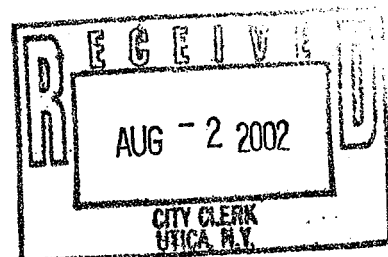

In 2017 Inv. Trevisani was the subject of an internal investigation and subsequent Command Discipline which resulted in a three-week suspension from work.

While the outcome of the investigation concluded that Inv. Trevisani did violate Utica Police Department Policy in 2015-2016, it should be noted that the matter was only able to be successfully investigated due to his honesty. As a consequence of the nature, sensitivity and reluctant witness involved in the case, it was only resolved due to Joe's acceptance of his actions and judgement.

On August 12<sup>th</sup>, 2016, a man was gunned down on the 1300 block of Brinckerhoff Ave. Upon learning the case would be a homicide, it was assigned to Investigator Joseph Trevisani of the Criminal Investigations Division Major Crimes Unit. In the very early stages very little, if any information, was coming in about the homicide. There were no witnesses present, no concerned parties coming forward, and little to no evidence, including a definitive crime scene, to base an investigation on.

Investigator Trevisani developed a suspect and began to focus his attention on a young male. An extensive four plus hour interview with the suspect took place and several inconsistencies were discovered. Some admissions about possible culpability were made, but it was decided at the time that the suspect would be released and attempts to shore up the investigation would be undertaken.

In the ensuing thirty days, Investigator Trevisani worked diligently putting in long hours, interviewing possible witnesses, pouring over case evidence, drawing search warrants and meeting with family members to further the case. More importantly, he worked nonstop on his off-hours contacting and meeting with family members at all hours of the day and night. Investigator Trevisani showed a great deal of respect not only for the victim and his family but also the suspect and his family. The investigator gave the homicide the highest level of attention that such a case deserves.

The respect, dedication, and attention to case detail he demonstrated was instrumental in the young male ultimately confessing to the murder at his own kitchen table with his mother, father and Investigator Trevisani at his side. Within weeks, he pled guilty to the death of the victim and was sentenced.

Investigator Trevisani not only exhibited great diligence, effort, commitment, and hard work throughout the investigation, but he also went to great personal lengths to see a successful resolution to this murder investigation. Had it not been for the time spent of his own hours and his strong gift of humility, it is likely this case would not have seen the same positive outcome for all parties involved.

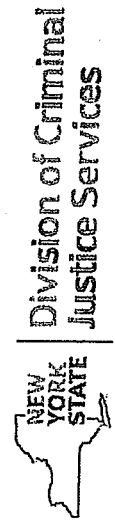

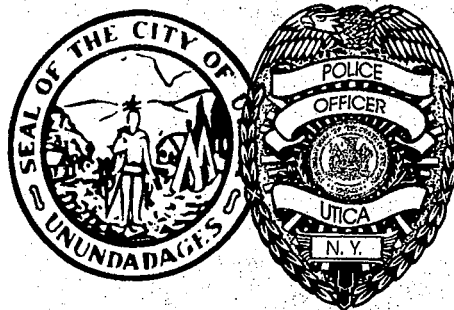

On January 13, 2010 at 13:38 hours, a 911 call was placed by a woman visiting her mother and brother at 1652 Seymour Avenue. The woman attempted to leave and was held along with her mother and 6 year old daughter at gunpoint by her emotionally disturbed brother. Her brother locked the family in the house, took the callers cell phone and told them he would have to kill them all, while pointing a loaded handgun at the 6 year old child. The caller's mother began to experience chest pains and the caller convinced her brother to take their mother to a hospital. The caller reported that she had obtained a cell phone and was calling as the suspect was leaving for a hospital with their mother.

