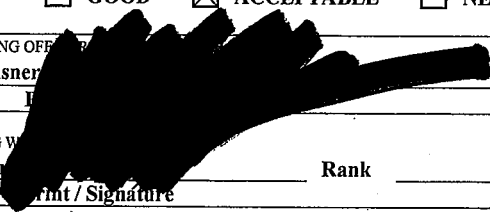

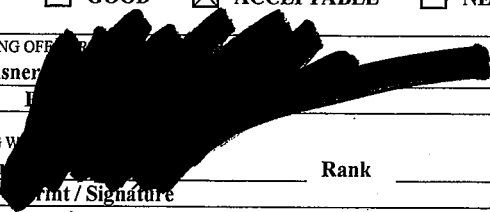

-General appearance: Inv. Bruzzese always presents himself in a very neat, professional manner.

-Attendance: During this evaluation period Inv. Bruzzese did not use any sick time and he only took off a total of eight days.

-During his first six months assigned to CID Nights, Bruzzese has transitioned very well and is right on track for where he should be.

-He works very well with the other investigators assigned to CID Nights. This is very important as the dynamic of a small unit needs to be strong and cohesive to accomplish the goals of CID and the department.

-Inv. Bruzzese's immediate supervisors are pleased with his development to this point. He has shown a strong desire to learn by working his assigned cases thoroughly and asking questions of his senior investigators and supervisors. Even though Bruzzese came to the unit with a relatively low amount of time on the job, he has demonstrated a basic understanding of the investigative process, which has helped him to hit the ground running. A couple examples of investigations that highlight this are:

-On June 19, 2017, his first day in CID, Inv. Bruzzese was assigned an assault investigation that took place at Oneida Square (RMS 17-26992). He worked the case for several weeks before making an arrest of the suspect on 8/1/17. All of his investigative steps were documented in a thorough narrative that was written very well.

-On September 15, 2017, Inv. Bruzzese was assigned a criminal mischief case involving Sacco's Locksmith and the neighboring residence, owned by Philip Donlon (RMS 17-41095). Bruzzese completed a thorough investigation, which included a successful interview of Donlon, who is a difficult person to deal with. The full confession that was obtained strengthened the case immensely and demonstrates that Bruzzese is developing good interview skills.

How can this employee best improve his/her performance?

Inv. Bruzzese can best improve his performance by seeking out various types of investigations and methods to use during those investigations. This will help to expose him to a wider variety of incidents which will help him become a more rounded and experienced investigator.

On October 19, 2015, several units were dispatched to a North Utica convenience store regarding an armed robbery. Upon arrival, Officer Scott Lewis began gathering information from the clerk and the store video surveillance regarding a detailed description of the two armed robbery suspects. This detailed information was given out to all cars. Around this same time, a caller from one of the neighboring streets reported two suspicious males who were seen running and then entered a dark-colored minivan. All units began searching the area for the suspects.

Within minutes, a second call was dispatched regarding an armed robbery of a convenience store in South Utica. The description given by the clerk matched the suspect descriptions of the first robbery in North Utica minutes ago. Patrol units then responded to the South Utica convenience store. While en route to that location, Officer Frederick Bruzzese noticed a dark-colored minivan traveling at a high rate of speed with its headlights off. Officer Bruzzese was able to quickly get behind this vehicle. After a brief pursuit, the occupants abandoned the van in the middle of an intersection and fled on foot through a West Utica neighborhood, leaving behind evidence and proceeds from the crime. Sergeant Frank Scarchilli ordered all units to set up a perimeter and seal off the area. Officers Lewis, Andre Wrobel, Joshua Skibinski, Joshua Austin, Dzevad Bajrektarevic, Victor Ramos and Officer Bruzzese secured a one block radius and moved in. Sweeping the yards, Officer Bajrektarevic located one of the suspects hiding under a car and placed him into custody. He was then brought to headquarters and interviewed by Officer Mark Rahm, where he was charged with two counts of Robbery 1st.

In the following days, Investigator Edward Smith and Officer Rahm began to develop information regarding the second suspect. The suspect was identified and located a short time later. During this suspect's interview with Investigator Tricia Nicholson-Scully, he admitted to participating in both the robberies in concert with the first suspect.

All of the officers involved are deserving of recognition for their teamwork, investigative skills and dedication to duty. As a result of their efforts, two dangerous individuals were removed from the city streets. They are a credit to themselves, their respective units and the Utica Police Department.

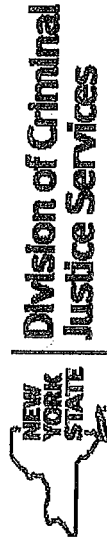

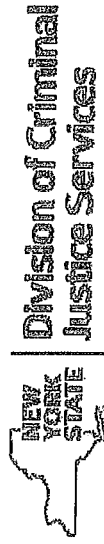
