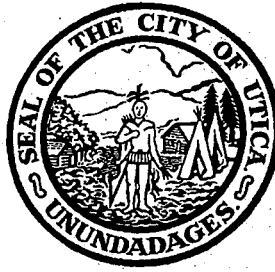

During this observation period Sgt. Curley used 0 sick days. Is attendance is excellent as is his punctuality. He is always early for work and available to respond to work at a moment's notice.

When a major incident is occurring, Sgt. Curley is undoubtedly either already on the scene or en-route. He regularly puts his personal life on hold for the needs of the department. If there is a need for CID supervision, he is the most reliable supervisor there is. He also makes himself constantly available to the media and other outlets as the department's Public Information Officer. This includes constant phone calls and messages for media personnel and regular early morning radio/tv interviews.

As a CID Night supervisor, Sgt. Curley regularly finds himself involved in high stress incidents. He always remains calm and collective and exhibits excellent command presence in front of his subordinates. He appropriately uses the resources available to him, or calls for additional resources when necessary.

Sgt. Curley is our agency's GIVE coordinator. He has been involved in nearly every aspect of the program since its inception over seven years ago. He has many responsibilities with the role, to include, but not limited to yearly grant submissions, quarterly reporting, monthly meetings, and daily oversight of two GIVE investigators and the Strike Teams. Being a former GIVE investigator Sgt. Curly understands the nuances of gun work, and imparts that knowledge and experience to his investigators.

Sgt. Curley often runs our lead desk during homicide investigations. With this duty he greatly understands the delegation of duty process and executes it excellently.

Sgt. Curley is and has been a valuable member of CID for many years in both the investigator and sergeant capacity. He is undoubtedly the most reliable supervisor in the division. Sgt. Curley is well known for taking on many responsibilities, at times to his detriment. He can best improve his performance by focusing on his supervisor role in CID, and impart knowledge and enthusiasm to investigators in the Night shift who at times can be complacent. Sgt Curley can also slow his decision making during high stress

situations, when time permits. This will allow him to evaluate all options and make sound decisions based on reason and experience. CID Supervisors should also be cognizant of their investigator's investigative management caseload and regularly audit the module.

Dear Chief Williams:

In my years as a prosecutor the murder of [REDACTED] on July [REDACTED] 2019 and the method thereof, is possibly one of the most disturbing cases I have ever reviewed. The work of every officer involved from the Utica Police Department was thorough and impressive- the work of Captain Coramato, Sergeant Curley, and Investigator Paladino to name a few. However, I have felt compelled to write this letter to you commending the work of Patrolman Zasa and Investigator Mahay in particular, due to their first-rate response on the day of the murder.

Patrolman Zasa was the first to arrive on scene. It is clear from the body worn camera footage that he was able to keep the armed defendant calm, and ask appropriate questions while searching the area for the victim as well as other possible suspects. Patrolman Zasa single-handedly holds the scene for approximately seven minutes, as backup was delayed due to obstacles posed by the [REDACTED]. In short, his performance was exemplary.

Investigator Mahay was also on scene that day. It was his keen observation of the defendant's unlocked cell phone for which he should be applauded. Investigator Mahay collected the defendant's cell phone and for a number of hours tapped the screen every couple of minutes in an effort to prevent the phone from locking while other members of your department obtained a search warrant. Investigator Mahay then conducted a forensic analysis and recovered the strongest piece of evidence my prosecutors have had in any case- a video of the murder itself.

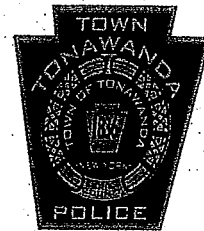
At all times, from the beginning of the investigation underlying this prosecution until the defendant pled guilty to Murder in the Second Degree, both officers displayed the utmost professionalism and their preparation prior to giving testimony was obvious.

The combined hard work of all of the police officers within your department allowed my prosecutors to seek the maximum sentence in this case; but please convey to both Patrolman Zasa and Investigator Mahay that their on scene, quick responses were exceptional and did not go unnoticed.



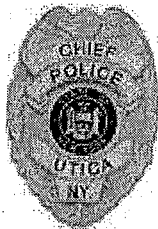

- Engaging in mini staff meetings with me about community issues.