Communications Officers DeMichele and Carville obtained information from the caller and directed units to the caller's location while keeping all units informed of events as the information was developed. Communications officers dispatched units and gave out the information about the suspect, his mother, a general description of the vehicle they were in and their eventual destination. They then coordinated the response to the scene and regional efforts to locate the suspect vehicle. Investigators Bick and Trevisani saw a vehicle matching the broadcasted description stopped at a traffic light at Genesee and the Parkway. The investigators were joined by Officers French and Shaffer and they attempted to affect a traffic stop of the vehicle as it drove west on Burrstone Road. The operator refused to comply and the officers followed and eventually stopped the vehicle at St Luke's Hospitals Emergency Room entrance. The officers approached the vehicle and were able to remove the suspect through sound tactical procedures and take him into custody without endangering his passenger/mother. The suspect was found to be in possession of a loaded .38 Caliber revolver with additional ammunition, 2 hand held MACE chemical spray canisters and a hand held Stun Gun. The suspect also had a suicide note on his person detailing his plan to take the lives of his family members and his own life.

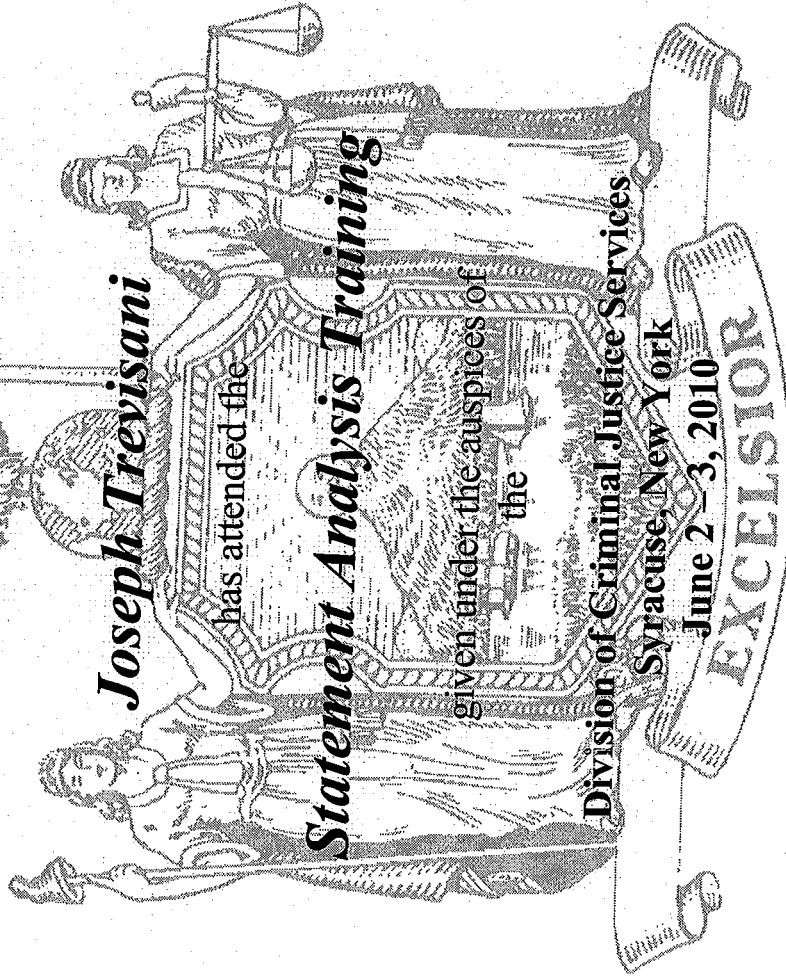
The alert and professional response of the officers combined with their use of sound tactical skills and team work prevented what could have been a major tragedy and needless loss of life. The peaceful resolution of this incident by these officers is a testimony to their professionalism, skill, courage and dedication. Their actions exhibit the highest standard of the department's commitment to protect the lives of the citizens of our City. Their actions bring honor upon both themselves and the Utica Police Department.
