
On August 21, 2017, Investigator Aaron Donaldson and Officers Michael Mahay, Christopher Manion, Paul Dewey, Dennis Basler and Tyler Sheppard were assigned to a GIVE Strike Team detail targeting "Hot Spot" locations of recent shooting incidents in the City of Utica. While in the east Utica area, Investigator Donaldson and Officers Dewey and Mahay observed three known GIVE Offenders riding bicycles in violation of several Vehicle & Traffic Law statutes. The three offenders were known to be associated with a violent group in the city believed to be responsible for multiple recent shots fired incidents. Investigator Donaldson notified Officers Manion, Basler and Sheppard of their observations and intentions to make a stop of the individuals.

Working together, the units made a coordinated effort to track and stop the group several blocks from where they were first observed. When the officers initiated contact, the three males began to flee on foot. One male in particular, who was believed to have been involved in several shooting incidents, was observed discarding a handgun in the roadway as he was fleeing the officers. After a foot pursuit and struggle to handcuff, three of the pursuing officers took the individual into custody. A loaded handgun was recovered and the other two suspects were charged accordingly.

The arrest of the violent gun offender had implications on several other gun-involved incidents in the city. He was ultimately convicted at trial for his crimes and sentenced to several years in prison. The officers' keen observation skills, ability to work as a team, and commitment to combating gun violence removed a violent gun offender from the streets and undoubtedly curbed gun violence in the City of Utica.



On November 4th 2017 at approximately 2345 hrs Car 25, PO Dewey and PO Sheppard attempted to stop a white in color four door vehicle incident to a report of shots fired in the area of James St and Dudley Ave. Upon activating their emergency lights the vehicle failed to comply and fled the stop. The subsequent vehicle pursuit ended when the suspect, Keevin Houlder stopped his vehicle at Rutger St and Mohawk St. Based on the circumstances of the incident, Sgt Grande and PO Dewey approached with their service weapons drawn and pointed at Houlder. ### Summary:

On 12/22/17 at about 2250 hours, car 26, PO Dewey and PO Sheppard observed who they know to be Nathaniel Sessome exit a vehicle on Mohawk St and Blandina St. PO Austin was in contact with car 26 and advised that Sessome had an active warrant from Onondaga County for Violation of Probation, which was extraditable throughout New York State. Due to the active warrant, PO Austin began surveillance of the vehicle so that officer could conduct a stop to take Sessome into custody. about 2256 hours PO Austin advised that Sessome had re-entered the vehicle and the vehicle began to travel South on Mohawk St toward Rutger St. Car 25, PO Mahay advised that the operator was Anthony Kenny-Oliver and that he had knowledge that he was driving with his driving privileges suspended. A vehicle stop was conducted on Mohawk St just south of Rutger St. The vehicle was a gray Nissan bearing NY Immediately Officers approached both the drivers side and passenger side. The occupants were identified as Anthony Kenny Oliver (Driver), Nathaniel Sessome (Passenger) and Jamar Sessome (rear passenger). Kenny was taken into custody without incident regarding him driving on a suspended license. When officers has Nathaniel Sessome exit the vehicle, he was advised that he was under arrest for the open warrant and was placed in handcuffs. Officers used 3 sets of handcuffs, due to officers knowing that Sessome had previously been shot and had little use of his left arm. Once in cuffs Sessome threw himself onto the ground and began screaming that his arm hurt and that officers were assaulting him. At no point were any officers assaulting Sessome. He then immediately became belligerent and screamed that he needed to go the hospital due to pain in his arms. Officers attempted to help him up out of the snow and Sessome again threw himself down to the ground while yelling at the officers that he needed an ambulance. I advised him that we could have an ambulance meet us at the station to evaluate him. He refused and again began screaming that his arm hurt. At this time I notified Dispatch to responded UFD for an evaluation of Sessome on scene. continued to be courteous and explain to Sessome that they had not done anything to him. He then began to flail himself around on the ground and yell that UPD is beating him. At no time were any officers using force against him. Sessome had a very strong odor of an alcoholic beverage on his breath and appeared intoxicated. Officers then again attempted to help him up out of the snow and he began to attempt to hit his head off of the back window of the car saying that officers were doing it to him. At no time were officers hitting Sessomes head into the window. Sessome then again through himself on the ground. UFD arrived on scene to evaluate him. Bianco and Kennedy from UFD treated Sessome. He was belligerent toward them and only continued to scream and be uncooperative. I believed all of his actions up to this point were in an attempt to not be arrested on the warrant and he thought he would go to the hospital and get released. During the entire encounter, Sessome was making false statements that officers were using force and "beating him". I was on scene the entire time of the incident and at no point did officers utilize force and were trying to assist him up and out of the snow.

