Sergeant Soja and Catholic Charities responded to the apartment of the client. After several attempts to contact the suspect forced entry was made into the barricaded hallway. The suspect appeared behind a second locked door and appeared to have some type of mental issues. Personnel from Catholic Charities attempted to talk to the suspect. The suspect then came down the stairs and stated he had the "gas" on and was going to blow up the house and everyone with him. At one point the suspect became irate and placed a knife to his throat. The suspect stated that he would only talk to Investigator Moldonado who he was familiar with, Investigator Maldonado and Lieutenant Bryan Cormato responded to the scene. Investigator Moldonado after a lengthy discussion with the suspect was able to have him drop the knife. After another discussion Investigator Molonado was able to convince the suspect to surrender. He was then taken into custody by the investigator and Lieutenant Coromato. The suspect was then taken to a local hospital for a mental health evaluation. I would like to commend Investigator Moldonado for his compassion, professionalism and his ability to deescalate this serious situation. As a result of Investigator Moldonado and Lt. Coromato the suspect was not injured and most importantly no law enforcement personnel were injured. The Utica Police Department should be proud to have these two officers in their command and their actions in assisting our department should not go unnoticed.

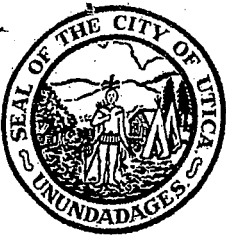

On February 16, 2014, my son, Donald [REDACTED] Jr., committed suicide. He was found by a friend, who, in turn, called 911. The Utica police investigators who were at the scene, came to my house to inform me of his passing, but I was in Florida at the time. My son [REDACTED] was there and they were able to inform him. They were very cordial and sympathetic and left their cell phone numbers, so that I could contact them when I returned home.

I was able to get a flight out Monday morning and called Inv. Maldonado as soon as I could. He was extremely compassionate, helpful and sympathetic. He gave me what information he could and told me to call him, at any time, if I had any more questions or if he could help in any way. I did, in fact, call him a few times for information and he was always courteous and professional.

On March 7th, I had made an appointment, with records Officer D. Taurisano, to come to the police station and pick up [REDACTED] property. Officer Taurisano was also very professional, compassionate and courteous. He attempted to make a difficult occasion easier for me. I know with my fragile composure, it was not an easy task for him either.

My purpose in sending this letter is to inform you of the professionalism of two of your officers. They handled the situation in a manner that made it a little easier for me and were able to take a little of the stigma away from it.

On January 19, 2014, both the Criskey, St. Easton and N. Shea Hess gas stations were robbed at gunpoint by a single unknown male. This began a tireless investigation conducted by members of the Criminal Investigation Division into identifying and arresting this male. Early on in the investigation, it was determined that the same male suspect had perpetrated both robberies on the 19th. Through numerous interviews and meetings with police contacts, viable suspect information was developed.

Once the suspect was positively identified as the perpetrator of the Fastac robbery, the CID investigators actively sought the male to take him into custody and answer for his actions. On February 18, 2014, surveillance commenced at locations known to be frequented by the suspect and his female girlfriend accomplice. During this cooperative detail, the suspect and female accomplice were located and arrested without incident. During the subsequent interviews of the offenders, probable cause was developed and each individual was charged in connection with both robberies.

Due to their diligent work ethic and commitment to justice as well as their ability to cultivate information and work as a team, two individuals were arrested in connection with the violent felonies.
