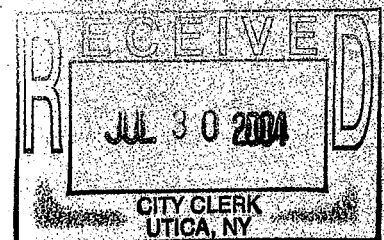

Sgt. Armstrong has a tremendous amount of experience on major crime scenes. He demonstrates a calm and collective command presence, and his able to direct investigators and patrol officers appropriately. His supervisors trust him to make correct judgment calls based on experience and knowledge of investigative techniques.

Sgt. Armstrong maintains a proper understanding of his investigator's active case load. He is often able to address questions and issues without referring to the case agent.

Sgt. Armstrong does an excellent job keeping his supervisors and the incoming day shift abreast of the previous evening's events. He regularly completes extensive email notifications to day personnel that keep supervisors aware of major incidents, and provide instructions to day investigators on what needs to be completed for on-going investigations.

Sgt. Armstrong sets an excellent example for his subordinates by always being involved in calls for service during the often busy Night shift. He does not hesitate to get involved with real time incidents and assists his investigators when and where needed. His subordinates respond well to his authority.

Sgt. Armstrong has excellent leadership qualities. He has integrity and honesty in abundance, and has been a pillar of the Criminal Investigation Division for many years.

On January 19, 2014, both the Oriskany St. Fastrac and N. Utica Hess gas stations were robbed at gunpoint by a single unknown male. Thus began a tireless investigation conducted by members of the Criminal Investigation Division into identifying and arresting this male. Early on in the investigation, it was determined that the same male suspect had perpetrated both robberies on the 19th. Through numerous interviews and meetings with police contacts, viable suspect information was developed.

Once the suspect was positively identified as the perpetrator of the Fastrac robbery, the CID Investigators actively sought the male to take him into custody and answer for his actions. On February 18, 2014, surveillance commenced at locations known to be frequented by the suspect and his female girlfriend accomplice. During this cooperative detail, the suspect and female accomplice were located and arrested without incident. During the subsequent interviews of the offenders, probable cause was developed and each individual was charged in connection with both robberies.

Due to their diligent work ethic and commitment to justice as well as their ability to cultivate information and work as a team, two individuals were arrested in connection with the violent felonies.

On November 21, 2011, Uniform Patrol Criminal Investigation & Special Operations Units responded to the area of Spring and Huntington Streets at approximately 11:10 PM in regards to a report of gunshots being fired. Officer Bubnis initially arrived and identified a subject of interest. Sgt. Cucharale was first on the scene to make this observation and directed other units responding. The subject in question was subsequently found by SOU Officers Fanigliula and Dalton inside a car.

Additional officers, along with CID Investigators Armstrong & Fernalld, also arrived on scene to assist. Armstrong and Fernalld immediately began their initial investigation. 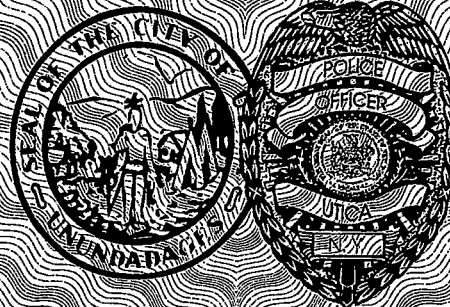
Due to the efforts of all involved, this dangerous individual was able to be arrested, charged and incarcerated and two illegal handguns were removed from the streets of the city.
