The department shall assign members as General Topics Instructors based upon the recommendations of Unit Commanders with the approval of the Chief of Police. Members selected for assignment, as instructors must successfully complete the DCJS Instructor Development Course.

If you are selected to become a General Topics Instructor and successfully pass the Instructor Development Course, you will be expected to assist in teaching with in-service instruction for this agency on any assigned topic, and may be called upon for instruction at the Police Academy. This also applies to all current General Topics Instructors.

General Topics Instructors may receive training on specialty courses of instruction such as, Defensive Tactics, Firearms, Radar/Lidar, BAO, Physical Fitness, TASER, EVOC etc. Consideration for specialty instruction will be based upon your current standing as a General Topics Instructor and participation with in-service and Police Academy instruction.

You may not Opt-Out of your title as General Topics Instructor during your tenure with this agency.


As a member of the Criminal Investigation Division Command Staff, certain responsibilities are increased from that of a Uniform Patrol Division Supervisor. You will be expected to be available by telephone on a 24 hour, 7 day a week basis. Although you will have a set work schedule and set hours, you will be expected to be flexible as the needs of the division dictate. 



Dear Chief Williams:

Please be advised that on Wednesday, January 24, 2018, the above named defendant plead guilty to a three count indictment charging him with Rape, Aggravated Burglary and Aggravated Robbery. He waived a presentence investigation and agreed to serve a nine (9) year prison sentence. Following his release from prison he will be required to serve five (5) years of post-release control.

This sentence was the result of a December 1996 cold case that was solved after a CODIS match was made almost 20 years after the fact. The victim, who was 75 at the time of the crimes, had since passed. After re-opening the case local officers were able to track the Defendant down to Utica, New York. Our local officers were assisted by Sgt. Stanley Fernald and Sgt. Michael Murphy of your department. These officers were able to obtain a DNA sample that confirmed that Jack Sheetz was in fact the perpetrator of these crimes. Additionally, your officers met with and assisted our local officers when they arrived in Utica and were prepared to come to Warren, Ohio to testify in a potential Motion to Suppress that was eventually cancelled due to the plea.

Please accept this letter as thanks for these officers and your department's assistance in this cold case conviction. Thanks to the assistance and efforts of Sgt. Stanley Fernald and Sgt. Michael Murphy a 20 year old violent crime has been solved and the perpetrator has been sentenced to prison where he belongs.



### MOHAWK VALLEY CRIME ANALYSIS CENTER

In January of 2017, the Mohawk Valley Crime Analysis Center (MVCAC) opened its doors on the first floor of the Utica Police Department. The project was made possible through an investment by the New York State Division of Criminal Justice Services in partnership with Mohawk Valley Law Enforcement.

The crime analysis center is staffed by sworn members of various agencies located in Oneida and Herkimer County. The center is overseen by Lt. Stanley Fernalld of the Utica Police Department, and center members include Sergeant Joseph Surace of the Oneida County Sheriff's Office, Investigator Dan Sullivan of the Oneida County District Attorney's Office, Probation Officer Randy Moore of the Oneida County Probation Department, Investigator Frank Spatto of the New York State Police, Investigator Aaron Donaldson of the Utica Police Department, and Officer Joshua Austin of the Utica Police Department. Additional analytical staffing support comes from Corey White of the New York State National Guard Counterdrug Task Force and Crime Analyst Michelle Collver and Crime Analyst Tori Watson of the John F. Finn Institute for Public Safety.

During the 2017 calendar year, the Mohawk Valley Crime Analysis Center supported law enforcement in Oneida, Herkimer and Madison Counties by fielding 1,381 requests for assistance. This assistance is unprecedented for a crime analysis center this size and only in its first year of operation.

The assistance included, but was not limited to, arrest reports for HIDTA, monthly GIVE statistical reporting, a daily arrest and informational report for the center's Board of Directors, and attempt to identify bulletins for any officer or investigator for crimes which ranged from petit larceny to murder.

Additionally, the Gun Involved Violence Elimination (GIVE) Field Intelligence Officers are assigned to the Mohawk Valley Crime Analysis Center. GIVE is a New York State Division of Criminal Justice Services (DCJS) initiative to support communities in their battle against gun violence through funding, training and analytical support. Oneida County GIVE is a collaborative effort of the centers' members to rid our streets of dangerous gun offenders while making a positive, long-lasting impact in the communities where gun violence is most prevalent.

In 2017, the GIVE program accounted for 99 guns recovered, 92 firearm arrests, multiple gun rewards payouts, and 55 operational deployments resulting in numerous firearms seized.

The Mohawk Valley Crime Analysis Center and its staff are not only assets to the Utica Police Department but they are an asset to the law enforcement community of the Mohawk Valley.

On February 24, 2012, around 6:15 p.m., Uniform Patrol Units were dispatched to the 500 block of Herkimer Road to a report of a fight involving a man with a gun. The first Patrol Unit arriving was assigned to Officer LoGalbo who met with subjects involved and quickly gathered information which was shared with additional Patrol Units as they arrived.

Officers Graeff and Parkosewich and Sergeant Cinque immediately established a perimeter at that residence which was most likely occupied by an armed individual. Subsequently a subject was taken into custody and the premise made safe. At that time, no weapon could be located.
