On May 9th 2018, you were assigned to a prisoner watch detail at St. Elizabeth's Hospital (room #331). At approximately 1022hrs, the prisoner, Devon Garry, asked you if he could use the bathroom. You then allowed Garry to enter the bathroom, unhandcuffed and shackled. Garry shut himself inside the bathroom and subsequently turned on the bathroom faucet. Unbeknownst to you, Garry climbed out the bathroom window and fled the hospital on foot. A nurse tech, who observed Garry escape, notified you and a foot pursuit ensued. Garry was eventually apprehended near 11 Amy Ave. As a result of the Professional Standards Unit's investigation, it was learned that you had been using your cell phone (for entertainment purposes), while Garry was in the bathroom, which may have caused a distraction, allowing Garry the time and opportunity to escape.

As a result of the investigation it was determined that you have violated Department Procedural Manual:

1.17 GENERAL RULES OF CONDUCT:



You are to be commended on a job well done! While on patrol near the Oneida Square Roundabout of Genesee Street northbound, Officer Parkosewich observed a vehicle whose headlamp was not working. The vehicle was stopped by Officers Parkosewich and White, who was also in the vicinity. Officer Parkosewich approached the driver side of the vehicle and Officer White approached the passenger side. In doing so, both officers could smell the odor of majijuana coming from the vehicle.

The operator of the car was asked for his license registration and insurance card and advised the driver he was being stopped for the non-working headlamp. The driver advised the officers he had received a ticket for the headlamp the night before and had a replacement headlight in the glove compartment. The officers asked whether he had any marjiuana on him and his answer was no. Due to the odor of marijuana coming from the vehicle, the driver was asked to vacate the vehicle for a search.

The driver stated he did not want to be searched and did not have marijuana on his person, although the odor of marijuane permeated from him. Officer Parkosewich ordered the driver to place his hands on the vehicle and proceeded with the search. A screwdriver was located in his right side of his pocket and as a search was made on his left side, the officer felt the handle of a handgun. The suspect then tried to put his hand in the pocket where the weapon was. Officer Parkosewich immediately pushed the suspect down on the hood of the vehicle and Officer White placed him in handcuffs. After doing so, the gun was examined which was found to be fully loaded. A continued search of the suspect also revealed marijuana on the suspect's person.

Thereafter, several family and friends of the suspect approached the vehicle making threats against the officers and arguing about the arrest of the suspect. They were advised to leave the area and one additional individual was arrested for Obstruction Governmental Administration 2nd degree

This undoubtedly was a very dangerous situation and because of the outstanding work and performance by both of you, no one was injured.

To: Chief of Police Mark W. Williams

Summary:

On July 9th 2018, I reviewed an internal investigation completed by the Professional Standards Unit in relation to the escape of Devon Garry from St. Elizabeth's Hospital.

Investigation:

On May 9th 2018, PO Eric White was assigned to a prisoner watch detail at St. Elizabeth's Hospital (room #331). At approximately 1022hrs, the prisoner, Devon Garry, asked White if he could use the bathroom. White then allowed Garry to enter the bathroom, un-handcuffed and wearing leg shackles. Garry shut himself inside the bathroom and subsequently turned on the bathroom faucet. Unbeknownst to White, who was standing at the hospital room entrance door, Garry climbed out the bathroom window and fled the hospital on foot. A nurse tech, who observed Garry escape, notified White and a foot pursuit ensued. Garry was eventually apprehended behind a bush, in front of 11 Amy Ave. As a result of the Professional Standards Unit investigation, it was learned that White had been using his cell phone, while Garry was in the bathroom, which may have caused a distraction, allowing Garry the time and opportunity to escape.

Findings:

In their conclusion, Professional Standards cited the following violation(s) of our Procedural Manual:

Chapter Eight, Article One, Professional Standards of Conduct and Ethics

1.17 GENERAL RULES OF CONDUCT:

FF. Cell Phone Usage While On Duty:

- 2. The use of mobile phones, while on duty, is restricted to police business and personal calls of an emergency nature.
- 3. It is a violation of departmental policy to conduct personal business while on duty regardless of assignment. This includes landline and mobile phone usage for both personal business and casual communications.

