claims there were witnesses that heard Rejrat called him a Spic. After conducting multiple interviews (On body worn camera) it was learned no witnesses heard anything. Whitton's complaint was made to me verbally on June 23rd. On June 24, Whitton told me that everybody left before Rejrat called him a Spic. On the 24th of June I told Whitton that I watched the body worn camera footage and never heard Rejrat call him a Spic. This is when Whitton changed his story, insisting Rejrat said it very low and under his breath. Then Whitton proceeded to tell me that Rejrat "mouthed" the word Spic to him. This is when I knew Whitton was lying because Officer Rejrat was wearing a medical mask. Whitton claimed that Rejrat called him a Spic around one minute after being taken out of handcuffs. When watching the video, this accusation does not hold water. Rejrat is never on camera calling Whitton a Spic around this specific timeframe nor any time during their interaction. When I spoke with Timothy Sheldon from Nimey's Automotive, he stated Whitton told him that Rejrat called him a "Stupid Fucking Spic." This is yet another discrepancy in his accusations. My investigation yielded that there was no proof of Officer Rejrat calling Patricio Whitton a Spic. Furthermore, my investigation found severe credibility and character issues with Mr. Whitton. Patricio Whitton was upset he was arrested and had ulterior motives for making this claim. One motive was trying to garner attention and sympathy on social media.

To conclude, I determined the complaint against Officer Rejrat to be unfounded. There were no inappropriate threats made toward Whitton and no evidence of Rejrat calling Whitton a Spic. Officer Rejrat has no prior history of concerning disciplinary issues and zero complaints in regards to utilizing racial slurs. Whitton has been provided multiple avenues to file a written complaint, however, he has failed to complete said complaint. This complaint was investigated as it was received on the phone and through his social media posts.

When investigating this complaint I did observe an ancillary issue involving Officer Stanley Rejrat. When reviewing body worn camera footage, I noticed that Officer Rejrat utilized profanity when speaking to Whitton. I know this is a difficult job, and I do think profanity can be acceptable in certain situations, but not this one. Rejrat stated to Whitton "If I find you in the city stealing shit again you are going to have a problem." Rejrat uses the word shit. When Officer Rejrat concludes his first interaction with Whitton, he says "Fuck". This is not language that should be utilized during calm interactions with citizens or suspects. These are trying times for police officers, but we need to maintain our integrity and professionalism. This use of profanity is in violation of Utica Police Department Chapter 8, Article 1, Section 1.14 (G) Sub Section 2. Employees shall be courteous, respectful and professional at all times, toward citizens, members of the department and individuals representing other organizations, in all forms of communications in the performance of their duties.
