Sirs,

On August 19, 2017 at approximately 0227 hrs, multiple units were dispatched to the area of [REDACTED] (Lansing St & Mohawk St) for a shots fired. We immediately located the victim/caller [REDACTED] who stated that a male he knows to be [REDACTED] had shot him in the left shin outside the bar. He said that [REDACTED] ran into the second floor apartment above the bar.

Long story short we set up a perimeter, began canvassing and located a single 9mm casing in the roadway. Within the first hour we also spoke with [REDACTED], owner of [REDACTED] who said that the second floor apartments are all vacant but a [REDACTED] used to live there. [REDACTED] confirmed to me multiple times that the apartments were all vacant and no one should be up there. Inv. Donaldson then requested he sign a search waiver for these apartments along with the key. [REDACTED] agreed and signed the waiver.

Once the Waiver was signed we developed a plan to conduct a slow and deliberate search of the second floor. Officer Flanagan and I grabbed the shields from unit 50 and 40 and were followed by Sgt. Goldstein, Officer Bubnis, Officer Parkosewich and Inv. Donaldson. Once on the second floor landing we made contact with the suspect [REDACTED] and a J [REDACTED] in apartment 1. Both were taken into custody without incident. We then cleared the remaining apartments and ended up locating a loaded 9mm pistol, a large quantity of U.S. currency and a large quantity of what appeared to be crack cocaine.

[REDACTED] was later tested for GSR which tested positive.

A firearms permit tab was created for [REDACTED]

Dear Chief Williams:

The purpose of this letter is to share with you a very positive experience my husband and I had with contacting the Utica Police on Sunday October 9th during one of the most frightening experiences we have had since moving back to my home town of Utica 14 years ago.

About 4:30 a.m. Sunday morning October 9th my husband was awakened by a strange sounding noise at first he could not tell where the noise was coming from and he thought it might be that an animal had gotten in the house - my husband is a cancer survivor but has heart issues stemming from chemo therapy treatments and is not in the best of health.

He could see that our bathroom door (right off our bedroom) was closed and he knew he did not close it. He could now hear some noise coming from that room he forced open the door open up against a small built man wearing a black hoodie which was hanging very low - he could not see the man's face he grabbed him by the arm. At this point I awakened and go right up and saw my husband holding this man's arm and escorting him out toward our dining room the man broke loose of my husband's grip on his arm and we couldn't see exactly where he went but he was headed toward the kitchen - one of the ways out of the house is through the door to our kitchen which leads to both our cellar and outside side entrance door. I always check all three doors leading to the outside of our house for some reason that night I was extra tired and must have forgotten to lock the side entrance door!

We called 911 and explained the situation they summoned the police for us and stayed on the phone with us until the officers came (which was very quickly) and checked the outside of the house and then came to our front door. There were 2 officers that came initially I wish I could have gotten their names one male and one female they were so nice and calming and reassuring. I told them I was concerned that the man may have gone down into the basement. They called for another officer to come which he did right away and gun in hand he checked our basement. Thank God no one was there.

We found a screw driver in the driveway next to one of the basement windows and noticed the screen was cut. We didn't notice anything missing in our house at that point.

That evening my husband was suffering from terrible leg cramps and I went in the bathroom to get one of his muscle relaxer pills and noticed the bottle was empty, then I checked his nausea pill bottle it was empty, same thing with his anti-anxiety and pain pills. I just couldn't believe it the man must have been after his drugs! I called the police dept. back and told them what happened and they sent Officer Schiavi (not sure if I am spelling this correctly) to take photos of the bottles and he checked for finger prints on the drawer where the pill were stored. He was very polite and understanding of all that happened to us.

I wanted to take the time to congratulate you on the swiftness of action that took place and the compassion and professionalism that we were shown by your team members.

We are very grateful that no one was hurt and that we were able to retrieve his medicine in a timely manner thanks to everyone who worked with us.

I hope you will share this letter with whoever is responsible for the wonderful people who handled our case and all the people involved that came to our aid we are so grateful to everyone!



Officer Joseph Aiello arrived on scene and deployed his department-issued tourniquet above the wound site and was able to slow the bleeding until paramedics arrived.

