

I am writing on behalf of the Utica Police Department concerning Officer Kyle Piersall, Badge # 6723, who is currently assigned to the Tactical Unit. Officer Piersall was assigned to the Tactical Unit in 2016.

The UPD is not aware of any potential impeachment information regarding Officer Piersall to include: agency or judicial findings of misconduct relating to truth, bias or integrity; substantive violations of law, Department policy or procedure; or pending investigations. Additionally, Officer Piersall has not been previously convicted of a misdemeanor crime of domestic violence as it pertains to Title 18, U.S.C., Section 922(g)(9). Prior to employment, the UPD conducted a thorough background investigation, including an FBI fingerprint check and no derogatory information was uncovered. Further, Officer Piersall has no delinquent financial obligations and has met all of the hiring and drug use policy requirements. Officer Piersall's last qualification date for firearms was in September 2017.

After a review of Officer Piersall's personnel file and character, the UPD can confirm that Officer Piersall is suitable for assignment with the DEA/Task Force. Officer Piersall has been employed in good standing with the UPD for four years. On March 28th, 2017, Investigator Aaron Donaldson received information via a confidential informant that four males were walking on Gray Ave., and that one of the males was in possession of a sawed-off shotgun.

Investigator Donaldson proceeded to the area, and soon thereafter located the males in question. He relayed his findings to members of the Tactical Unit who were assisting him with this investigation. TAC members Sergeant James Grande, Officer Sean Bubnis, Officer Paul Dewey, Officer Jessica Dodge, Officer Michael Mahay and Officer Kyle Piersall with the assistance of Officer Dennis Basler from C Squad, attempted to conduct a stop of the parties. Two of the males fled toward City Street while the other two were successfully stopped.

During the investigation of the two detained individuals, Officer Basler conducted pat frisks. In doing so, he felt what he soon learned to be a sawed-off shotgun, as described by the informant, in the front of one subject's pants. That individual was immediately arrested, brought to headquarters, and charged with several felonies.

On Thursday, July 13, 2017, PO Piersall observed an apparent hand to hand transaction in the parking lot of the Foodland located at Court St and Schuyler St. A male party involved in the hand to hand transaction began to walk from the parking lot. This male is Anthony C. Zammiello. PO Piersall conducted a citizen stop of Zammiello in front of 924 Stark St, based upon his observations. During the initial conversation, Zammiello handed PO Piersall an amount of greenish-brown vegetation consistent with marijuana. Zammiello's demeanor indicated that he was going to attempt to flee the stop. Sgt. S. Berger arrived as back up and based upon Zammiello's furtive movements, the decision was made to detain Zammiello using handcuffs. When advised to place his hands behind his back, Zammiello refused to do so and began to actively prevent officers from handcuffing him. Officers took Zammiello to the ground and using body pressure, were able to get Zammiello handcuffed without further incident.

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On Thursday July 20th I received a Civilian Complaint Report from the desk officer, PO Parkosewich upon my arrival at work. PO Parkosewich advised me that the complaint had been dropped off at approximately 1600 hrs by the complainant, Darryl Drone [REDACTED]. In the complaint Drone alleges that PO Piersall stopped him due to the vehicle he was driving (unknown how this pertains to the allegations). Drone believes this to be the case due to PO Piersall "eyeing" his vehicle on Tracy St and subsequently stopping it on Oneida St near Walker St. Drone acknowledges that PO Piersall explained the reason for the stop (VTL Infractions) but alleges "abuse of authority" and "racial profiling" played a part in the stop. The original Civilian Complaint Report (UPD-132) was placed under the door of the Professional Standards Unit. I will complete the associated fact finding investigation into the incident which will be reported to Lt B Bansner.

On 2/3/18 at about 0005 hours, units were dispatched to 640 Varick St (Lukin's) regarding a fight. Upon arrival the victim was uncooperative. Security advised officers that a male who is now known to be Daryl Ferguson, was the aggressor and was attempting to re-enter the bar. Officer Piersall and Gomez approached the male as he was attempting to fight a bouncer at the door. Once PO Gomez made contact with Ferguson, Ferguson began struggling with the bouncer and then pushed PO Piersall. At this time PO Piersall advised that he was under arrest and Ferguson began to actively resist arrest. PO Piersall and Gomez were attempting to take Ferguson to the ground at which time Sgt Phillips attempted to assist and utilized a hard hand strike to Ferguson. This force was effective and officers were able to get Ferguson to the ground, where he was able to be handcuffed. Once in handcuffs, all force ended and Ferguson was transported to the station. PO Weir secured photographs of the scene and of Ferguson at HQ. At HQ I attempted to interview Ferguson, who was highly intoxicated and belligerent. He refused to answer any questions and was only yelling at me about what his charges were. PO Piersall and PO Gomez's response to resistance investigation will be handled by Sgt Goldstein and Sgt Phillips Response to resistance and Exposure to be handled by Lt. D'Ambro. Sgt Phillips refused medical treatment at this time (complaint of pain to left knee and elbow and a small cut to his right index finger.)

