In this example, Officer Dare was given little information regarding the sale of illegal untaxed cigarettes and the sale of immitaion marijuana from several local bodegas. Officer Dare was able to use his street contacts to develop a case. During his investigation he found that another juristiction was also looking into these bodegas for the same issues but were unable to connect the dots. With Officer Dares information, several agencies collaberated and were able to arrest and prosecute multiple individuals.

Attendance- Officer Dare has used zero sick days this rating period.

Reliability- Officer Dare stepped up in the beginning of the year when two senior members of the unit were re-assigned. He was relied upon to train a new member and handle more responsibilities.

Judgment- On April 3, 2019 Sgt. Murphy became aware that Officer Dare recorded a phone call with an Assistant District Attorney without their permission or knowledge. Officer Dare recorded a conversation that he had with the ADA due to issues with a case that he investigated and turned over to the District Attorney's Office. Officer Dare played the recording for Sgt. Murphy and explained that it was because of issues he was having with the case and with that ADA. Officer Dare was issued a Counseling Memo regarding this incident.

In June Officer Dare initiated an investigation and requested assistance from the DEA in writing a GPS warrant. A few months later when it came time to execute search warrants, Officer Dare asked a member of the DEA to write the search warrants, effectively turning the case over to them. This was done so without supervisor approval.

Knowledge of Laws, Policies, Etc.- Officer Dare continues to learn more about search and seizure law and narcotics investigations as his time in the unit progresses.

How can this employee best improve his/her performance? (Include setting Career /Performance Goals).

Officer Dare has done a good job performing in SIU this past year. Moving forward, he should focus on investigating more desirable targets. He should also focus on maintaining better confidential informants that result in more desirable targets. Officer Dare has shown that he is more than capable of being a good narcotics investigator. He has learned a lot regarding investigations in the last 18 months and he should transition to higher quality investigations over quantity investigations.

The swift actions of these officers resulted in the arrest of three individuals involved in the shooting and the seizure of a firearm.

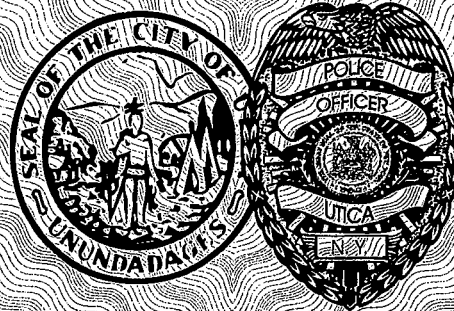

On February 2nd, 2016, Investigator Charles Goldstein, working under the GIVE Program, received information that an individual was in possession of an illegal handgun and was likely going to commit a shooting.

Investigator Goldstein contacted the METRO, Warrants and Patrol Units for assistance. He and Investigator Peter Paladino conducted surveillance of the location where the suspect was reported to be staying. Soon thereafter, they witnessed the male exit the location and enter into a vehicle. After conducting a tail of the vehicle, and upon obtaining the proper NYS VTL violations, a vehicle stop was initiated. As the investigators attempted to interview the suspect, he fled on foot but was ultimately apprehended with the assistance of Sergeant Mark Fields, Investigator Timothy Moore, Investigator Joseph Dare, Officer Eric Scorzafava and Officer James Femia. After a brief struggle on the ground, the officers located a loaded .380 caliber handgun in the suspect's waistband, as well as a quantity of narcotics on his person.

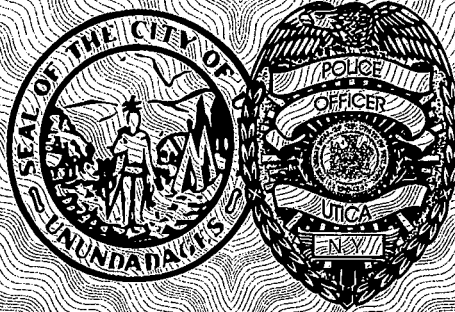

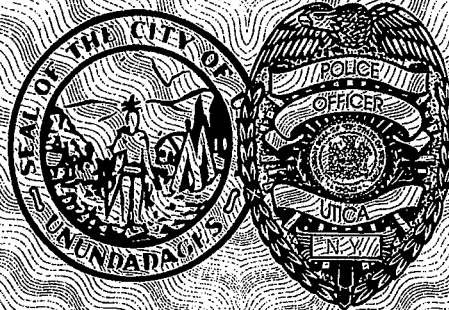

Sergeant D'Ambro encountered the suspect attempting to jump a fence. Once the suspect came off of the fence, Sergeant D'Ambro ordered the suspect to surrender and took him into custody.