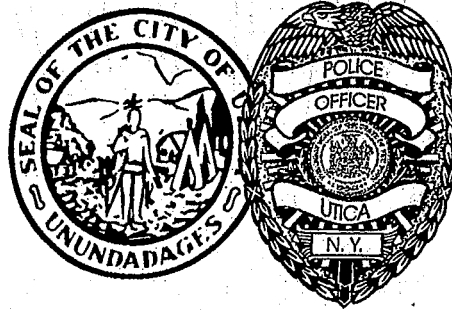

On August 31, 2018, at approximately 2:45 a.m., Dispatch advised of a home invasion that had just occurred on Leslie Ave. It was reported that two men had entered the residence armed with handguns and fled after tying up the victims and burglarizing the home. While multiple units were en route, dispatch was advising BOLO information of the suspect vehicle. Officer Patrick Murphy spotted the vehicle, it immediately tried to evade him and a vehicle pursuit was initiated.

The pursuit continued through most of South Utica and into New Hartford. The driver crashed the vehicle and continued to flee on foot, jumping fences in yards with Officers Brian Baye and Murphy in close pursuit. Officer Harrington arrived and cut him off after he jumped another fence. He then held the suspect at gun point until Officers Baye and Murphy caught up and took him into custody. A subsequent search of the suspect's vehicle led to the recovery of a loaded 9mm handgun as well as other articles of evidence relative to the home invasion.

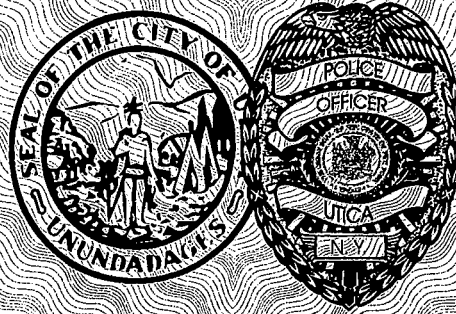

The officers noticed a male walking in the area in the roadway, which is a violation of NYS VTL. Officers Bubnis and Murphy attempted to stop the male subject to address the violation and interview him regarding the reports of shots fired / armed person brandishing a handgun. 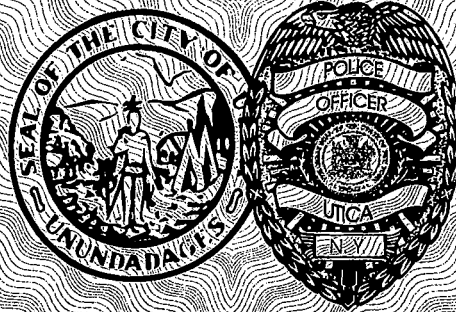

On September 8, 2015, several units were dispatched to a Cornhill area convenience store regarding an armed robbery. Upon arrival, Sergeant Frank Sarchilli, Officer Joshua Harrington and Officer Patrick Murphy spoke with the store clerk. The clerk stated that two males entered the store, one displaying a silver in color revolver handgun and ordered the clerk to give them the money. The two males removed proceeds from the register and fled the scene. The officers then reviewed the store video surveillance and were able to give a detailed description out to other units but were unable to locate the suspects.

On September 9, 2015, while on patrol, Officers Harrington and Murphy noticed two males on bicycles matching the description of the two armed robbers. When the officers approached, the males began to flee through the yards. Sergeant Sarchilli, Sergeant Starr Rae Wooden and Officers Harrington and Murphy gave chase. Officer Murphy was able to detain one of the males in the Cornhill area of the city. This male was attired in the same clothing that he wore the night before during the robbery. He was positively identified as a juvenile and was then turned over to Investigator Jeremy Van Horne. Investigator Van Horne was able to interview this juvenile with a parent present and secured a complete confession to the armed robbery. With information given from the confession, Investigator William Williams was able to develop a possible second suspect. After completing a photo array, he did in fact identify the second male involved in the armed robbery, who was identified as an adult. CID Investigators Gary Taurisani and John Scaramuzzino then took over the case. After this second suspect was located, they were also able to secure a complete confession from him to the armed robbery. Due to the magnitude of this incident, both males were charged as adults with Robbery in the first degree.

The cooperation and teamwork between these three units enabled two dangerous criminals to be removed from the city streets. Their dedication to the investigation and keeping the city safe, brings honor to themselves and to the Utica Police Department.

Officers Funicello, Harrington and Murphy bring honor to themselves and the entire Utica Police Department.

