With the exception of six (6) days that Officer Goldstein had to utilize for an off duty injury, he has had perfect attendance.


Officer Goldstein has been called upon to adjust his hours at a moments notice and has done so with no complaints.







Sirs,

On August 19, 2017 at approximately 0227 hrs, multiple units were dispatched to the area of [REDACTED] (Lansing St & Mohawk St) for a shots fired. We immediately located the victim/caller [REDACTED] who stated that a male he knows to be [REDACTED] had shot him in the left shin outside the bar. He said that [REDACTED] ran into the second floor apartment above the bar.

Long story short we set up a perimeter, began canvassing and located a single 9mm casing in the roadway. Within the first hour we also spoke with [REDACTED] owner of [REDACTED] bar who said that the second floor apartments are all vacant but a [REDACTED] used to live there. [REDACTED] confirmed to me multiple times that the apartments were all vacant and no one should be up there. Inv. Donaldson then requested he sign a search waiver for these apartments along with the key. [REDACTED] agreed and signed the waiver.

Once the Waiver was signed we developed a plan to conduct a slow and deliberate search of the second floor. Officer Flanagan and I grabbed the shields from unit 50 and 40 and were followed by Sgt. Goldstein, Officer Bubnis, Officer Parkosewich and Inv. Donaldson. Once on the second floor landing we made contact with the suspect [REDACTED] and a [REDACTED] in apartment 1. Both were taken into custody without incident. We then cleared the remaining apartments and ended up locating a loaded 9mm pistol, a large quantity of U.S. currency and a large quantity of what appeared to be crack cocaine.

[REDACTED] was later tested for GSR which tested positive.

A firearms permit tab was created for [REDACTED]

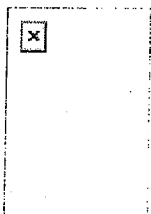

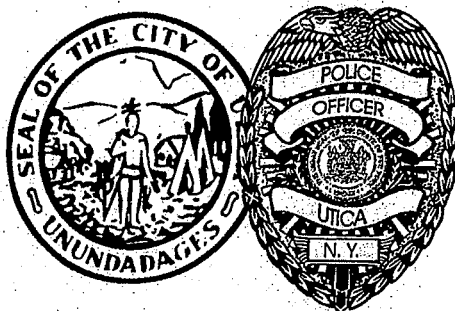

Beginning on January 12<sup>th</sup>, 2021, in response to a troubling increase in gun violence in the City of Utica, the Department introduced a team of uniformed officers to work in conjunction with the already existing investigators assigned to the New York State Division of Criminal Justice Services (NYS DCJS) Gun Involved Violence Elimination (GIVE) grant. Using a 'strike team' concept, the officers and GIVE investigators would conduct gun interdiction investigations using the best available criminal intelligence in an attempt to disrupt the concerning trend in shooting violence in our city.


This team of officers was constructed out of a necessity to respond to an unprecedented amount of gun violence that we observed not only during the 2020 calendar year, but following a weekend in January where we saw twelve confirmed shooting incidents in just over a 24-hour period. New York State as a whole, saw a drastic increase in gun violence in 2020, and unfortunately Utica was not spared of this unfortunate trend. Amongst reporting GIVE jurisdictions statewide, there was a 74% increase in shooting incidents and an 82% increase in shooting victims in 2020 when compared to the previous year. As for Utica, there were increases of 68% and 53%, respectively.

Using the tenets of GIVE, to include procedural justice, hot spot policing and focused deterrence, the officers in the unit proactively sought out individuals believed to be perpetrating gun violence in our community and/or illegally possessing firearms. In a time of the COVID-19 pandemic and social unrest, the officers in the unit volunteered for the assignment knowing full well the potential dangers and pitfalls of street interdiction policing.

As of March 31<sup>st</sup>, in just under three months' time, the unit has made a tremendous impact in reducing gun violence in our community. In February, the department recorded a 70% decrease in confirmed shots fired when compared to the previous month. As a result of the police work conducted by the unit from inception date to March 31<sup>st</sup>, they have been responsible for nineteen individuals charged with weapons related offenses and eighteen illegal firearms seized from our streets.

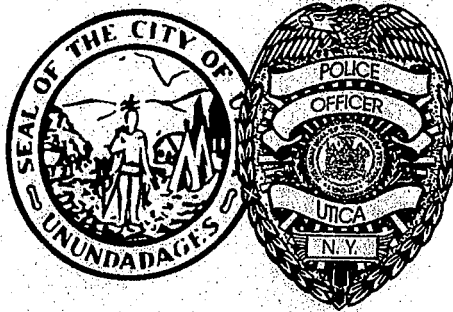

On August 19, 2017, at approximately 2:30 a.m., multiple units were dispatched to the area of Rick's Place located on Mohawk St. for a shots fired incident. Upon arrival, officers met with the victim. The victim reported that he had an argument inside the bar which continued outside. Once outside, he was shot in the leg. He reported that the man who shot him then fled into the second floor above the bar.

Due to the circumstances, a perimeter was immediately established around this location. More evidence was located during the initial investigation and a search waiver was obtained from the building owner. A tactical plan was then developed to conduct a slow and deliberate search for the suspect and any possible evidence. Sergeant Keith Phillips and Officer Sean Flanagan led the search with shields followed by Sergeant Charles Goldstein, Investigator Aaron Donaldson, Officer Sean Bubnis and Officer Charles Parkosewich. Once inside, they located the suspect in the shooting, a loaded .9mm pistol, a large quantity of cash and a large quantity of cocaine.

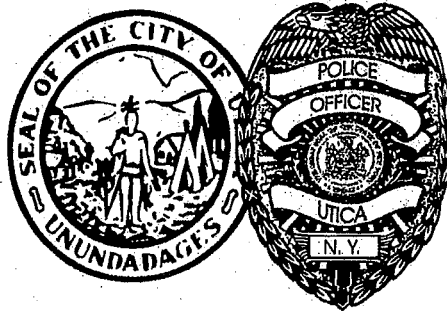

While officers were interviewing family, the female said that there were guns on the second floor and prior to police arrival, the suspect threw a six year child to the ground outside, injuring her.

On July 1, 2007, Officers Michael Cerminaro, Kevin Strife, Charles Goldstein, Daniel Marciano and Sergeant Robert Scully were dispatched to the Cornhill area for shots fired. While en route, the officers were alerted that two vehicles had left the scene. Officer Cerminaro immediately gave out a BOLO for both vehicles and they were subsequently stopped at two separate locations. One vehicle occupied by the gunshot victim was stopped by Officer Marciano and the second vehicle detained at another location by other officers, led to the arrest of two occupants and the recovery of a loaded shotgun. A third occupant who fled from the vehicle was later apprehended. Sergeant Scully later retraced the person's footsteps and located a .22 caliber revolver in a nearby backyard. The three individuals were later charged with attempted murder.

The officers' timely response, quick thinking and investigative initiative led to the apprehension of three dangerous criminals and took two firearms off the street. Their actions are a credit to themselves and the Utica Police Department.
