
Dear Chief Williams,

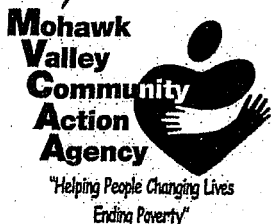

Anyway - I was in trouble, and I knew it - and then you simply appeared and took my arm and told me everything was ok. And I knew it was ok. I looked for you later in the day, but everything was so crazy and crowded. I was afraid I wouldn't be able to thank you for your help.

And then I turned on the news - and there you were! I must say that your sweater vest is a very different look from your emergency response uniform - but both are very comforting!

So, thank you Chief Williams, for keeping us safe - and for keeping this old, fat, 'wobbly' woman safe AND sane! In 2 months I will be retiring after 32 years at Utica College (42 years of college teaching). This was definitely NOT an experience I was hoping for before I retire - but it is certainly one I will never forget.

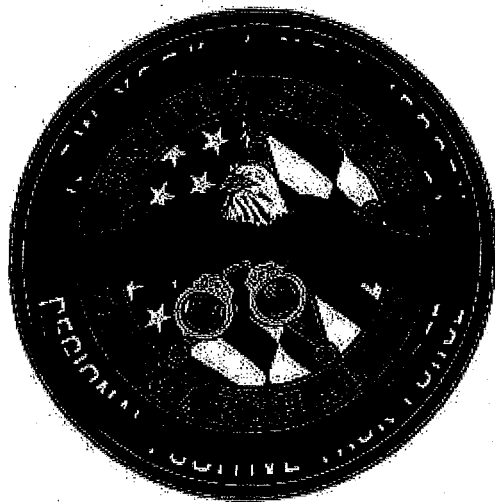

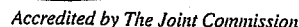

On behalf of The Pennsylvania Office of Attorney General, Bureau of Narcotics Investigation, I want to extend this letter of commendation to Investigator Bill Williams, under your command, regarding a PA Grand Jury marijuana trafficking investigation jointly conducted in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and New York. This investigation culminated in the arrests of nineteen Pennsylvania and New York residents who had to be located and arrested in multiple counties, requiring the coordination of multiple Pennsylvania and New York local, state and federal law enforcement agencies.


The investigation revealed that defendants, J [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] were involved in a large scale marijuana trafficking organization where Murray organized the distribution efforts in New York and Spira in Pennsylvania. The suppliers to this organization were also identified and some are [REDACTED]. Over six million dollars in marijuana was distributed by this organization throughout New York, Pennsylvania, Virginia and North Carolina between mid 2006 and early 2009.

With the cooperative efforts of Inv. Williams this marijuana organization was dismantled. Through continuing investigative efforts we will potentially identify larger suppliers in New York and Canada. Many different law enforcement personnel were involved either in the investigative or arrest efforts to conclude this investigation. Inv. Williams clearly demonstrated superior investigative abilities that contributed to the successful closure. He is an asset to your agency and should be commended for his investigative contribution.

As you well know, fighting the war on drugs successfully demands that we in law enforcement work together to solve the problem. Thank you for Inv. Williams' hard work and assistance. We look forward to any future endeavors with your agency. Please share my gratitude with Inv. Williams.

Parole Officer Warren [REDACTED] of the Utica Parole Office has informed me of an incident which took place on June 13, 2007 in which he and Investigator William Williams of your office were working an Operation Impact Detail. During the course of a home visit with Parolee Louis [REDACTED] [REDACTED] attempted to flee his apartment. In an effort to flee from the apartment, [REDACTED] attacked Investigator Williams who was blocking his exit. In attempting to affect the custody of [REDACTED], both Investigator Williams and Parole Officer Mason were dragged down a hallway six to eight feet before he was finally restrained. Despite being surprised and attacked by the parolee, Investigator Williams at all times, behaved in a highly professional manner. Investigator Williams continued to give [REDACTED] verbal directions to stop fighting and only used the force necessary in order to effect the custody, despite [REDACTED]'s continued attack upon both Investigator Williams and Parole Officer Mason.

Investigator Williams' action in this very dangerous custody situation are greatly appreciated by both Parole Officer Mason as well as the entire Utica Parole Office. During the incident, Investigator Williams demonstrated composure under extreme duress and at all times exhibited a high level of professionalism. In addition to his actions in effecting the custody, it should also be noted that a quantity of crack cocaine was also found in the residence.

I would like to take this opportunity to commend Investigator Williams, not only for his actions in this case, but for his on-going cooperative efforts with the Utica Parole Office.

Fields began to give dispatch the description of the male, the vehicle pulled into the intersection and began returning fire at the male who was now running on Sunset Ave. As Sgt. Fields continued to give descriptions and details, he kept an eye on the vehicle and the male running.

At this time, Investigator William Williams, Officer Joseph Dare and NYS Parole Officer Jeffrey Stewart who were parked on Oswego St., observed the vehicle and conducted a vehicle stop. The stop resulted in the arrest of the two parties and the seizure of a handgun. During this same time, Sgt. Fields followed the male to a residence on Sunset Ave. After several units responded to assist, the male was located and taken into custody.

The swift actions of these officers resulted in the arrest of three individuals involved in the shooting and the seizure of a firearm.