Disciplinary Recommendation:

Based upon the Professional Standards Unit's findings, a review of PO Eric White's investigation history and the overall seriousness of the resulting event, I recommend that he surrenders (3) vacation days from his time bank.

I realized at this point that the inmate must have jumped out of the bathroom window inside of his room. To Chief of Police: Mark Williams

On May 9th 2018, I, Sgt. H. Rios reported to work with the Utica Police Department. There I am assigned to the Office of Professional Standards under the direct supervision of the Chief of Police: Mark Williams.

On the above date at approximately 1400 hrs, I was briefed by Lt. Dougherty (B-Platoon Squad Commander), regarding an escape of an inmate (Devon Shymeek Garry Carry Was in our custody due to him being a robbery suspect from a previous incident.

Lt. Dougherty provided me with the following information;

That on 05/09/2018 PO Eric White was assigned to St. Elizabeth's Hospital on a prisoner watch detail room # 331. At approximately 1022 hours Devon Garry requested to use the bathroom (in-room bathroom). Devon while in the bathroom, managed to climb out of a 3rd floor window and onto the rooftop, while PO E. White was sitting outside of the bathroom. PO White was alerted by a member of the nursing staff that she had just seen Mr. Gary standing in the hallway of the 3rd floor near the bathroom / vending machine area and then watched him flee on foot from the building. After being informed that Devon had fled from the Hospital, PO White looked out of a window that was facing the front of the Hospital and observed Devon running down the sidewalk in his Orange hospital smock. PO White gave chase and eventually, after a short foot pursuit caught up to Mr. Garry on Amy Ave, where he was taken into custody without incident.

After being briefed by Lt. Dougherty, I was asked if I would go up to St. Elizabeth's Hospital and assist Sgt. Howard Brodt who was on his way there to speak to staff about the incident. Lt. Dougherty told me that someone (possibly the nursing staff) had called his office informing him that the officer on-duty who was supposed to be watching Devon Garry was on his cell at the time of the incident. I told Lt. Dougherty that I would assist and then drew BWC SPR10 to record any and all interviews.

Upon arrival to St. Elizabeth's I met Sgt. Brodt at the Emergency Room Entrance and we then responded to the third floor of St. Elizabeth's Hospital, specifically room # 331. We stopped at the nurse's station / desk on the third floor and began to speak with several nurses in an attempt to see if anyone of them was the one who had contacted the Lt. Office regarding the officer being on his phone. While speaking to several nurses and not being able to find the caller at this time, I informed Sgt. Brodt that if he had to leave, he could as he was the only supervisor on the street for road patrol. I told Sgt. Brodt that I would be handling the investigation.

Interview of: Mrs. Jessica Fister, 14:46 hours.

Mrs. Fister works on the third floor "Transfer Center room # 390." This office is located to the right of room # 331 and from the doorway of this office; there is s perfect view of room of 331.

While speaking to Mrs. Fister she said the following;

Said, that a Natalie Fauss who is a Cardiologist was uncomfortable the day prior (5/8/18) of the escape, because she was left alone in the room with Devon Garry. Mrs. Fister then made contact via a land line and asked Mrs. Fauss if she had time to come speak to me. Mrs. Fauss stated that she did, and then stated that she would respond to room # 309. See BWC SPR10 video # 2.

At approximately 14:52 hours, Mrs. Natalie Fauss along with Cathy Rossi responded to room # 339.

Interview of: Mrs. Natalie Fauss, (SPR10-14:53-08-00:23 hours).