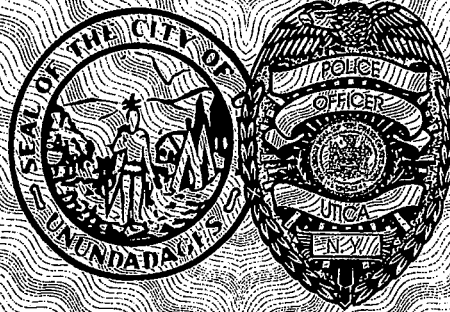

OFFICER JOSEPH DARE and OFFICER JOHN LOMONICO

On June 6, 2013, Officers Dare and Lomonico were assigned to Car 59 for the 0800 to 1600 hours shift. At approximately 0830 hours while on routine patrol, they observed smoke coming from the area across from Slocum Dickson on Burrstone Road. They immediately headed to the area and observed a vehicle that had been involved in an accident. The vehicle had gone off the road and struck a tree. The Officers observed that the vehicle's engine was on fire and the driver was still in the vehicle. Officer Dare grabbed the fire extinguisher from the car and handed it to another person so he and Lomonico could aid the drivers.

The driver was conscious but appeared to be disoriented. The Officers told him to get out of the car but he did not seem to understand what they were telling him. At that time, both Officers pulled him from the car to safety. He was then turned over to Edwards Ambulance for treatment.

Officers Dare and Lomonico's immediate response and quick action without regard for their personal safety, potentially prevented severe injury or death to the individual. Their actions reflect their dedication to the profession, the community and the department.

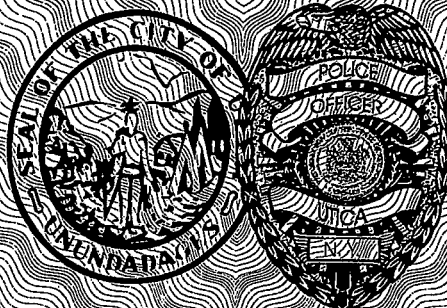

I. Identify and define the behavior to be modified:

On April 3, 2019 Sgt. Murphy became aware that Officer Dare recorded a phone call with Assistant District Attorney [REDACTED] without her permission or knowledge. Officer Dare recorded a conversation that he had with [REDACTED] due to issues with a case that he investigated and turned over to the District Attorney's Office. Officer Dare played the recording for Sgt. Murphy and explained that it was because of issues he was having with the case and with ADA [REDACTED].

II. Review of applicable rules & regulations, orders and operating procedures or laws:

Chapter 8 Rules and Regulations, Article 1 Professional Standards Of Conduct And Ethics, Performance and Attention to Duty Section 1.14 Paragraph JJ, Unauthorized Recording of Conversation(s) which states:

1. All Police Officers are prohibited from engaging in the practice of recording conversations with other Police Officers, Superior Officers, and other Public Officials, without notifying those parties prior to the taping that such an act is taking place. Recording devices include, but are not limited to, tape recorders, digital recorders, cell phones, or answering machine devices. This order also applies when any Police Officer counsels a civilian, a relative, or any other party to engage in this type of activity with the Police Officer's knowledge or on the Police Officer's behalf. The only exception to this order will be if a sworn Police Officer is specifically involved in an authorized Police investigation.

III. Employee's response to the performance deficiency:

Officer Dare explained that he was not aware that it was a policy violation to record public officials without notifying them beforehand.

IV. Clearly explain the behavior expected of the member:

It is expected that Officer Dare never record a conversation with a public official or police officer without notifying them beforehand.

V. Potential consequences for continuing the unacceptable behavior:

The Progressive Disciplinary System will be initiated and negative or punitive discipline may be recommended for any further incidents, similar in nature, in which you are involved.

VI. Provisions for follow-up consultations:

This counseling memorandum will be placed in your squad training file. If, after a period of six months there are no further incidents of a similar nature, this memo will be purged from your training file and the matter will be considered closed.