At the end of the week, these officers gave a presentation to our members and opened the floor for any questions. At the end of this presentation, it was clear to them and our members, that their work that week would go a long way if our members happen to see them outside of the club.

"Are the rest of UPD as cool as you guys."

"I always thought cops were not cool, but you two are totally different."

"If we had more interactions with the police like today, that would be fine, you guys are not so bad."

On January 19, 2014, both the Oriskany St. Fastrac and N. Utica Hess gas stations were robbed at gunpoint by a single unknown male. Thus began a tireless investigation conducted by members of the Criminal Investigation Division into identifying and arresting this male. Early on in the investigation, it was determined that the same male suspect had perpetrated both robberies on the 19th. Through numerous interviews and meetings with police contacts, viable suspect information was developed.

Once the suspect was positively identified as the perpetrator of the Fastrac robbery, the CID Investigators actively sought the male to take him into custody and answer for his actions. On February 18, 2014, surveillance commenced at locations known to be frequented by the suspect and his female girlfriend accomplice. During this cooperative detail, the suspect and female accomplice were located and arrested without incident. During the subsequent interviews of the offenders, probable cause was developed and each individual was charged in connection with both robberies.

Due to their diligent work ethic and commitment to justice as well as their ability to cultivate information and work as a team, two individuals were arrested in connection with the violent felonies.

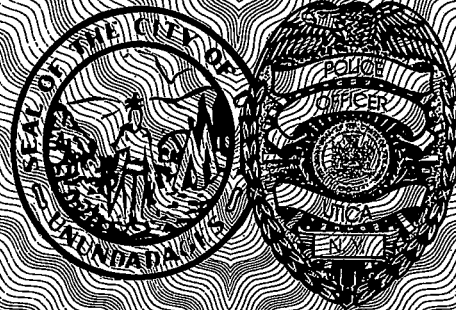

On 1/8/13 at 16:50 hours Officer Kerry Carville was off duty attending a basketball game at Donovan Junior High School. Officer Michael Curley was working as a School Resource Officer at the same game. Officer Carville saw an individual leaving the basketball game and as that party was leaving the game, he dropped an object on the floor, picked it up and left the gym. Officer Carville recognized the object as a black colored handgun. Officer Carville alerted Officer Curley, drew her handgun and ran towards this male announcing that she was a police officer. Officer Carville ordered him to stop. Officer Carville yelled, "Police, gun, gun, gun". The male refused to adhere to the commands of Officer Carville and ran from her and Officer Curley outside of the school to the parking circle. The Officers ordered the suspect several times to stop and drop the gun. The individual chose to ignore the commands and pointed the gun directly at Officer Carville.

At this point Officer Carville felt she was going to be shot. She side-stepped and sought cover behind a small tree, all the while she and Officer Curley continued yelling commands to the suspect to drop the gun. The suspect finally dropped the gun and was taken in to custody. Further investigation revealed the handgun was in fact a BB gun. It was identical in size and shape to an actual Colt Officer's Model 1911 .45 Caliber handgun but it was in fact a BB gun. Given the manner in which it was carried and displayed, it was impossible for PO Carville and PO Curley to know it was not a deadly weapon. The cool professionalism displayed by PO Carville and PO Curley in what could have been a highly dangerous incident with potentially tragic consequences prevented that very useless tragedy from occurring. Their quick response to the threat of an apparent deadly weapon in a crowded public area at Donovan Middle School reflects greatly upon their character and dedication to the safety of our community above their own safety. Their willingness to place themselves in harms way without regard for their own personal safety reflects great credit upon themselves and upon the Utica Police Department. I believe their professional conduct in the face of potentially deadly physical force is worthy of commendation for Exceptional Duty Service in this situation.

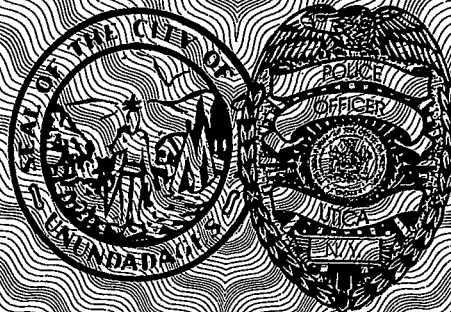