While speaking to Mrs. Fauss, she said the following;

Said, that on the day before the escape (5/8/18) while they were conducting tests on Mr. Garry, they had concerns with what the officer was doing. Said, that the officer was outside of the curtain. Said, that she had to ask the officer to come into the curtain area while they conducted their tests, telling the officer that they normally don't scan a prisoner without an officer monitoring. (Hospital protocol, nothing in UPD Policy and Policy) the officer complied when asked to monitor the tests. Mrs. Fauss stated that the prisoner(s) hands were un-cuffed and she felt that the prisoner was rubbing/touching her arm. Mrs. Fauss stated that due to the prisoner's hands being un-cuffed, he was able to expose himself to her. Mrs. Fauss went on to say that the Officer was very pleasant and felt that the officer was acting as though he and the prisoner was buddies, very laxed as the officer told her that he was on for over 17 hours. Said that the

(SPR10-15:00:11-07:26) – Said that the prisoners had no restraints on him, legs or hands while they (the nurses) were conducting their tests.

Mrs. Cathy Rossi (SPR10-15:02:00 – 09:15). 315-801-4422

Stated that on 05/08/18 she left work at 1700 hrs, the officer was outside of the room, leaning on the wall, was not in the room. Said, that when she returned at 0655 hrs, on 05/09/18 same thing the officer was outside of the room also leaning on the wall, went on to say that when the hospital called the escape she was not surprised.

(SPR10-15:12:27-00:38) - I was provided with a telephone for security- Mr. Christopher Kilmartin Mr. Kilmartin told me that he would have to contact his superiors to get authorization to release any and all video related to the escape of Mr. Garry.

(SPR10-13:22-01:33) > I was asked if I had spoken to Inv. M. Rahn, telling me that a Mrs. Kelly Reesh had given a statement to Inv. Rahn to the fact that Kelly was the person who witnessed Garry coming out of the bathroom and was the one who was doing vitals on Mr. Garry, the patient was shackled to the bed, but there was no guard in the room, apparently he had gone to the bathroom so they weren't comfortable going into the room this morning without him.

(SPR10-15:14:52 - 03:03) > I spoke Mrs. Briana Sangiocomo, who is a supervisor on the 3rd floor.

Said the prisoner said to, or the patient said to Kelly, what are you looking for, well, I was looking for the officer who was in this room; well he went to the bathroom.

When he came back (PO White, after the escape), as a supervisor I asked him what happened

Said that she spoke to Officer White and had asked him what had happened, and Officer White told her "I un-shackled his hands so he can go to the bathroom, he shut the door for privacy, he said, and then he was in there for quite some time he said, and his feet were still shackled he said, and I didn't know anything until they came in to tell me and when he went to unlock the door the door was still locked. The officer said to me, do you guys lock your screens, I told him we don't normally have patients jumping out the window (she was laughing as she said this).

Said that with the County (OCJ), Marcy and all those, we have protocols in place, but I don't think that involved UPD.

(SPR10-15:18:08 – 06:19)- Said that PO White has been standing in the doorway (facing out) on his cell phone pacing all day back and forth.

While speaking to a Supervisor, she said you kind of feel bad, "didn't want him to get reprimanded", but then you kind of feel bad too"

(SPR10-15:21:46-09:57) – I was then escorted to room # 331 and conducted a walk through utilizing BWC SPR10. I was shown where Officer White had been standing in the doorway while on his cell phone with the curtain closed allegedly for patient privacy.

While conducting a check of the bathroom window, I made mention that this window, had no outer window that appeared to be standardized on every other window and the turn knob was missing.

(SPR10-15:28:48-00:14) > Interview of Kaylyn Leffingwell (Primary Nurse)

This Morning at 07:00 I was doing bedside reporting with the night nurse, so it wasn't the officer who was on when all this went down, it was the nightshift one and I didn't catch his name, um but at one point when we did do bed side reporting he was there, um a couple minutes later when we had walked by and I think actually the nurse tech notified me, she like do you know that's there's no guard present, and we went in there and the patient was in his bed he had cuffs on he was shackled and I asked the patient do you know where the officer went and he goes "he went to the bathroom." When all this went down, I didn't see the set up, I just noticed when I went in there, the room was empty, the bathroom door was locked and the water was running, the curtain was partially closed.

