



Judgement/Initiative/Performance Under Stress - PO Talerico was counseled regarding his actions on 10/26/2017 when he conducted a citizen stop of an active FL05. After advising the suspect of the warrant he became non-compliant. PO Talerico failed to effect the lawful arrest, instead choosing the let the suspect walk away. He accepted responsibility for his actions and ensured it would not happen again.

Responsiveness to Supervision - PO Talerico appears eager to learn and takes constructive criticism well.

Work Quality/Report Writing Ability - PO Talerico requires more than average supervisory intervention with regards to his narratives/reports. Progress has been made in December with regards to the accuracy and completeness of his narratives, however room for improvement still exists. On 10/14/2017 PO Talerico failed to properly complete two (2) city court information complaints for UPM.

Punctuality - PO Talerico arrives early to work, in uniform well before roll call and ready to work.

Initiative - PO Talerico, as a new officer in the Tactical Unit must progress with regards to proactive policing. This will undoubtedly happen as he becomes more comfortable in the unit and with the experience of working alongside senior members.

Pertinent Information Pass Along Information regarding defendant Carrie Mathis:

Shortly after the below email regarding suspect Carrie Mathis was sent out department wide, PO Talerico who was off-duty diligently observed the below noted Dodge Durango being operated by Mathis in the downtown Utica area at which time he alerted CID Sgt. Armstrong who in turn alerted Patrol 3. Car 53 – PO Kyle Murphy subsequently located the suspect vehicle and tried to stop Mathis however she failed to comply and a vehicle pursuit ensued. The pursuit was reasonable therefore it was allowed to continue. The pursuit continued outside the city therefore several NYSP and OCSO patrol units who were equipped with spike strips volunteered their assistance. After two unsuccessful spike strip deployments, Lt. Holt decided to end UPD's involvement as the pursuit entered the Town of Vernon on St. Rte. 5. A few minutes later, NYSP successfully spike stripped the vehicle driven by Mathis on St. Rte. 5 just west of the Village of Vernon still within the Town of Vernon. After being spike stripped, Mathis reportedly crash landed in an open field and barricaded herself with a knife inside the vehicle. NYSP and OCSO units were able to bring the standoff to a peaceful end at which time Mathis was taken into police custody pursuant to UPD's pending VTL charges as well as other pending warrants / investigations as follows:

1. UPD's investigation pursuant to a Petit Larceny from Stewart's on Culver Ave. a few weeks ago when Mathis was suspected of snatching money from the cash register.
2. UPD's investigation pursuant to a Robbery from Fastrac on Herkimer Rd. a few days ago when Mathis was suspected of threatening the clerk then snatching money from the cash register.
3. Wanted by New Hartford PD regarding an arrest warrant for Petit Larceny.
4. Wanted by Herkimer PD regarding an arrest warrant for Petit Larceny.
5. Wanted by Whitesboro PD regarding pending charges from Grand Larceny (purse snatching incident).

NYSP and OCSO advised that they did not have any charges on Mathis therefore they wished to turn same over to UPD pursuant to our agency's pending charges. Sgt. Perra and PO West responded to the scene and took custody of Mathis. Upon their arrival, they found that Mathis was [REDACTED]

Personnel from Vaneal advised

police custody as she was under arrest pursuant to our agency's pending VTL charges = Unlawful Fleeing a Police Officer and a slew of other VTL charges therefore she was accompanied to the hospital by PO West. [REDACTED]

CID advised they would continue with their pending investigations involving Mathis in the morning therefore CID wished to pass the following information along to the various patrol shifts = Do not arraign Mathis until CID proceeds with their above noted pending investigations related to the Stewarts and Fastrac incidents. After concluding said investigations, CID advised they would ultimately lodge additional applicable charges against Mathis at which time she could be booked, processed, and finally arraigned.

CID Capt. Kelly was notified regarding the above situation (Command Notification).

