On September 23<sup>rd</sup> 2009 at approximately 23:35 hours, Officer Dzenan Sabonovic and David Armstrong responded to a domestic incident on Bleecker Street on the city's east side in which the suspect was alleged to be in possession of a handgun. When Officer Sabanovic arrived at the scene of the domestic incident, he learned that the suspect had fled and immediately began an area check for the suspect's vehicle. Officer Sabanovic located the vehicle and with the assistance of Officers Armstrong, Howe and Bubnis, three occupants of the vehicle were detained and a loaded .25 caliber handgun was located in the vehicle resulting in the arrest of all three occupants.

Due to the quick response and cooperation of all Officers involved, a potentially deadly domestic incident was averted and a loaded handgun was removed from the street. The Officers' actions bring honor to both themselves and the Utica Police Department.