When I did my evaluation, the prisoner was shackled.

I didn't witness it, but this is what was told to me;

Apparently when he went out the window there's a roof, just like how that one is (pointing to a window in the office), he went out the window got on the roof and then went through the next door, which brought him around the corner in that little waiting area by the vending machines, and there was a nurse tech from our floor around there and she saw him I think at that point he went down the stairs and outside, but then she went to the patients room where the cop was she goes do you know your guys leaving, he's escaping, so that's when he realized the guy was gone, he jumped up and checked the bathroom door and noticed it was locked so then he went out and pursued him. When I asked do you know who this person was who this was that told her and she said, that was Kelly that was Kelly the nurse tech who, I don't know her last name, she's here now. Kelly was the one who saw Garry come back in and notified Officer White.

Kaylyn was asked during her travels did you see the officers on their cell phones, "Yes" they would be like wondering kind of like walking back and forth in the hallway, I mean he wouldn't go too far from the door, obviously not in sight of the guy, I kind of felt a little uncomfortable because like nobody was like really watching the guy, it was both officers one from the morning and one from the afternoon. Each time I went in there, they would kind of stand by the doorway with the curtain closed; they couldn't even see the patient from the trunk up.

(SPR10-15:38:52 – 00:53) - Interview with Kelly Reesh (Nurse Tech).

- > Stated that she went in to take Mr. Garry's vital at 0630-0700 hrs.
- > Stated at 0630-0700 hrs, she waited at least 5 minutes to take vitals because the officer was not around.

Kelly was asked when she the prisoner come back into the building where was she, she said I was coming out of the bathroom and I saw him standing there near the vending machine, this was about 10:30 am.

- When I saw him standing there (Garry), I went to the nurse, because, I'm like, is this guy supposed to be out in the hall without the officer, and I walked by the room and the officer was sitting there in the chair, you know,
- I asked what was the officer doing, sitting in the chair and she said it looked like he was texting. She said no I don't think so, so turned around to go to the desk, and when she did I heard people say he just went out the door and he's a prisoner. He had orange on and that how we tell, only inmates or anyone being held they all wear orange. I went over there and I looked out the window, and I seen him outside and I ran and I said to the officer, I went in there and I said to the officer your guy is outside, he's like "uh" and I'm like your guy is outside, he jumped up and tried to open the bathroom door and it was locked.
- It must have been at least 3 minutes from the time I saw him (Garry) at the vending machines, to the time I spoke to the nurse until I spoke to the officer. I mean he had enough time to get down the stairs with his feet shackled and out the door.
- I thought to myself is the officer not in the room, so I made sure that I looked when I walked by the room, I mean I was only 20 ft away from the room when I said to her can this guy be out of the room. When I went back to the room the officer was still on the phone, when I told him that

his guy was outside it's like he didn't even hear me. When he finally realized that I was talking to him, he said "what." (Supporting Dep of Kelly Reesh was filed under attachment # 7)

After conducting my interviews, I then responded back to UPD and did the following;

>Reviewed RMS 18-17894 to see if Force was used / needed to take Mr. Garry back into custody. (None filed by any member of UPD Officer's on scene)

>Printed RMS case files # 18-17984 (filed under attachment # 1)

>Printed the On Duty for May 9, 2018 (filed under attachment # 2)

>Researched existence of Body Warn Camera Footage, of Sgt. Berger, Sgt. H. Brodt, PO A. Llewellyn. PO Morinitti, PO E. White. All video's that were located, have been tagged under RMS 18-17894. (Filed under Folder B)

>Made a copy of the BWC footage as part of this case file. (Filed under Attachment Folder B)

>Sgt. Rios searched Crime Scene Photo(s) from RMS 18-17894 and located 24 pictures related to this incident. (These photos were not downloaded as they can be viewed in the Crime Scene Photo tab at any given time).

>Sgt. Rios requested any and all video from St. Elizabeth's Hospital Security relative to escape.

