Utica Harbor Point Local Development Corporation

Operations & Accomplishments April 1, 2022 – March 31, 2023

- City of Utica submitted a request for \$2 million in federal earmark funds to Senator Schumer and Congresswoman Tenney to begin engineering work for a pedestrian bridge to connect the Harbor with Bagg's Square and the Nexus Center; award of the requested funding was announced in March 2022
- In May 2021, the City received its first tranche of American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funding (\$30 million). In October, the Mayor announced an allocation of nearly \$6 million of ARPA funds to begin development of the athletic fields at the Harbor.
- In May 2021, the City's Planning Board granted final approval to a subdivision plan for the DSA-1 redevelopment area.
- In January 2022, Governor Hochul delivered her State of the State address. A 230+ page brochure that accompanied the address listed the redevelopment of Utica's Harbor as a priority project for the State.
