Everyone in every branch of law enforcement reacted with such capable strength to keep us safe and to resolve this situation. We were all truly fortunate that this was not the horrific tragedy that it could have been.

I am that old, fat, 'wobbly' woman who was having trouble breathing and navigating the stairs as I tried to exit Gordon Science Center. To say that I was running out of 'steam' would be an understatement. I wasn't sure I could do much more - and I was so afraid that I was going to cause trouble by interrupting the safe evacuation of our students. I had lost sight of 'my' students and felt that I was somehow failing at my responsibility to keep them safe. My brain knew that all of the law enforcement people were now doing a great job of keeping us safe - but after 32 years of being very serious about keeping my' kids safe, it was a difficult feeling to abandon. Anyway - I was in trouble, and I knew it - and then you simply appeared and took my arm and told me everything was ok. And I knew it was ok. You were taking good care of us - and you were taking good care of me. I will be forever grateful to you for those few moments that you spent with me. I looked for you later in the day, but everything was so crazy and crowded. I was afraid I wouldn't be able to thank you for your help.


And then I turned on the news - and there you were! I must say that your sweater vest is a very different look from your emergency response uniform - but both are very comforting!




### Dear Chief Williams

Based on that tip, multiple officers from many agencies were sent to the area of South and West Streets in Utica. The group of officers organized themselves and searched a vacant building in the area with negative results. Further conversation took place between officers on the scene and the tipster. Based on that information, the officers began a grid type search of the yards. It was during this search that officers located and took a suspect into custody. He was in possession of the handgun that he used less than 24 hours earlier to shoot the deputy.

The involved group of officers worked together to bring this armed and dangerous felon into custody with no injuries to themselves or the suspect. They should be recognized for their willingness to put themselves in harms way. Their professionalism, skills, ability, dedication and teamwork brought these events to a successful conclusion.


### MERITORIOUS SERVICE




Officer Williams interrupted a robbery in progress, prevented harm to two store employees and the apprehension of this suspect closed several other open robberies.