I then reviewed the narrative of PO White. PO White depicted the following scenario in narrative dated May 9, 2018; (filed under attachment # 3)

At the start of the shift I was directed by Lt. Dougherty to respond to St. Elizabeth's hospital to relieve PO Merrick, who was on prisoner watch in room 331. I relieved PO Merrick from his post and began prisoner watch of a black male who I know to be Devon Garry. Garry was in our custody due to him being a robbery suspect from a previous incident. At approximately 1022 hours Devon requested to use his in-room bathroom and I agreed. Devon had used the bathroom previously without incident due to him having a bowl movement and Devon stated he had to go again. At this time Devon was shackled at the ankles, but I allowed his hands to be free in order for him to utilize the tissue paper to clean himself. I remained posted at his room entrance door while Devon entered the bathroom and closed the door behind him. I could audibly hear Devon use the toilet and then the faucet turn on. When the faucet turned on I took this as Devon was finished using the bathroom and was now washing his hands. Within a minute or so of Devon being in the bathroom a member of the nursing staff entered the room and advised me Devon had just fled on foot from the building. I immediately ran to the window in the hall facing west towards the front of Hospital and I observed Devon running down the sidewalk in his Orange hospital smock.

At this point I exited the hospital, called out the foot pursuit of the escapee Devon to dispatch and proceeded to chase after him. I pursued Devon west across Genesee Street, through the parking lot of 2206 Genesee Street, where Devon turned northbound through a backyard of residence of 9 Amy Ave. As I passed through the yard, I conducted a check of an open garage due to me losing visual of Devon and then proceeded to the front of the residence to the street. I advised dispatch of his description, the units in route of my location of where I last observed him and maintained my position on the sidewalk due to the fact I was close enough to Devon when I lost sight of him that I knew he was hiding close by.

While scanning the area and waiting for other units to arrive to establish a perimeter, I observed an unknown civilian standing on the north side of Amy Ave just to the east of my location and he was pointing to the bushes of 11 Amy Ave. I made my way east towards 11 Amy and the unknown civilian shouted, "He's in the bushes". At this time I could hear rustling in the bushes and I drew my duty weapon at the low ready. I called out to Devon using his last name Garry and Devon inquired if the person calling him was myself. I rounded the bush and observed Devon on the ground and advised him to come out.

At this time Car 40 Sgt. A. Berger and Car 50 Sgt. Brandt were on the scene and grabbed hold of Devon as he crawled out from behind the bush. I then was able to take Devon into custody without incident. Devon was placed in the rear seat of car 54 and transported back to St. E's while Sgt. Berger and I followed behind. We then escorted Devon back to his assigned room number 331 and I gave Sgt. Berger the details of what transpired. Inv. Rahn also arrived on scene and advised me to notify him when Devon was discharged and at booking in HQ.

PO Dare of Car 54 then remained at the hospital to assist with the prisoner watch due to Devon now being a flight risk. Devon's assigned physician re-evaluated Devon's vitals and the tests completed earlier regarding Devon's previous medical complaint and deemed Devon in good health. Devon was then discharged and I transported him to booking at HQ with car 54 following. Devon was turned over to the booking officer PO Fanelli and I advised Inv. Rahn of our arrival. Inv. Rahn advised me to complete a supporting deposition regarding the incident.

This concluded my involvement in the incident.

May 18, 2018

>Sgt. Rios received the requested video from St. Elizabeth's Hospital from Christopher Kilmartin (Manager, Security Department). (Affidavit of the video was filed under attachment # 4; the video was files under folder B)

June 7, 2018 (Interview of PO E. White SPR02).