Lastly, all shifts please be aware that Mathis was [REDACTED] as annotated above therefore constant watch provisions shall be enacted at all times while she is in our agency's custody. [REDACTED]

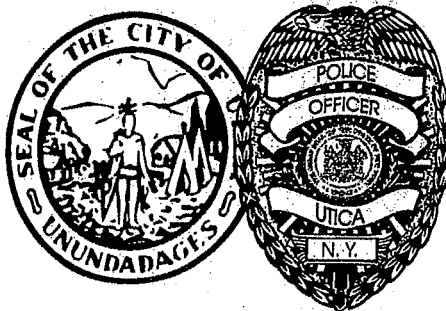

On March 13th, 2017, officers were assigned to the GIVE Detail from the hours of 4:00 p.m. to midnight. At approximately 9:00 p.m., Investigator Aaron Donaldson received information that there was a lone male subject walking on foot in the area of Sunset Ave near Shaw Street and was believed to be in possession of a firearm. A description of the male was provided to the officers by Investigator Donaldson. At one point, the male met up with three additional subjects and they were now standing in front of a market located on Oswego Street. Officer Charles Parkosewich was assisting in plain clothes and advised the rest of the marked units that the subject was observed in front of the store and was now walking with the other individuals westbound on Oswego Street.

The marked units consisted of Officer Brandon Burnham and Officer Andrew Miller, Sergeant Joseph Cimpi and Officer Donald Talerico and Sergeant Kerry Carville with Officers Alexander Castilla and Christopher Vomer. All patrol units were nearby and were able to converge onto the subjects from all points, so as to apprehend the subjects if they decided to flee. The subject, who was believed to be in possession of the firearm, was apprehended by Sergeant Carville and handcuffed. Officer Parkosewich was able to locate a loaded .22 caliber Burgo Revolver in the male's waistband. Sergeant Cimpi then searched the subject and located a .22 caliber live ammunition round.

If not for the number of officers on scene tactically positioned to ensure the subjects could not escape, the armed suspect may have fled the area or possibly attempted to use the handgun on an officer to escape. Due to Investigator Donaldson's gathering of information and Officer Parkosewich providing a distinct description of the subject, as well as all the marked units working together, a dangerous armed criminal was apprehended and an illegally possessed handgun was seized without incident. The actions of these officers bring honor to themselves and the Utica Police Department.

On 9/13/18 at about 2222 hours car 27, PO Murphy and Talerico were traveling on Bleecker St near Bacon St when they observed a black male walking int eh roadway. They conducted a stop of the male regarding the violation. Upon stopping the male he refused to give his name to officers and attempted to make phone calls and began to argue with officers. PO Murphy advised the male that if he refused to provide his pedigree information he would be arrested for obstructing governmental administration. The male refused and at this point they began to grab ahold of the males arms. The male then yelled that his name was Walter Peak. At this point PO Talerico knew that Peak was a file 5 from this agency and Peak was advised that he was under arrest several times. Peak tensed his arms and attempted to prevent control and would not allow officers to place him in handcuffs. After a brief struggle PO Murphy and PO Talerico were able to pull Peak's hands behind his back using come along and placed him handcuffs. At no time was peak taken to the ground, this all occurred while standing on the sidewalk. Once in handcuff's all force stopped. PO Talerico then notified me regarding the response to resistance.

I responded to the scene and was advised of the incident. I then spoke to Peak who stated he was not injured and only requested his handcuffs be adjusted. The left cuff was adjusted. While speaking to Peak he told me that he was stopped by the police and did not give his name when they asked and that he was trying to call his Aunt prior to being arrested. This was consistent with PO Murphys and PO Talericos accounts of the incident.

PO Talerico secured photographs of the scene. Peak was then transported to HQ where he was turned over to the booking officer. At HQ I spoke to Peak. I asked him again what occurred and he again stated he walked int eh road because of a skunk and then was stopped by police. Summary:

On 6/14/19 at about 2020 hours, car 25, PO Basler and PO Talerico observed 2 males in the 1100 block of Walnut St that were failing to use the sidewalk. They conducted a stop of the parties in front of 1020 Walnut St regarding the violation. During the stop both parties were uncooperative and argumentative saying that they did not need to stop. Officers advised them that they needed to stop and they did for a moment. Officers then asked for identification, at which time a white male wearing jeans and a gray sweat shirt identified himself verbally as Paul Larson. PO Talerico then realized that he believed the male to be who he knows to be Paul Watkins [REDACTED] who is an active file 5. Paul again told PO Basler his last name was Larson and PO Talerico began to approach the male and confirmed it appeared to be Paul Watkins. Due to PO Talerico knowing that Watkins was a file 5 he grabbed ahold of the Paul and advised him that he was being detained to confirm his identity. Paul immediately attempted to flee from PO Talerico. At that time PO Talerico attempted a takedown of Paul and PO Basler responded to assist him. PO Basler and PO Talerico were able to take Paul to the ground and place him in handcuffs. Once in handcuffs all force stopped. Once in handcuffs the male confirmed his actual name was Paul Watkins [REDACTED]. There were in fact multiple open bench warrants for Paul Watkins. Other officers conducted a stop of the second party who continued to walk away from officers during the encounter. This second male was identified as Christopher Hautala [REDACTED]. Due to Christopher not stopping for lawful orders given by officers he was arrested for obstructing. I responded to the scene and observed the location of where the take down occurred, which was directly in front of 1020 Walnut St. PO Basler and PO Talerico advised me of what had occurred and were conducting a search of Paul Watkins. He was found to be in possession of two small bags of marijuana. PO Basler secured photo graphs of the scene. Both Hautala and Watkins were transported to HQ and turned over to the booking officer. PO Basler then secured photographs of Watkins. I interviewed Watkins and he complained of neck pain, right elbow pain and pain to his right ribs. On Thursday June 20th 2019 members of the TAC unit were involved in a citizen stop of five persons on the 1000 block of Knox St relative to the parties walking in the roadway.

The presence and actions of the parties from 1021 Knox and others were clearly obstructing the members of TAC in the furtherance of their investigation into the identity of the members stopped for the original VTL.

Prior to the vehicle coming to a complete stop, the front seat occupant fled the vehicle eastbound. Due to the observed VTL by the passenger who clearly did not have their seatbelt on with the vehicle in motion, the officer gave chase. On September 12th 2019 at approximately 0121 hrs PO Talerico conducted a stop of NY [REDACTED] on Schuyler St at Court St relative to the observed VTL violation of 1163b.

Upon making contact with the driver, he verbally identified himself as Curtis Becker yet provided no form of identification. The male was then advised regarding False Personation/Criminal Impersonation. By this time PO Sheppard and PO DeTraglia were on scene to assist. Officers would learn that the operator was lying about his name and that he was, in fact Scott Becker. Based on Becker knowingly and unlawfully providing his brother's pedigree information officers requested that he step out of the vehicle to be taken into custody for Criminal Impersonation.

At that time, while PO Sheppard and PO Talerico were attempting to unlock and open the door to the truck, Becker sped off. As Becker fled south on Schuyler St PO Sheppard was caught up in the open window/door frame causing him to be dragged along with the vehicle. While continuing to flee, Becker repeatedly yanked the wheel side to side while at speed in an apparent attempt to throw PO Sheppard from the vehicle. Once at Schuyler St at its intersection with Noyes St PO Sheppard fell from the vehicle as Becker continued to flee south across open field towards Oswego St.

Units from TAC and Patrol 1 continued the pursuit into New Hartford along with NHPD units until such time as Becker came to a stop in the gravel driveway of 55 Slusser Ave, New Hartford NY 13413.

At that time PO Bubnis, PO Talerico, and PO Aiello and I were able to take Becker into custody after a Response to Resistance involving a takedown and hard hand strikes. During this Response to Resistance PO Bubnis reported to me that he injured his right hand. At that time, I observed his right hand to be swollen. PO Bubnis was directed to St Elizabeth's Medical Center for further treatment. I would later respond to St Elizabeth's with PO Bubnis who was diagnosed with a broken right hand.

As a result of this incident a fact-finding investigation is being commenced regarding any violations of Policy and Procedure pertaining to the arrest, booking and release of Healy. Upon researching the incident I have determined that detailed narratives are needed from the following involved personnel as it pertains to any involvement they had with the arrest, booking and/or release of Healy or any other relevant information pertaining to this matter.