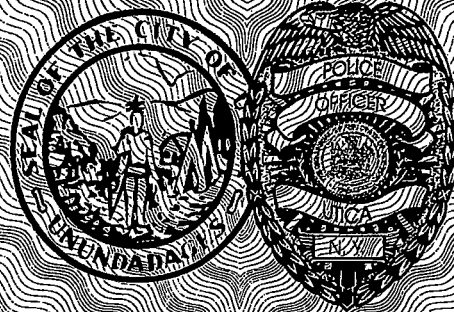

On March 17, 2014 at 5:00 a.m., Officer Harrington was dispatched to a structure fire on Gray Ave. When the officer arrived, he found a female yelling from the second floor that her apartment was on fire. He also saw two young boys hanging outside the windows. Officer Harrington ran to the second floor and encountered heavy smoke. When he attempted to enter the door, he was pushed back by the heat. The fire and smoke grew so strong that the officer was pushed from the building and advised responding fire crews of the situation.

Using that information, the fire crew was able to use a ladder and pull the family from the building. Officer Harrington further aided the victims by running the children to waiting ambulances. DISCIPLINE AGREEMENT

This **DISCIPLINE AGREEMENT** (hereinafter "Agreement") is made and entered into by and between Toshua Henry (hereinafter "Employee"), **JOHN E. CREEDON POLICE BENEVOLENT ASSOCIATION, INC.** ("Union" or "PBA") and the **CITY OF UTICA** (collectively, hereinafter "City" or "Employer"), this 9 day of April 2021.

WHEREAS, the City and the Union are parties to a collective bargaining agreement ("CBA") covering the period April 1, 2016 to March 31, 2021, which contains a negotiated discipline procedure;

WHEREAS, the Employee is currently employed by the City in its Police Department as a Police Officer and is a member of the Union;

WHEREAS, the City sought to impose discipline on the Employee under Civil Service Law ("CSL") § 75 for serious misconduct arising out of Employee's participation in an illegal "blue flu" strike in violation of CSL § 210.1 from September 25-September 27, 2020 when the Employee called in sick and refused to report for his/her tour of duty without justification ("Misconduct");

WHEREAS, following negotiations, the Employee agrees to accept the certain discipline to resolve the Misconduct and to avoid further proceedings and/or litigation.

NOW, in consideration of the mutual covenants and promises contained herein, the parties agree as follows:

1. This Agreement is not precedent setting.
2. For good and valuable consideration recited below, the Employee admits that s/he committed the above Misconduct and agrees to elect and accept one of the following forms of discipline:

[EMPLOYEE TO INITIAL ONE]



Five (5) calendar day unpaid suspension, to be served at the election of the Police Chief; or


— A fine equal to five (5) calendar days of the Employee's current gross pay, to be deducted from the Employee's bi-weekly paychecks over a one (1) month period until fully paid, effective immediately.


3. The Employee agrees and understands that the discipline imposed herein is in addition to the "two-for-one" payroll deductions previously imposed pursuant to a certain agreement made between the City and Union to settle the illegal strike.

4. In consideration of the foregoing, the City agrees to forgo other, more serious discipline, to include a longer unpaid suspension or dismissal.
5. The Employee and Union, agree that they will not commence, file or maintain a grievance, action, special proceeding, challenge, objection, appeal or improper practice charge in any court, arbitration, Public Employment Relations Board, or other forum, arising out of or pertaining to the Misconduct or discipline imposed.
6. Employee irrevocably waives, releases and withdraws his rights to due process discipline proceedings arising out of or pertaining to the Misconduct or discipline imposed pursuant to: CSL § 75; the negotiated discipline procedure under the CBA; applicable City policies; Police Department rules or regulations; or applicable federal, state or local laws.
7. The Employee acknowledges that he voluntarily enters into this Agreement without any coercion or duress, by any party or the representative of any party. By entering into this Agreement, the Employee acknowledges that he has read and considered each of the provisions of this Agreement and he voluntarily enters into this Agreement with full knowledge of the consequences. The Employee acknowledges that he had sufficient time to consider the provisions of this Agreement and to consult with the Union and an attorney of his choice prior to executing this Agreement.
8. In the event that a party challenges the enforcement of this Agreement, including the Misconduct findings, the discipline imposed or the releases provided, said challenge shall not be subject to the CBA's grievance procedure and shall instead be venued in the Oneida County Supreme Court. The prevailing party in said challenge shall recover from the losing party all costs incurred, including attorneys' fees, in defending against any such challenge.
9. This Agreement may be signed in counterparts.