> Sgt. Rios and Inv. Howe conducted a fact-finding interview with Officer Eric White. In addition to the information contained in Officer E. White's narrative report dated May 9, 2018, Officer E. White was presented with a number of additional questions to assist in providing further clarification into his activities and observations related to this incident. Officer E. White was advised of the nature of this investigation and provided his Notice of Right to Union Representation. Officer White exercised his

rights to representation and was represented by PBA President Christopher Jennings. (See Notice of Right to Union Representation and Garrity Warnings provided to Officer E. White - filed under attachment # 5). After all pre-interview paperwork was explained to and signed by Officer White, his interview then commenced. This interview was conducted utilizing a BWC –SPR02 (Body Warn Camera), see a visual / audio recording of Officer E. White's interview attached hereto (filed under folder B).

>Officer E. White was questioned regarding the escape of Devon Garry who was in the custody of the Utica Police Department. Mr. Garry was in UPD custody for a previous incident of Robbery. The allegations that have been brought forward against Officer E. White is/was that during the time Mr. Garry's escape, he was on his "Cell Phone."

Officer White was given the opportunity to view video footage possessed by the Office of Professional Standards Unit regarding the escape and interaction between he and Mr. Garry prior to the his escape given by witnesses, at which point Officer White refused to watch any video.

Officer White was asked to give his recollection of the day in question (May 9, 2018) prior to Mr. Garry's escape.

> Specific questions posed to Officer White will be referenced by BWC # and then followed by the time. The verbiage is in the officer's words and appears as close as possible to the exact language spoken during the interview.

(BWC - SPR02 - 10:100)

>Officer White said that just before 10:30 am, M. Garry was lying in bed; just after eating used the bathroom when he first got there telling Officer White that he had to take a dump. Officer White said that Mr. Garry was fine with him the whole time, watching TV, hanging out; talking, said that he had to go to the bathroom again a little after 10:00 am. Mr. Garry goes into the bathroom closes the door behind him; he hears Garry using the bathroom and then hears the faucet turn on, now thinking that Mr. Garry is washing his hands. Officer White said after hearing the water being turned on he's kind of like dazing off at the door not really thinking anything about it, until a nurse comes into the room and tells him that "Hey your guy is gone." Officer White said he then looks out of a window and see's Garry running bare ass down the side walk with an orange smock on at which point he gives chase.

(BWC - SPR02 - 10:11:53)

>Officer White was specifically asked when Mr. Garry went to the bathroom was he cuffed was Garry cuffed to the front, legs what kind of restraints used?

Said he had his shackles on and he took the cuffs off so that he could wash his hands. Went on to say that his shackles were already on and that whoever put them only used the first latch of the leg shackles that came off when Mr. Gary started running down the street.

>Officer White was asked if he was ever asked to step further into the room behind the curtain of Mr. Garry while one of the nurses conducted vitals on Mr. Garry.

Officer White said "No."

>Officer White was asked if he was aware of any Policy and Procedure in regards to conducting a prisoner watch.

Officer White said that he's looked over our policy (UPD) on prisoner watches and didn't see much in there.

(BWC - SPR02 - 10:14:40

>Officer White was then told what the allegations against him were; that during the escape of Mr. Garry, he was on his either texting or reading or whatever, he takes Devon to the bathroom, he goes back to the chair and he goes on his phone again.

Said that by the time Mr. Garry went to the bathroom and the time that nurse came into the room to advise him that Mr. Garry was gone it had only been a minute or two, it was all quick I was reading an article on my phone and I kept glancing up.

>Officer White was specifically asked; while the water was running after a minute or so and Mr. Garry still in the bathroom didn't he say that's a long time washing his hands?

Officer White said that he was reading on his cell phone, he figured Garry was taking a dump and washing up; he wasn't keeping track of the time and admits that he was distracted due to his reading and being on his cell phone.

(BWC - SPR02 - 10:19:43)

>Officer White was specifically asked regarding the allegation f he was on his cell phone or not?

➤ Officer White said; "Yea." Officer White went on to say, that everybody ups there, everybody reading articles you're up there for hours sitting with this guy.

>Officer White was asked if he was aware of the Utica Policy and Procedure in regards to cell phone use while on duty.

> Officer White said "Yea, I know," but, I mean, everyone uses their phone on duty.

Officer White was then given a copy of the Policy and Procedure for his review (filed under attachment # 6).