On May 19, 2020 I reported to work for the 1545-0000 hours shift and was assigned car 44 to city wide patrol.

At approximately 1750 hours I responded to 906 Eagle St. to assist car 55, PO Talerico who had located an EDP at that location.

Upon my arrival I observed PO Talerico interviewing a white male, slender build, light colored hair wearing a black jacket and jeans. I now know this male to be

The male appeared to be agitated, he was argumentative and verbally non compliant PO Talerico made countless attempts to explain why we were there and was going to occur. At some point during the interview [REDACTED] contacted his father and asked him to respond to the scene. [REDACTED] was continuously pacing around yelling at us to get away from him. He stated multiple times that he refused to go to the hospital because it was going to cost him thousands of dollars in bills.

PO Talerico requested that I contact dispatch and request EMS for an [REDACTED] which I did. A short time later UFD arrived on scene. [REDACTED] was still non-compliant. PO Talerico continued to make attempts to reason with him. While the interview continued a black pick up truck pulled up aggressively and stopped abruptly in the lot located at the above location. A white male wearing a blue tank top and jeans exited the truck stating that he was [REDACTED] I now know him to be [REDACTED]. He was also argumentative, ordering us to release his son to him immediately. It was explained to him that was not possible at this time due to his son meeting the criteria for [REDACTED]. He continued to argue with us regardless. He then requested a supervisor and shortly after I called for one to respond.

Car 40 Sgt. Gymburch arrived moments later. [REDACTED] requested to speak to her away from the other officers. He moved around the side of the building. I, to maintain security moved from location to the other side of [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] should he attempt to flee. She very eloquently and professionally spoke to [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] explaining everything in great detail at length to no avail. At this time [REDACTED] began to become evasive and was moving around quite a bit. He was extremely jittery and kept looking around in every

direction. In my experience this behavior is consistent with someone preparing to flee. [REDACTED] as then advised for a final time that he was going to the hospital in our custody via UFD Ambulance. He continues to be argumentative and non compliant

[REDACTED] attempts to flee the scene by beginning to walk away. I at this time close the distance to him, and grab his left arm/hand to place him in handcuffs. He immediately tenses his arms and is now physically non compliant. I was able to secure one handcuff to his left hand. He then breaks free of my grasp and grab onto his belt tightly with his left hand in an attempt to evade being handcuffed. He is repeatedly told to stop resisting. I ordered him multiple times to let go of his belt and he refused. Sgt. Gymburch aided me by taking control of the handcuffs. This enabled me to employ an "arm bar" to break his grasp from his belt. Seconds later the technique proved to be effective and [REDACTED] released his grasp of his belt. He was then handcuffed and escorted to the UFD ambulance.

I along with PO Talerico followed UFD to [REDACTED] For safety reasons. Once we arrived he was escorted inside and turned over to the Hospital Staff without further incident.

On October 1, 2020, the Office of Professional Standards received an email from Zach Oren (Corporation council) notifying us regarding a notice of claim submitted by a Peter Morgan. The incident in question occurred on 1/7/20, at approximately 1325 hours and is memorialized by RMS 20-680. Chief Williams advised the PSU to conduct a precautionary investigation into the allegations. I first reviewed the RMS for this incident and noted that PO Anken was dispatched to 2000 Bleecker Street (Masonic Home) regarding a [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] PO Anken did not have any contact with the suspect during this investigation. Furthermore, the BWC showed that PO Anken had probable cause to complete the report. I then viewed the BWC from Officers Santana and Talerico who were responsible for transporting the suspect from a Herkimer PD Officer who had located the suspect. I did not view any impropriety on behalf of the transporting officers. The allegations made by the suspect appear to be focused on his innocence. In my opinion, the claims made by the suspect are unfounded. In reviewing all reports and evidence related to this incident it appears as though police services were provided in a competent and professional manner while in accordance with Utica Police Department, Policy and Procedure along with State and Federal laws. The allegations of this complaint have not been verified by facts and at this time I am unable to establish any basis for sustaining this complaint. Should any further information be obtained to contradict any information contained in this report, I will prepare an addendum report and re-evaluate my recommendation at that time.

This investigation is closed and has been registered into the Professional Standards database.