Once the ambulance arrived on scene, Sessome was transported to St Elizabeth Hospital. PO Austin, PO Dewey and PO Sheppard also went to the hospital to maintain custody of Sessome. I notified Lt Holt in the Squad Commander officers regarding Sessome going to the hospital and he made contact with Onondaga County to arrange transfer of custody. I was advised that it was approved to meet half way to transfer custody once Sessome was discharged from the hospital.

PO Mahay secured photographs of the scene and attempted to secure photos at the hospital of Sessome but was unsuccessful due to him being totally uncooperative. All photographs were downloaded under RMS number 17-55828.

At the hospital Sessome continued to be loud and belligerent. He was yelling at ER staff and refused certain nurses to assist in treating him. He continually changed what his complaint of pain and injury was. It was his arm then his chest, then he could not breath. Dr. Joseph Freedman treated Sessome and stated that there were no apparent injuries and diagnosed him with a complaint of pain. Sessome was discharged from the hospital and transported and transferred over to Onondaga County at exit 33 by car 26.

All BWC footage was downloaded and viewed and tagged regarding the incident (7761, 5181, 6723,2342 and 3486). All officers are to complete comprehensive narratives regarding the incident. PO Austin placed copies of the discharged paperwork into records.

Officer Sheppard and Officer Kellogg conducted a MV Stop of Gerbino at approximately 1344 hours while at the intersection of Lenox Ave. and Wager St.

I did not note any issues with the manner in which Gerbino was searched (incident to arrest) on scene by the officers.

The only property provided to the officers was a photocopy of his DLIC because he did not have his physical license on his person.

I did not note any property being removed from the vehicle during the inventory search.

On January 11th, 2019 at 0954 hours I called Ann Ryan at message on her answering machine for either her or Mr. Gerbino to contact me.

On January 11th, 2019 at 1030 hours I received a call back from Mrs. Ryan who advised me that she would pass my message along to Mr. Gerbino to have him contact me.

On January 11th, 2019 at approximately 1130 hours I received a call from Mr. Gerbino on my desk phone. Mr. Gerbino made the following statements pertaining to his interaction with the Police Officers who had arrested him on January 9th, 2019:

--The officer who searched him violated his rights and searched him up in his "balls and anus" and he had on blue gloves when he was searching him

--The two officers are loose cannons

--Vehicle registration, house keys and personal papers are missing from the vehicle --The officers were very unprofessional and "stone cold"

--He sat in the back of the police car for 20 minutes with music blasting in his ear before being transported to the station

 $\mbox{--At}$  the station he asked for help getting out of the patrol car and the officer said, "fuck you"

After Mr. Gerbino made the above statements to me, I advised him that I watched the BWC footage from start to finish and some of the statements he was making were not truthful based on what I had observed on the footage. Mr. Gerbino became somewhat agitated and then began to continually press for a copy of the BWC footage which I advised him that I did not have the authority to release to him but I would be more than happy to have him come in to UPD headquarters where I would allow him to watch the footage. I also advised Mr. Gerbino that if he wished he could also file a formal complaint against the officers unless he was satisfied with the information I was providing him. Mr. Gerbino refused to come to the station to file a formal complaint and only stated he needed to consult his attorney prior to doing so. I then advised Mr. Gerbino that he could bring his attorney to the station as well and he could complete the complaint form in his attorney's presence. Mr. Gerbino refused and when specifically asked if he wished to file a formal complaint he would not answer the question.

I advised Mr. Gerbino that I would be filing the complaint on his behalf but I would prefer he respond to headquarters to file the complaint himself. Again Mr. Gerbino refused to come to the station.

Furthermore, I asked Mr. Gerbino if he would like to speak directly with our Professional Standards Unit however he refused.

I then completed the UPD Personnel Complaint Form on his behalf and same was turned over to PSU along with this narrative attached.