Officer White did acknowledge that being on his phone was a clear violation of department policy.

Policy and Procedure violation; Chapter 8 article 1

Subject: Professional Standards of Conduct and Ethics - FF. Cell Phone Usage While On Duty 1, 2, 3

Prior to stopping the interview and to provide Officer Aiello an opportunity to arrive at a statement or give more data than had been requested of him, the following questions were put to him;

- 1. Is there anything that I have failed to ask you that you would like to add? He said "No."
- 2. Has everything you said been the truth to the best of your knowledge, he responded "Yes."

The interview of Officer Eric White concluded at about 10:38 am. (See visual/audio-recorded interview filed under folder B)

Investigative Summary

On May 8, 2018 at approximately 06:07 hours, the Utica Police Department made an arrest of a Robbery suspect identified as Devon S. Garry DOB 8/9/86. Shortly after his arrest on the May 8, 2018, Mr. Garry was transported from the arrest scene to St. Elizabeth's Hospital for "Chest Paint" that were thought to be induced by cocaine use. After transporting Mr. Garry to St. Elizabeth's Hospital, Sgt A. Berger (acting Squad Commander) was notified of Mr. Garry being transported to the Hospital. It was later learned that Mr. Garry was going to be admitted for further observation and that Officer Merrick who had brought Mr. Garry to the hospital was going to need relief. After receiving the information that Mr. Garry was going to be admitted, a Prisoner watch was assembled due to the fact that Mr. Garry was in the custody of the Utica Police Department.

On 05/09/2018, PO Eric White was assigned to St. Elizabeth's Hospital on the prisoner watch detail room # 331. At approximately 1022 hours Devon Garry requested to use the bathroom (in-room bathroom). Devon while in the bathroom, managed to climb out of a 3rd floor window and onto the rooftop, while PO E. White was sitting outside of the bathroom. PO White was alerted by a member of the nursing staff that she had just seen Mr. Garry standing in the hallway of the 3rd floor near the bathroom / vending

machine area and then watched him flee on foot from the building. After being informed that Devon had fled from the Hospital, PO White looked out of a window that was facing the front of the Hospital and observed Devon running down the sidewalk in his Orange hospital smock. PO White gave chase and eventually, after a short foot pursuit caught up to Mr. Garry on Amy Ave, where he was taken into custody without incident.

Later during the day of the May 9, 2018 Lt. Dougherty (Squad Commander) receives a phone call from a nurse at St. Elizabeth's Hospital who is not identified stating that prior to the escape of Mr. Garry, the officer who was suppose to be watching him was on his cell phone and not paying attention to Mr. Garry. This investigation learned that the officer in question was Officer E. White.

During the interview process in regards to being on his cell phone at the time of the escape Officer White confirms, ""Yea." Officer White went on to say, that everybody up there, everybody reading articles you're up there for hours sitting with this guy.

Also during this investigation while speaking to and interviewing several nurses, it was learned that it was not just PO White who had been on the phone during the prisoner detail of Devon White. It appears that all officers on the detail at some point were either on their phone, standing in the hallway, or left the prisoner unattended for periods of time while they used the bathroom.

CONCLUSION

Through the investigation conducted by the Professional Standards Unit, it has been determined that Officer White failed to check to make sure that Mr. Garry's shackles were properly secured when he used the restroom while receiving medical Treatment at St. Elizabeth's Hospital on May 9, 2018; Officer Whites admits that he never checked the shackles prior to his shift or when Mr. Garry went to the bathroom.

Mr. Garry told investigators when he was running from the hospital, one of the leg cuffs came off, which left his legs unshackled and easier for him to run.

It has also been determines that Officer White violated the Utica Police Departments "Cell Phone Policy"

Chapter 8 Article 1; FF. 1, 2, 3

Officer White chased the Mr. Garry from the 3rd floor, down a stairwell and onto the first floor of the hospital. He exited the hospital and ran through the parking lot, crossed Genesee Street and jumped

into bushes in an attempt to hide from Officer White and responding Officers. Mr. Garry was later found by Officer White in the bushes returned back to St. Elizabeth's Hospital and ultimately charged with "Escape" by investigator Rahn of the Utica Police Criminal Investigations Division.