On 4/19/18 at about 2040 hours car 25, PO Piersall and PO Basler were patrolling the area of the 1500 block of Dudley Ave when they observed two black males walking in the roadway and consuming what they believed to be open containers of alcohol. They attempted to conduct a stop of the two parties (Ramel Lockwood and Kerry Lockwood). Upon stopping the parties, One party who was later identified as Ramel Lockwood [REDACTED] was reaching in his pockets and attempting to put distance between the officers and himself. Due to this location being known for illegal activity including weapons possession and narcotics related offenses they believed that Lockwood was attempting to conceal possible contraband and asked him to remove his hands from his pockets and to provide them with identification. Lockwood then immediately fled south and then east into the driveway of 1521 Dudley Ave. Officers gave chase and caught up to Ramel in the driveway and PO Piersall utilized a take down. Once on the ground Ramel Lockwood continued to actively resist

arrest and failed to comply with officers commands. He grabbed ahold of PO Baslers uniform near his upper chest and grabbed at his duty belt. At this time PO Basler utilized two hard hand strikes to the left side of Ramel's head area. This gained compliance and Lockwood was placed in handcuffs without further escalation of force. Ramel Lockwood was found to have a quantity of suspected marihuana as well as a corner knotted bag with three smaller clear corner knotted bags, each containing an off white chunky substance consist to crack cocaine. This contraband was in his left jacket pocket. He was also found to be in possession of \$1315.00 in US currency. Kerry Lockwood was issued an appearance ticket for Open Container on scene and released.

I responded to the scene and spoke to Ramel Lockwood. He stated that he was not injured and did not need medical attention. I had PO Talerico secure photographs of the scene. There were several belligerent parties in the area that were arguing with officers and being hostile. They did not wish to speak about what happened and were only yelling obscenities and arguing with officers. Car 25 transported Ramel to HQ where he was turned over to the booking officer. I contacted Inv. Detraglia, who responded to charge Lockwood with the narcotics offenses.

At HQ I again interviewed Ramel Lockwood. He stated he was not injured and did not need medical attention. He did not wish to speak to me about what had occurred. Photographs were then secured of him at the station. All photographs were downloaded into the proper folder.

All BWC footage was downloaded, viewed and tagged.

Ramel Lockwood was charged with Walking in the Road, Open Container, Littering, Obstructing, Resisting, Harassment, UPM, CPCS 7th, CPCS 5th and CPCS 3rd. Supervisor form to be completed along with UOF investigation.

On 9/26/18 at about 1947 hours car 25, PO Dewey and PO Piersall were patrolling the area of Rutger St near John St when they observed a maroon colored Dodge Magnum bearing NY [REDACTED] traveling at a high rate of speed east bound on Rutger St. As the vehicle passed by them they also noted that the vehicle had illegal window tint. Due to these violations the officers turned their patrol car around in order to conduct a stop of the vehicle. Officers stated that as they turned the car around it appeared as if the maroon Magnum began to pick up speed and then turned north onto First St. Officers activated their lights in order to conduct a stop of the vehicle.

The vehicle pulled into the driveway of 318 Lansing St which is on the First St side of the residence. PO Dewey and Piersall advised that the operator who they now know to be Emanuel Reed [REDACTED] immediately exited the vehicle and began to flee north on First St and then west on Lansing St and then into the rear yards in between 316 and 318 Lansing St. Officers pursued him and Reed attempted to get back to his vehicle. Once at his vehicle he observed PO Piersall chasing him and Reed again fled to the rear yard of 316 Lansing St where he slipped into the wet grass and fell to the ground. At this time PO Piersall also fell to the ground due to the wet grass. Reed continued to flee and PO Piersall was able to get on top of him. Reed had his hands under his body and would not immediately comply with PO Piersall's commands, so PO Piersall drew his duty weapon and held it at the low ready and told Reed to stop resisting, while he sat on Reed's back and kept downward pressure to Reed's upper back with his left hand and knee. PO Dewey then arrived to assist PO Piersall place Reed into handcuffs without further incident. PO Piersall had his gun at the low ready and was not directly pointed at Reed during this incident.

Once in custody Reed was placed in the rear of car 25. I responded to the scene and was advised by officers of what had transpired. I assisted officers with a search of the immediate area where Reed's flight path was. PO Piersall pointed out to me the direct path Reed took from his vehicle to the rear yard of 316 Lansing St where he was taken into custody. A quantity of crack cocaine was located near where Reed was taken into custody. The contraband appeared dry and everything else was wet due to rain. The thermal imager was utilized by me and PO Dewey and we saw that the contraband illuminated white indicating that it was warmer than its surroundings.

Photographs were secured of the contraband, the scene, the vehicle on scene and the Contraband was collected.

Reed was transported to HQ where he was turned over to the booking officer.

At HQ I interviewed Reed. I asked if he was injured and he said no. I asked if he needed medical attention and he stated no. I then asked if he wanted to talk to me about what happened. He told me he had been drinking so he ran from police and fell down in a rear yard. He had no complaints.

BWC footage was downloaded and tagged. PO Dewey's BWC fell off immediately at the beginning of the foot pursuit and did not capture any footage until he retrieved after Reed was in custody.

All photographs were downloaded into the proper folder.

Due to the amount of suspected narcotics that was located, Inv Desens was contacted by Lt Bansner regarding the arrest and he responded to HQ.

Ultimately Reed was charged with UTTs' for tinted windows and speeding, Obstructing Governmental Administration 2nd, Resisting Arrest, CPCS 3rd, CPCS 4th and CPCS 7th. Response to resistance completed by PO Piersall regarding empty hand control of Reed.

Investigation pending.