On July 18th 2019 PO T Sheppard and PO K Murphy conducted a vehicle stop of NY reg a red in color SUV on Oswego St at Lenox Ave. While speaking with the operator of the vehicle, officers noted the odor of marijuana emanating from within the vehicle. Based on this odor the occupants would be searched for contraband. During the search of the front seat passenger, who was identified as Boyd Williams, he attempted to flee on foot northbound. PO T Sheppard and PO K Murphy were forced to utilize a takedown technique in the grassy area to the north in order to gain a position of advantage. Once on the ground, Williams continued to actively resist arrest by refusing to place his hands behind his back and trying to stand back up to flee. Lawrence was then helped up and walked to the rear of car 26. At the rear door, he refused to get in the car and began to fight with officers again. At this time several officers were attempting to place him in the car and during the struggle their duty belts scraped against the rear drivers side quarter panel of car 26, causing several scratches. I responded to the passenger side of car 26 and grabbed ahold of Lawrence's wrist

as PO Desens utilized a come along and we were able to get him seated in the rear of car 26.

During the incident, Lawrence grabbed PO Kellogg and was kicking at several officers

The call was for a burglary that had just occurred. While officers were responding tac unit officers observed a male carrying a purse. When stopping the male he discarded the purse. The purse is confirmed to be the purse from the burglary. Inv Kelly then charges the suspect, Mark McDermott accordingly.

In reviewing all reports and evidence related to this incident it appears as though police services were provided in a competent and professional manner while in accordance with Utica Police Department, Policy and Procedure and State and Federal laws. The allegations of this complaint have not been verified by facts and at this time. I am unable to establish any basis for sustaining this complaint. Should any further information be obtained to contradict any information contained in this report, I will prepare an addendum report and re-evaluate my recommendation at that time.

On August 19th, 2019, I Lt. Brian D. Bansner was made aware by the Squad Commander that Anthony V. Zumbo was in the lobby and wished to speak with me. I responded to the squad commanders office, retrieved BWC SP1 and then escorted Zumbo to the Patrol Workstation where I conducted an interview of him.

I spoke to Zumbo mainly regarding this incident(19-29589) in which Zumbo was issued an Appearance Ticket for Exposure of a Person by PO Tyler Sheppard/PO Ray Kellogg. Zumbo advised me that his ex-girlfriend is dating Sgt. Joshua Grande and Zumbo felt that he was targeted by Grande in this specific incidence. I was aware of this incident and had already spoken to the officers involved in the stop as well as reviewed associated BWC footage. I advised Zumbo that based on my review of the incident I could understand his perception of the events leading up to his arrest for Exposure of a Person but it does not appear that he was targeted or that Sgt. Grande was aware of the stop until he arrived to back up the responding officers.

All associated BWC footage was tagged regarding this incident and the interview of Zumbo at HO.

At the completion of my interview, Zumbo did not wish to file a formal complaint and only wished that I speak with Sgt. Grande to ensure that he is not being targeted.

On 10/10/19 at about 0125 hours PO Desens and PO Detraglia conducted a stop of NY at the intersection of the car. As he did he observed the rear seat passenger to PO Detraglia approached the passenger side of the car. have a clear corner knotted bag with what appeared to be narcotics in it. This male was attempting to put the bag down his pants. Immediately PO Detraglia ordered the male out the car. The male was hesitant so PO Detraglia again ordered him out and escorted him out of the car. PO Detraglia attempted to detain the male who tensed up and immediately began fighting with him. PO Desens assisted PO Detraglia. Both officers administered several hard hand strikes to the males upper body with little effect. The male then attempted to get back into the car and crawl across to get out of the other side of the car away from officers. This had a desired effect and the male was removed from the vehicle and placed in PO Detraglia completed a search of the male and located in his pants one clear corner knotted bag containing an off white chunky substance consistent to crack cocaine. The bag also contained pills. These suspected narcotics appeared to be felonious in nature. UFD was requested to respond to the scene to evaluate the suspect.

identified himself as Eric Davis initially in an attempt to prevent officers from gathering his true identity. It was found that the male was actually Daniel Davis.

UFD arrived on scene and evaluated Davis.