Although Officer White explains his thought process as to why he was on his phone and became distracted not realizing that Mr. Garry had escaped, which may be a contributing factor, this explanation does not serve as justification for his actions and response to the situation at hand, which is hereby concluded to be unacceptable and in direct violation of Utica Police Department Policy and Procedures. It should be noted that during this investigation it was reported to this investigator that each nurse treating Mr. Garry relayed concerns of the way Mr. Garry was secured (handcuffed/restraints) and that the officers watching Mr. Garry acted as though they were his best friend and in their view failed to exercise caution in their safety. The nurses mostly complained about the Officers being on their cell phones, walking the halls and leaving Mr. Garry unattended.

In a rapidly evolving cell phone era and since the inception of "Smart Phones" and this being a young department where it's members are growing up dependant on the technology of cell phones, whether to view social media, search the web, reading etc; situations come up where young officers are forced to be placed on assignments that are new to them and most likely never discussed or trained on by their FTO (Field Training Officer) on how to perform these duties. While on these assignments sometimes they must make split-second decisions in which sometimes mistakes are made. Although we cannot condone any acts of policy and procedure violations, the Utica Police Departments does have a Policy and Procedure in place; however, it cannot cover each and every situation imaginable. The Utica Police Department relies on each and every Officer to utilize the skills and training given to them, along with the ability to use common sense in handling all calls and work details. An evolving and un-imaginable tool such as a "Cell Phone" and its use while working has been a hot topic nationally, not only in the law enforcement work place, but in all work places. The Cell Phone is said to be a tool we cannot do without. Officers have been made aware of the Utica Police Policy as to phone use while on duty and that they are not allowed to use their cell phones during work hours. The use of cell phones while on this detail (the watching of Mr. Garry), was in violation of the Utica Police Policy and Procedure; however, it was done to keep the officer occupied during sometimes early morning long details, where the officer has no one to talk too and his only job is to sit there watching a person sleep. The totality of the circumstances should be factors of consideration in determining disciplinary action. Upon examination of the video and the interviews held, and as a result of Officer White Admitting to using his cell phone while on the detail, I therefore find that Officer E. White violated Utica Police Policy and Procedure.

As a result of these investigative findings, it is recommended that disciplinary action be taken against Officer E. White for violations of the following Utica Police Department, Policies and Procedures:

Subject: Professional Standards of Conduct & Ethics

FF. Cell Phone Usage While On Duty;

- 1. No Officer may talk on a mobile phone without utilizing hands-free equipment while operating a departmental vehicle that is in motion. No officer shall text or utilize a mobile phone in any manner while operating a departmental vehicle that is in motion. The hands-free equipment shall only be worn while operating a vehicle.
- 2. The use of mobile phones, while on duty, is restricted to police business and personal calls of an emergency nature.
- 3. It is a violation of departmental policy to conduct personal business while on duty regardless of assignment. This includes landline and mobile phone usage for both personal business and casual communications.

Training issues noted;

As stated above training needs to be conducted as to how to perform "Prisoner Watch Details" and what's expected of them during this detail while at the hospital.

Since the date of May 9, 2018 the Utica Police Department has been working with the Staff of St. Elizabeth's Hospital, to come up with a Protocol for the Utica Police Department to follow while a Prisoner is being treated and in our custody. St. Elizabeth's Hospital already has guidelines / Policies in place with the Oneida County Sheriffs Dept and NYS Corrections.

Police have admitted to feeling "embarrassed" after a man managed to escape custody - while in handcuffs.

This Professional Standards Internal Investigation is closed and has been registered into the Professional Standards database as, "SUSTAINED"
This incident has been forwarded to Lt. S. Dougherty and Capt Cinque for review and possible disciplinary action.