On January 8, 2018, at approximately 10:35 a.m., units were dispatched to the area of Conkling Ave. regarding a shots fired incident where a male had been struck. Upon speaking with the victim, they developed a suspect. That suspect was one of the city's top GIVE offenders.

Approximately an hour later, Investigator William Williams and Officer Michael Cerminaro of the Warrants Unit were patrolling the area of James St. and Seymour Ave. when they observed the suspect as a passenger in a tan-colored vehicle. They communicated their observations over the radio and Sergeant Ashley Berger immediately located the vehicle at the intersection of Pleasant St. and Kemble St. and conducted a vehicle stop. The suspect was then taken into custody by the officers and charged with attempted murder, robbery, and several firearms possession charges.

On July 21, 2015, there was a runaway train incident involving the NY Susquehanna and Western Railway and Union Station. An unmanned railcar rolled north down Schuyler St. colliding with a motor vehicle at Oriskany Street and ultimately crashing into Union Station causing significant damage. Information was provided that a juvenile may have tampered with the railcar, releasing its braking system and thereby setting the railcar in motion. Acting on extremely limited witness information, Investigators Williams, Van Horne, and Carville of the Juvenile Aid Unit heavily canvassed the area for any type of witness information or surveillance footage. After obtaining a partial name from information on a sign-in sheet at Addison Miller Pool, the investigators were able to follow leads which ultimately lead them to the juvenile suspect. During an interview with this juvenile he confessed to being involved in the incident.

During this investigation, the officers demonstrated a diligent work ethic and commitment to the truth, as well as an ability to cultivate information and work as a team. The investigation has led to questions being asked about the safety measures being taken by the railway industry when leaving railcars unattended and of the parking lock system.

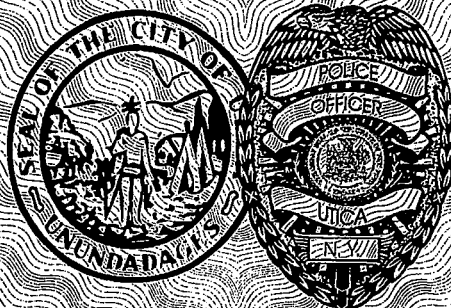

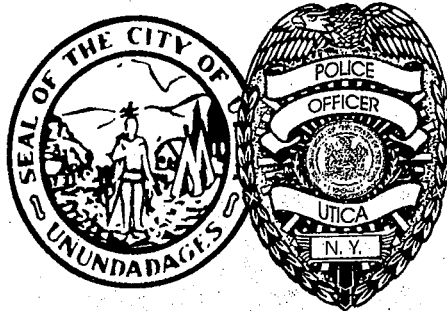

On July 29, 2010, after committing a bank robbery in Rome, New York and during a subsequent chase during which an Oneida County Sheriff's Deputy was shot, the suspect eluded police. The manhunt continued through the night and into July 30th. In the late afternoon hours, the Utica Police Department fielded a tip from [REDACTED] a concerned citizen, as to a possible location of the suspect. Based on that tip, multiple officers from many agencies were sent to the area of South and West Streets in Utica. The group of officers organized themselves and searched a vacant building in the area with negative results. Further conversation took place between officers on the scene and the tipster. Based on that information, the officers began a grid type search of the yards. It was during this search that officers located and took a suspect into custody. He was in possession of the handgun that he used less than 24 hours earlier to shoot the deputy.

The involved group of officers worked together to bring this armed and dangerous felon into custody with no injuries to themselves or the suspect. They should be recognized for their willingness to put themselves in harms way. Their professionalism, skills, ability, dedication and teamwork brought these events to a successful conclusion.

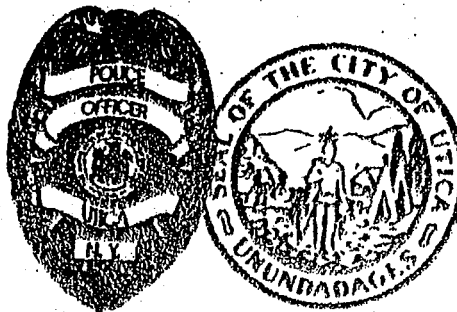
The bravery and selfless dedication of these officers, as individuals as well as a team, resulted in the arrest of an armed individual, who attempted to shoot and kill a police officer.



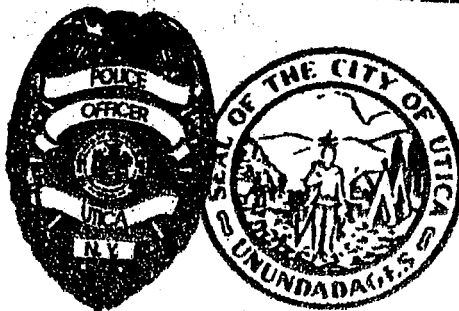

Officer Williams interrupted a robbery in progress, prevented harm to two store employees and the apprehension of this suspect closed several other open robberies.

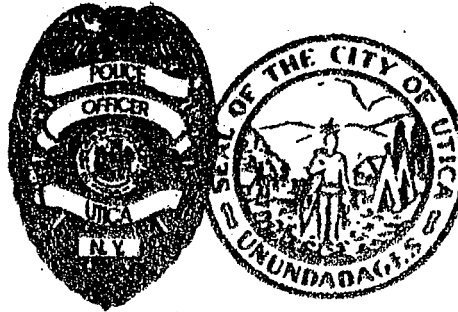