I asked Davis on scene if he was injured and he stated he was not. I asked if he

On 10/23/19 at about 2231 hours PO Talerico was responding to assist car 27 with a vehicle stop in the 800 block of Oswego St. PO Talerico was on the 700 block of Oswego St approaching Sunset Ave, traveling west. PO Talerico observed a grey Infiniti traveling north on Sunset Ave at a high rate of speed and passed through a steady red light at the intersection of Oswego St. PO Talerico believed the vehicle to be traveling well over 50mph. Due to the violations he attempted to conduct a stop of the vehicle. He caught up to the vehicle at the intersection of Francis St at Noyes St and activated his emergency lights to conduct the stop. The vehicle bearing NY pulled into the driveway of 25 Noyes St. The drimmediately exited the driver's seat and began to walk toward the front of the vehicle, away from PO Talerico. PO Talerico attempted to call out the stop and ordered the male who he knows to be Johnathan Wright to get back into the vehicle. Wright refused to comply and continued to walk away. At this time, due to the male not complying and PO Talerico believing he was about to flee, he grabbed ahold of him and pinned Wright against the car and advised him that he was under arrest. At this point Wright began to resist arrest by tensing up then pulling away while flailing his body in an attempt to get away. PO Talerico utilized a take down in the driveway of 25 Noyes St. While this was occurring While this was occurring, the rear passenger who was identified as Bernard Wright jumped from the rear passenger seat into the driver seat of the vehicle and attempted to back out of the driveway while PO Talerico was ordering him to stop and not move. male backed the car into the roadway, striking car 24's front bumper. Officers arrived on scene at this time to assist PO Talerico, who was still struggling on the ground with Johnathan Wright. PO Sheppard assisted by utilizing a come along to get Johnathan's hands out from under his body. After a struggle, Johnathan was handcuffed. He continued to be uncooperative and was then escorted to car 27 by PO Kellogg and PO Talerico. Both officers utilized come alongs due to Johnathan not cooperating and continuing to struggle with officers. I assisted RO Korman with detaining Bernard Wright. Bernard Wright was uncooperative at first and refused to place his hands behind his back but after I ordered him to place his hands behind his back a second time RO Korman and I utilized a come along to place his hands behind his back and into cuffs. Once in cuffs all force stopped. Bernard Wright was placed into the rear of car 22. As PO Kellogg and PO Talerico attempted to place Johnathan Wright into the rear of car 27, Wright continued to pull away and resist. PO Kellogg continued to use a come along to get him into the back seat. As Johnathan sat into the seat he wrapped PO Kellogg in his legs which caused PO Kellogg to fall into the back seat and Johnathon kicked him in the face with his foot. I immediately responded to the drivers side of the car and grabbed ahold of Johnathan Wrights arms and pulled him across to the drivers side and held him down on the seat in order to gain control over him, as he appeared to be attempting to injure officers. Once PO Kellogg was out of the car, I sat Johnathan up and closed the door. He continued to kick at the doors of the car during the incident. Both Bernard Wright and Johnathan Wright were transported to HQ. At HQ Bernard was turned over to the booking officer immediately. Johnathan Wright continued to be uncooperative at HQ and refused to walk into the station. He began pulling away from officers at which point PO West, RO Grullon and PO Desens utilized come alongs to escort him into the station and turn him over to the booking officer. This response to resistance occurred from 2248 through 2301 hours. Once in the station come alongs were utilized by PO West, PO Grullon and PO Desens in order to Once on the bench and secured, all force place Johnathan Wright on the bench. stopped.

I asked Johnathan Wright if he was injured and he said he was. He complained of an abrasion to his left eye area and lower back pain. He stated that he wanted go to the hospital. UFD was notified and responded to transport him. PO Lentricchia escorted him to St Elizabeth's hospital to be treated. Johnathan was bleeding from his left eye area, but would not cooperate so that I could see clearly where the injury was.

I asked Bernard Wright if he was injured and needed medical attention and he stated he was not injured and  $\operatorname{did}$  not need medical attention.

Car 24 sustained a large crack in the front drivers side bumper area from the Infiniti striking it while Bernard was attempting to back out of the driveway

during the stop. Photographs were secured of the damage to the vehicles. Photographs were secured of the scene where the response to resistances occurred as well as Johnathan Wright. Photographs were not secured of Bernard Wright as he was released from custody with tickets prior to PO Sheppard being able to secure them. PO Sheppard is completing an MV104a regarding the infinity striking parked UPD car 24.

Car 24 was parked at the UPD garage.

All photographs were downloaded. All BWC footage has been downloaded and tagged. Response to resistance reports have been completed.
